This is our final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated 17 November 2016, for "a copy of records, electronic or otherwise, of all case processing notes, letters, emails, inter-agency communications, etc. that pertain to FOIA Case 2015-00680-F and also FOIA APPEAL 2015-00137-A."






