



MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 24 June 1967 Washington Post Article on NSA-CLA Building Negotiations

1. The 24 June 1967 Washington Post article strongly suggests that CIA is bringing strong pressure against NSA as a result of the February revelations. The article, based on NSA sources, purports that CIA is "trying to evict" NSA from its office quarters and that "three CIA conduits" have presented NSA with "bills totalling about \$25,000 and dating back three or four years."
