Dear Mr. Greenewald:

This letter responds to your recent Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests received by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC or Commission) and assigned to the Consumer & Governmental Affairs (CGB) and Enforcement Bureaus (EB). Your requests seek complaints regarding: 1) the television series "The Walking Dead," from January 2016 to the present and 2) the three Presidential debates which took place in September, and October 2016. The above requests have been aggregated. Your requests have been assigned FOIA Control Nos. 2017-070 and 2017-071.

CGB conducted a search of the databases in which we maintain the records of informal complaints filed by, or on behalf of, consumers. Our search identified approximately forty-eight responsive documents. Enforcement reports that it did not identify any responsive records.

Records responsive to your request were withheld or redacted under FOIA Exemption 6. Exemption 6 protects files containing personally identifiable information disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Balancing the public's right to disclosure against the individual's right to privacy, we have determined that release of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Therefore, all FCC employee names, complainants' names, addresses, and telephone numbers were redacted under Exemption 6.¹ The FCC receives many complaints and comments that do not involve violations of the Communications Act or any FCC rule or order. Thus, a complaint or comment does not necessarily indicate any wrongdoing by any individuals or entities named in the complaint or comment.

FOIA and FCC rules require the FCC to charge requesters for time spent searching for and reviewing responsive documents, and for copying them. Pursuant to section 0.466(a)(5)-(7) of the Commission's rules, you have been classified for fee purposes as category (2), "educational requesters, non-commercial scientific organizations, or representatives of the news media."² As an "educational requester, non-commercial scientific organization, or representative of the news media," the FCC assesses charges to recover the cost of reproducing the records requested, excluding the cost of reproducing the first 100 pages. The production in response to your request did not involve more than 100 pages of duplication. Therefore, you will not be charged any fees.

If you consider this to be a denial of your FOIA request, you may seek review by filing an application for review with the Office of General Counsel. An application for review must be *received* by the Commission within 90 calendar days of the date of this letter.³ You may file an application for review by mailing the application to Federal Communications Commission, Office of General Counsel, 445 12th St SW, Washington, DC 20554, or you may file your application for review electronically by e-mailing it to <u>FOIA-Appeal@fcc.gov</u>. Please caption the envelope (or subject line, if via e-mail) and the application itself as "Review of Freedom of Information Action" and the application should refer to FOIA Nos. 2017-070 and 2017-071.

Thank you for contacting the FCC to share your concerns about broadcast program material that you find offensive. The FCC licenses over-the-air radio and TV broadcast stations. It is against federal law for a licensed television or radio station to air obscene programming at any time, or to air indecent or profane material during the hours of 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. The FCC is charged with enforcing the law that governs the broadcast of such material.

The FCC is not permitted to censor or restrict the availability of non-broadcast programming shown over cable and satellite systems. Cable and Satellite Operators do not have the same restrictions on program content as regular television broadcast stations.

For the FCC to consider whether a licensee has violated these requirements of the law, a complaint must relate to particular programming, rather than express a general opinion. To proceed on a complaint, the FCC must have information that includes the station that aired the programming material, the date and time of day of the broadcast, a recording, transcript or description of the material broadcasted.

Licensed Broadcasters are responsible for selecting the broadcast material that airs on their stations, including advertisements. The FCC expects broadcasters to be responsible to the community they serve and act with reasonable care to ensure that advertisements aired on their stations are not false or misleading.

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) has primary responsibility for determining whether specific advertising is false or misleading, and for taking action against the sponsors of such material. You can file a complaint with

the FTC, or call toll-free 1-877-FTC-HELP (1-877-382-4357).

If your complaint is regarding non-broadcast programming shown over a cable or satellite system, or concerning broadcasts from a FCC licensed TV or radio station, and you have not provided the necessary information, or the facts and information contained in the complaint did not suggest that a violation of the statute or FCC rules regarding indecency, obscenity, and profane material has occurred, we cannot proceed further with regard to your allegations. Accordingly, we must close your complaint.



Here is the email I also sent to AMC, which outlines my concerns:

To Whom This May Concern:

Let me begin by saying I've been a big fan of the Walking Dead since the beginning. However, I feel the need to share my distaste for the season premiere aired on Sunday. The brutality depicted was tasteless and irresponsible. I found it to be problematic on a number of fronts:

1. There was no regard shown for human life. The incessant bashing of the characters' heads was disgusting and intolerable. While I can tolerate gore related to zombies, this took it to another level that I don't feel is appropriate for television. Imagine the societal impact this could have on younger, more vulnerable viewers. I'm 31, but I know I wouldn't be comfortable with my 17 year old brother watching this.

2. The level of violence was unnecessary. I don't believe it was crucial to advance the plot as the writer mention on the Talking Dead. It was simply violence for the sake of violence. It provided no social commentary. The sole purpose seemed to be to shock the audience. And that disgusts me. It's pure smut.

4. I understand following the plot of the comics. However, the writers already take a huge amount of creative license with the show. The way they chose to portray this part of the story was irresponsible. Television is a different medium, which requires different moral considerations. The portrayal involved real humans which were dehumanized through the violence depicted. It can't be healthy for young minds to see this. Plus, with the show, audience and reach is much greater than the graphic novels. The potential negative impact on society is far greater.

In short: I expect more from AMC and the Walking Dead. I hope there are other voicing their concern over this episode, and that you consider our opinions as you develop new episodes in the future.

I will be also sharing my views with the FCC.

I hope you take this complaint seriously.

USA Today even wrote an article saying:

In a moment of extreme graphic violence (even for a routinely violent show), two fan-favorite cast members, Glenn (Steven Yeun) and Abraham (Michael Cudlitz), were brutally beaten to death by Negan with a baseball bat covered in barbed wire. The two deaths of beloved characters were shown in such excruciating detail in a relentless and frustrating episode that many fans said they were frustrated enough to quit the show for good. For this recapper, it was a hard episode to get through, with the violence verging on nauseating while the plot dithered and attempted to manipulate fans into caring.

The episode was also lambasted by critics, with The Daily Beast writing, "When real life already seems a few calamitous steps away from dystopia, surviving an hour of pure, relentless misery isn't entertainment — it's a chore," while GQ said, "if the average episode is as much fun as a punch to the jaw, the Season Seven premiere was—well—a barbed-wire baseball bat to the skull." Vox went so far as to call it "dumb, dumb, dumb, dumb, dumb, dumb. It's stupid. It's downright appalling, is what it is."

In a conference call with reporters on Monday, episode director Greg Nicotero defended the use of such graphic violence.

"In this instance, we felt it was important to launch us into this season to show the extent of what Negan is https://fcctest.zendesk.com/tickets/1285263/print

capable of doing because that drives so much of where the series is going from here on," he said. "It's graphic and horrible. And while designing, testing and shooting the makeups, we wanted to push it a little bit." In response to fans saying they would quit, Nicotero added, "I would say that that means we have done something to affect these people in a way that they don't necessarily know how to process. I'm a big Game of Thrones fan and I've been shocked at the turn of events on that show but I still love it and I still am committed to seeing where the story goes. I think it's' a kneejerk reaction people have because they care about these characters."



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



The season premier of The Walking Dead was so horrific and realistic that it should not be able to be broadcasted on a non-premier channel and definitely not on prime time. The Walking Dead is televised on AMC, which is a non-premier channel. 


