Dear Mr. Brychkov:

We are in receipt of your letter of 13 March 1965 pertaining to the publication of the correspondence between our two organizations in the Information Bulletin of the International Student Conference (November 1964).

We fully recognize the validity of your objections to the publication of your correspondence without receiving prior permission from your organization. We also recognize that any editing of such correspondence was completely unjustified. USNSA would like to express its sincere apologies in this matter and accepts full responsibility for the action.

We would, however, like to offer an explanation for what has occured. Copies of the correspondence between our two organizations were sent to our representative in Paris and to the American members of the Secretariat of the ISG so that they might be fully apprized of the latest developments in the relations between our two organizations. Apparently, they assumed that they were authorized to publish the material. Since we sent them the copies we do, of course, accept the ultimate responsibility for such action. We are in the process of contacting them to clarify this matter.

As you requested, we are sending copies of letters received by USNSA dated August 24th and December 28th, as well as copies of our letters of September 24th, November 16, and March 2 to the ISC. We shall request the ISC to publish all of the letters in unedited form and draw attention to the fact that discrepancies existed in the material praviously published.

We are concerned, however, about the last paragraph in your letter of 13 March. We do not believe that it is either courteous or fruitful to issue threats when actions have been taken which one of our organizations feels has been unfair. Clearly the first step is to

We would again draw your attention to our letter of March 2nd, and will be looking forward to your comments on the proposals made in that communication.
