Hope you are well. We understand that at one point, Special Agent [ATF] and Phoenix Detective Daniel Moncrief went at the direction of [ATF] to do an interview at the home of a firearms purchaser. We do not know the name of the purchaser or the date, although it was presumably after the fall of 2009. The purchaser turned out to be a prohibited possessor (possibly a felon—we're not sure), and his firearms were seized. However, he was not arrested at that time. We would like a copy of the Report of Incident (ROI) from this event. Can that be located for us?
