
Several persons in my congregation have told me that they have seen statements attributed to you which describe the National Council of Churches as either Communist infiltrated or Communist dominated. You can well imagine how this has distressed me.

I would like to say that I have long admired you personally and I have long admired the work that you have done - and I say this sincerely. At the same time, as a clergyman of a denomination that has long taken a leading part in both the Federal Council and the Mational Council of Churches I am disturbed to hear these statements attributed to you. If the Mational Council is in any way serving the Communist cause I - and thousands of other Presbyterian ministers - would like to know about it. Therefore, permit me to ask you these two cuestions:

- 1) Have you ever so described the National Council?
- 2) Do you believe that the Matienal Council is Communist dominated, or Communist infiltrated, or is in any way aiding the Communist conspiracy either at home or abroad?

I am awaiting your answer with eagerness as you may well imagine. I want to thank you in advance for the time you give to this inquiry.

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

First of all, may I say that like 99.44% of Americans, I would like to express my appreciation for the wonderful work you and your organization have been doing for so ma years.

Another American for whom I have great respect and admiration is Herbert Philbrick. When he was in Indianapoliskin May he made an excellent speech on Communism to a capacity frowd at the Murat Temple (which holds 1800). In and afternoon he was available to answer questions, and I took advantage of the opportunity to ask him several questions. One question (asked by someone else) was about the Communist influence in the churches. He answered that yes, they were influential in churches, schools and labor unions. He suggested checking the record of G. Bromley

I have also read that you are disturbed about the charges of Communism in the churches and that you believe that the Protestant ministers are loyal Americans.

It does seem reasonable that the Communists would leave no stone unturned to accomplish their purpose and that they would infiltrate churches as well as school, unions, etc. Have you read News and Views (Oct. 1960) which includes the resolution of the Spring Branch Christian Church of Houston, Texas which made a thorough study of the National Council of Churches and its officers?

1) They protest the political activities of the N.C.C. and wish to cooperate with other churches toward the end that the N. C. C. will cease all political

activities. 2) That the leaders and officers of the N. C. C., who are now, or knowingly become, affiliated with an organization or cause which wither the F. B. I., Dept. of Justice, Atty. Gen., Senate Internal Securities Committee or the Un-American Activities Comm., classify as "subversive" or "Communist-front" be relieved of their position.

2) That a plan be worked out giving individual churches a role and voice in the National Countil.






Dear Sir:

A woman in my congreggion told me recently that she did not know which way to turn, she was very confused. It seems that she has been an ardent follower of the messages delivered daily by the Reverend Carl McIntire, president of the International Council of Churches. No doubt you are familiar with this man and his work on communism. The National Council of Churches and the World Council of Churches has been under heavy attack by Dr. McIntire for their alleged support, knowingly and unknowingly, of communism. The woman that I mentioned is very disturbed that our church belongs to the above councils and she is therefore reluctant to support a group which in turn supports communism.

I am not writing for counseling advice for this woman. But what I would like to know is to what extent has communism infiltrated, or to what extent are the accusations of McIntire concerning such infiltrations true? In your own mind are these councils quilty of the accusations which are made against it? Also, from your experienced point of view, I would like to know what you think about the work of this man, McIntire. Is he telling the true story?

I realize that some of these questions might tend to put you on the spot. But what I am looking for is some factual data concerning these problems. Dear Mr. Hoover:



I am writing you direct because I have such a profound respect for your integrity and judgement. I have enclosed the article from "The Episcopalism" one of my Church's publications, which has prompted this letter.

For some time, I have been increasingly concerned over the work and pronouncewents of the Mational Council of Churches of Christ in America, and have done a great deal of research and study on the matter, increasing the danger, in my opinion, of our "giving up" to the theory that it is better to be Red than dead. I have also been concerned about the increasing use of the social gospel instead of the True Gospel from some of our pulpits.

