EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS

SUBSECTIONS OF TITLE 5, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 552

- (b)(1) (A) specifically authorized under criteria established by an Executive order to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy and (B) are in fact properly classified to such Executive order;

OTTAWA — (AP) — Canadian sources said today the United States is considering a vast expansion of North America's defense network. The move, they said, would place the Canadians, who would provide the manpower, in a highly placed position in the government's defense plans before long when Canada would have to pay the price of a loss of sovereignty to a more Americanized defense force than the defense force of this dilemma even suggests for Canada, which has no draft, may be forced to impose peacetime conscription within five years.
