Request of Loren Chudy, Chicago's American Newspaper, for info re CIA Operations

1. At 1323 on 16 Feb 67, a phone call was received in the Chicago Field Office by [Redacted] from an individual who identified himself as Loren Chudy, a reporter for Chicago's American.

2. Mr. Chudy stated that, recently [Redacted] asked if [Redacted] would give information re contacts with the National Student Association. [Redacted] responded that he had no information concerning such activities. When Mr. Chudy then asked if he could quote [Redacted] to this effect, [Redacted] stated that the only quote he could authorize would be "No Comment".

3. [Redacted] then volunteered to give to Mr. Chudy a telephone number in Washington to which Mr. Chudy could direct his questions. Mr. Chudy gave a telephone number of 222-4124 where he could be reached.

4. [Redacted] then telephoned the above information to [Redacted] who advised [Redacted] to have Chudy call Mr. Joseph C. Coovrin at 202-331-7676.

5. [Redacted] contacted Mr. Chudy and gave to Mr. Chudy the Coovrin telephone number.
