6. Arrangements were made this date for Special Agent [REDACTED] to be introduced to Subjects through [REDACTED] at 1730 hours this date. During the meeting with Special Agent [REDACTED] described his past relationship and handling of Subjects. Special Agent [REDACTED] was informed by [REDACTED] and statement signed by Subjects that their initial impression to being handled by the FBI was negative. However, they realized that it was their patriotic duty to have an audience with Special Agent [REDACTED] and would be happy to listen and talk with him with regard to their past activities.

7. If Subjects do or do not agree to continue their activities under the supervision of the FBI, this, it is clearly understood by Special Agent [REDACTED] and the undersigned as well as [REDACTED] will be a matter of decision for the Subjects to make. Regardless of the decision by Subjects, they will not be used further in Operation MERRIMACK without the specific approval of the Director of Security on any future requirements.
