My name is Rebekah Zemansky; I'm writing to see if you can help me find someone to talk to me about firearm serial numbers and how agencies work together when firearms are seized at crime scenes.

I was at the January press conference when they announced the indictments for [ATF] and four other cases, and they mentioned how inter-agency cooperation with this tracking is so important - and that it can even work with international cases - and I've also read about how important this tracing can be when dealing with cases like Jared Loughner. I think that both the database and the agency coordination could be a really interesting story, as it's a different side of law enforcement than case by case coverage.

If it's possible, I'd really like to learn more about this and look forward to hearing back from you - I appreciate any help you can provide!
