I just spoke to Pat Cunningham. He just got a call from a lawyer of their cooperating FFLs. Issa's staff (Pinto, Kerner, and Castor) called the lawyer yesterday and said they were going to subpoen the FFL to testify in a hearing on May 10 or 11 **ATF** old Issa's staff that his client has a variety of concerns with testifying, including the fact that he is a witness in a criminal matter and concerns for his safety. Staff told him that it would be easier to keep this confidential if he was willing to come in for a voluntary interview. Counsel said that his client didn't want to. Staff asked whether he would accept service of a forthwith subpoena on Monday. **ATF** said no he wouldn't **ATF** sked USAO-AZ if DOJ could help quash the subpoena **ATF** asked USAO-AZ what they would do to help assure the safety of his client. USAO-AZ and **ATF** and the client will be meeting next week to discuss a threat assessment.
