MEMORANDUM FOR: The President

1. This report is the first we have had indicating direct support of the Women's Strike for Peace by the Soviets.

2. As you well realize, this item is not only sensitive in its own right, but is particularly so since this Agency has no charter to operate within the United States on this kind of matter.

3. We will pass this information to the Federal Bureau of Investigation since it obviously requires follow-up.
