SUBJECT : Projected Operation MERRIMACK
Coverage of 21 October Demonstration

1. On even date a conference was held with [REDACTED] relative to our coverage of the activities immediately preceding and following the 21 October demonstration. It was determined that beginning with 16 October 1967, either [REDACTED], or myself will man an office at [REDACTED]. The purpose of establishing a temporary office there is to serve as a communications link between your office and the agents in the field.
