1. Following the sighting of a UFO by civil ATC radar and RAAF 3CRU a Mirage was launched to investigate. Attached is a report by the pilot identifying the object as a balloon.
2. In order to determine the origin of this balloon I have spoken with various civil and Service ATC authorities as follows:
  - a. RAAF Sector 4 Brisbane (civilian counterpart)
  - b. DOA Air Safety Branch Brisbane (Ted Lovell, 2531363).
  - c. DOA Air Safety Branch Sydney (Joni Wayne, 2111056; and
  - d. Superintendent Airways Operations Sydney (Warwick Biggs).

None of these authorities have or appear to intend to investigate the incident more fully to determine the balloons origin. Joni Wayne did offer that from its description the balloon appeared to be an old type, no

longer in use in Australia.

3. Being of a flight safety nature these ATC authorities are responsible for any further investigation. Since the matter is not of a National Security nature no further action is required in regard to UFO, as laid down in Ref A.

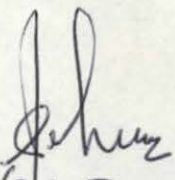

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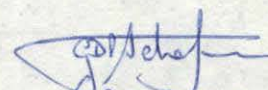

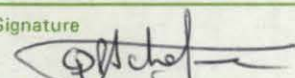

4. Description of Sighting. The caller sighted a formation of stars, approximately 9-12 in number, travelling over the moon in a V/C formation from East to West (his right to left). He also described the stars as a 'bunch of lights'. There appeared to be one main large star at the lead of the formation and the trailing stars almost appeared to be towed by the lead star although there appeared to be nothing interconnecting them. The caller's wife and daughter also experienced the sighting which lasted for approximately three minutes until the moon was covered by cloud

5. When asked if any of the stars were still there he advised that the large one and several smaller ones were there but not in any formation and they had stopped.

6. The sighting occurred when the gentleman was returning from his garage. He had used a torch on his way to the garage but the torch would not operate on the way back to the house during the presence of the formation but did work when he was back inside the house.

7. I would estimate the caller to be a middle aged gentleman. He was concerned when I asked for his name and address that the information might 'leak out' but reluctantly provided the information. He sounded genuine.
