SUBJECT: Contact between the United States National Student Association (NSA)

has received an urgent letter from the United States National Student Association (NSA) signed by Charles Palmer, president of the NSA, which requested that the cable the NSA on 15 November strong statements against the continued involvement of the United States in the Vietnam war that the letter also requested that they send by mail any statements they had made in past regarding United States involvement in the Vietnam war and copies of statements they had made in past against the United States participation in the war.

COMMENTS

one of the resolutions passed was a censure of the United States for the presence of its military forces in Vietnam and its refusal to withdraw its forces from Vietnam.

The NSA has not yet taken an official position on the November Moratorium, although many individual members have expressed themselves in support of it. This is the first direct indication of NSA specifically soliciting support for the Moratorium from an organization.

Charles P. PALMER is elected the president of the NSA during its National convention in August 1969 in El Paso, Texas. PALMER is a former student body president from the University of California at Berkeley and was involved with the People's Park demonstrations in Berkeley in the spring of 1969.
