YOUTH INTERNATIONAL PARTY

The Youth International Party (YIP), commonly known as YIPPIES, was formed in January 1968 by a small group of artists, writers and musicians and has been referred to as "the first attempt to give social direction to the drug movement."

Founders of the YIP; all users of LSD; other "consciousness-expanding" drugs and marijuana, include: Paul KRASSNER, editor of the satirical magazine, The Realist; Edward SANDERS, leader of the rock group, the Frug; Abbott Howard HOFFMAN and Jerry Clyde RUBIN, defendants in the "Chicago Seven" conspiracy trial.

The YIP has no formal structure; no leaders and is a non-membership New Left coordinating group, headquartered in New York City, which utilizes the extensive underground press network to broadcast "its gospel of protest and ridicule of the establishment."
