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(U) FOREWORD

(U) The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Foreign Government Information Classification Guide (FGICG) provides guidance concerning the classification and level of protection afforded to foreign government information. The FGICG is not intended to provide specific guidance concerning the handling, safeguarding, transport, declassification and downgrading, destruction, or administration of classified material, whether in paper or electronic form. Specific guidance concerning these topics is available in Executive Order (EO) 13526, "Classified National Security Information;" Department of Justice (DOJ) Security Program Operating Manual (SPOM); FBI Security Policy Manual (SPM); FBI Automatic Declassification Guide; FBI Foreign Dissemination Manual (FDM); Federal Register, Part V, National Archives and Records Administration (NARA), Information Security Oversight Office (ISOO) Final Rule (32 CFR Parts 2001 and 2003); and other documents referenced herein.

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(U) The duration of classification, classification markings, and other requirements of EO 13526, are to be applied to information classified pursuant to this guide, in accordance with the SPM and other approved FBI policies and procedures. I hereby approve the issuance of this classification guide and the classification determinations designated herein, as an authorized Original Classification Authority

(U) The FGICG shall be considered the primary authority on the subject matters it addresses for derivative classifiers within the FBI. This version, is effective immediately, and supersedes the Foreign Government Information Classification Guide #1 (G-1), Revised 5/2008.

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(U) FOREIGN GOVERNMENT INFORMATION

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1 GENERAL

1.1 (U) PURPOSE

(U) To provide instructions on the classification of foreign government information.

1.2 (U) AUTHORITY

(U) The FGICG is issued under authority of Executive Order 13526; Information Security Oversight Office Directive Number 1 (32 CFR Section 2001.10); Department of Justice Security Program Operating Manual; the FBI Security Policy Manual; and the designated Original Classification Authority (OCA) of the Executive Assistant Director, National Security Branch. The FGICG constitutes authority and may be cited as the basis for classification of information and material.

(U) Executive Order 13526 defines foreign government information as:

1. Information provided to the United States Government by a foreign government or governments, an international organization of governments, or any element thereof, with the expectation that the information, the source of the information, or both, are to be held in confidence; or
2. Information produced by the United States pursuant to or as a result of a joint arrangement with a foreign government or governments, or an international organization of governments or any element thereof, requiring that the information, the arrangement, or both, are to be held in confidence; or
3. Information received and treated as "Foreign Government Information" under the terms of a predecessor order.

(U) Executive Order 13526, section 1.6(e) provides that "Foreign government information shall retain its original classification markings or shall be assigned a

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U.S. classification that provides a degree of protection at least equivalent to that required by the entity that furnished the information." This constitutes the authority for the instructions in column 1 of the classification matrix. Note that the FBI has no authority to waive or modify this guidance. The FBI will exercise its original classification authority under Executive Order 13526 to classify foreign government information it receives, taking into consideration the foreign government classification and the intent of the entity that furnished the information. This FBI authority, which has been delegated by the FBI Director to the EAD, NSB, is the basis for the instructions in section 3 below, which FBI derivative classifiers are required to follow.

(U) The guidance in columns 2, 3, and 4 of the classification matrix relates not to information provided by a foreign entity, but to information obtained and reported by the FBI on activities conducted by both foreign and US entities. Accordingly, classification of such information is authorized by Executive Order 13526, section 1.2 (a), which requires that a US Original Classification Authority determine that unauthorized disclosure could reasonably be expected to damage US national security and section 1.4 (d) which provides that information is eligible for classification if it pertains to foreign relations or foreign activities of the United States. The EAD, NSB, as the cognizant FBI OCA, has determined that damage to US national security could reasonably be expected to result from unauthorized disclosure of relationships with foreign entities that those entities have asked to US to keep in confidence. The guidance in columns 2, 3, and 4 shall therefore be treated an exercise of OCA authority, which derivative classifiers are required to follow, subject to the FBI policies for classification challenges and exceptions.

(U) In the event of a conflict between the guidance in this classification matrix and guidance in another FBI classification guide when both are applicable to a particular item of information, derivative classifiers shall apply the most restrictive guidance, and cite the source of the most restrictive guidance in the classification block.

2 (U) USE OF THE GUIDE

(U) The FGICG is for the use of FBI personnel, contractors and detailees performing derivative classification actions when addressing the elements of information covered by this guide.

(U) For the purpose of marking documents containing classified information covered by the FGICG, derivative classifiers will cite "FBI FGICG" at a minimum (include the date of this guide if the system allows) on the "Derived From" line, and the declassification instruction as specified in the guide. For Example:

(U) *Derived From: FBI FGICG, 2012XXXX*
(U) *Declassify On: (Insert declassification instruction as cited for the particular type of information in the classification guide)*

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(U) Caveats appearing on foreign government documents or Legal Attaché documents setting forth leads must also be placed verbatim on communications in response to the lead.

(U) If classified information covered by the FGICG, as well as classified information from other classified sources, is included in the same document, the document will be marked as follows:

(U) Derived From: Multiple Sources

(U) Declassify On: (Carry forward the single most restrictive declassification instruction from all source documents)

(U) NOTE: If "Multiple Sources" are used for a derivatively classified document, a record of the sources used for classification will be maintained (at a minimum) with the file or record copy of the document. It is good practice to include the source listing either at the beginning of the document, near the classification authority block (the "Derived from/Declassify on" block), or at the end of the document with the words "Derived from:" and then a comprehensive list of only the sources from which the classifications were determined.





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(U) Note, that documents marked in accordance with ICD 206, Sourcing Requirements for Disseminated Analytic Products, dated 17 October 2007, may commingle FGI with US classified in portions, and FGI from another source. The FGI shall be identified in the source reference citations as endnotes in disseminated analytic products. Documents not marked in accordance with ICD 206 Sourcing Requirements for Disseminated Analytic Products, dated 17 October 2007, must keep the FGI segregated from US classified portions and from FGI of another source. Concealed FGI shall not be mixed with

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acknowledged FGI within the same portion.

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5 (U) CHANGE RECOMMENDATIONS

(U) The FBI International Operations Division (ICD) through its network of Legal Attaches is the primary source of information regarding the specific classification recommendations for each listed country and agency. All users of this Guide are encouraged to assist in improving and maintaining its accuracy. If the classification level(s) and duration(s) mandated in this Guide impose requirements that are considered impractical, or some information is of such a unique nature or extremely sensitive to require higher levels of protection, or any contributory factors indicate a need for change(s) in this Guide, documented and justified recommendations should be made to the Office of Primary Responsibility listed in Section 1.3. Pending final decision, the information in question will be protected at the highest level of either the current classification or the recommended change.
