All except two family members indicated they understood. Only the step mom and brother did not agree. The step mom is convinced that Terry was killed by a crooked agent. The brother stormed out before our meet was ended. He is the one who later said it was a friendly fire incident, that we had blood on our hands and that this was a cover up. I recommend
