Subj: FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT (FOIA) DON-NAVY-2014-008036

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of July 25, 2014, in which you have requested copies of all records that were generated to research the cost, savings, and implementation of the procurement of electricity produced from renewable energy generation systems.

Upon review of your request, we have determined that most of the information you are requesting is exempt from disclosure pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5) which prohibits the disclosure of information that is "confidential commercial information" or documentation of "deliberative process". The only information we can provide to you is the Hawaiian Electric Company, Inc. (HECO) rates based on the actual billings used to develop the Government Estimate at enclosure (1). Other than this information, the records you requested contain confidential source selection information and contractor bid and proposal information, which may not be released pursuant to 41 U.S.C. § 423 and 10 U.S.C. § 2305(g). Additionally, the records reflecting government estimates, are restricted from release by the Federal Acquisition Regulation 36.203(c) and relate to deliberative process.

This is a partial denial of your request; therefore, you are advised of your right to appeal this determination, in writing, to the General Counsel of the Navy, 1000 Navy Pentagon Room 4E635, Washington DC 20350-1000.

Your appeal must be postmarked within 60 calendar days from the date of this letter to be considered. A statement as to why your appeal should be granted should be included and the enclosed copy of this letter should be attached. Both the appeal letter and the envelope should bear the notation, "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
