MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: PROJECT MERRIMACK

1. On 7 April 1967, [REDACTED] informed me they already had assets who had made contact with SNCC, Women Strike for Peace, Washington Peace Center and at St. Stephen's Church, 16th and Newton Streets, N. W., designated as the local coordinating center for the "Spring Mobilization."

2. On 10 April (0900 hours), [REDACTED] advised that weekend activity was relatively quiet. He stated that MERRIMACK assets reported hearing that next Saturday (15 April) will be a day or maybe "the day" of demonstration in D. C. The focal points of activity over the past weekend were reported to be the Washington Peace Center, the Georgetown Strip, DuPont Circle, and the coordinating center (St. Stephen's Church). [REDACTED] stated that coverage will continue throughout the week.

3. On 10 April (0930 hours), [REDACTED] reported that a MERRIMACK asset reported that WSP would demonstrate before the White House between 10 and 10:30 a. m. in conjunction with Vice President Humphries return to the capitol city.