There is no question in my wind that this trend in the churches stems from the leadership of a handful of men. Unfortunately, too many of our parish priests and clergymen simply will not take the time or lack the time to become informed on the matter of Socialism and Communism. Furthermore, the increasing use of the works of the German theologian, Bultmann, in the seminaries is beginning to show forth. Bultmann - summed up - treats EVERYTHING in the bible as myth - what better could serve the purpose of the Communists in their effort to destroy our churches?

I am now working ceaselessly in preparing the the Triennial Convention of the Episcopal Church, which meets in Detroit in September, in hopes we can gain enough strength among the delegates to get our Church CUT of the Mational Council of Churches of Christ in America - or at least get a resolution passed requesting that the Council cease and desist from speaking in behalf of Episcopalians.

And along comes this article quoting Mr. Sullivan. May I ask if he was quoted out of context? May I ask if what he has said here is properly quoted, and if so, are these YOUR opinions as well?

It has never been my intention to do a single thing to DESTROY my Church rather I believe that by waking up the priests and laymen to the dangers. the Church in trath COULD become our greatest bulwark against Communism. If we who call ourselves Christians truly understood the teachings of Christ, Communism would never have gotten a foothold in this country.

There is no time left to perpetuate myths which can destroy us.

wo EPISCOPAL laymen were having a troubled conversation at the headquarters of the Justice Department in Washington, D.C. One of them was a newspaperman. The other was a high official of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

"I think," said the reporter, "that this thing is getting serious."

"So do I," said the FBI man.

He paused and stared out of his office window at the throngs of springtime tourists on sun-bathed Pennsylvania Avenue.

"It would certainly be ironic," he said, "if a job which the Communists couldn't do for themselves should be done for them by the very people who profess to be their worst enemies."

The two men were talking about a campaign which threatens to weaken and demoralize America's churches by planting in the public mind the suspicion that they are overrun by Reds.

This campaign is not being conducted by Communists. It is being carried on by men and organizations which claim to be militantly anti-Communist. But the FBI has evidence that the Communists are as delighted with the results as if they had planned the whole operation them selves.

Sapping the vitality of Christian churches has always been a major Communist objective. In every country where the Communists have gained power, from Russia to Cuba. the objective is being pursued openly, with acts of persecution and harassment against churches.

In free nations like the United States of America, Communists cannot attack Christianity directly. But they are constantly alert for opportunities to disrupt churches by more devious methods.

One obvious method is to infiltrate the churches by naving disguised Communists work their way up to positions of leadership, particularly in the ranks of the clergy. The Communists undoubtedly have tried to do this. But they have found that it is much easier said than done. Communism and Christianity are diametrically opposed in their basic beliefs about God and man. As a practical matter, it is enormously difficult for a Communist to pose convincingly as a dedicated Christian even for the space of one conversation, let alone through the long years of seminary study and pulpit service which are required of any man who becomes an influential leader in U.S. church life.

Another method which the Communists have tried is duping well-meaning Christian clergymen into leading their names to Communist-front projects.

Dr. Ralph Lord Roy, a Methodist minister, has been conducting a study for the past six years, under a grant from the Fund for the Republic, to determine what success the Communists have had in this direction. His extensively documented research is reported in a book, Communism and the Churches, recently published by Harcourt, Brace.

Dr. Roy sums up his findings in these words:





Sermon preached in Saint John's Episcopal Church, Fort Worth, Texas, Sunday, April 23, 1961, by The Rev. John R. Leatherbury,

The Vestry has asked me to talk on the National Council of Churches. I will endeavor to tell you what the National Council of Churches stands for. I am in no way speaking as an authority. I am not speaking for the Diocese of Dallas. I am speaking for myself as a priest of 28 years — I am speaking as your rector of 14 years. And after I have given some of the salient thoughts of the National Council of Churches of Christ, then I shall give you John R. Leatherbury.

First, we must remember that there are two organizations that go by the name of the NATIONAL COUNCIL. We must straighten this out first. The National Council of the Episcopal Church are duly elected officers of the Episcopal Church with The Rt. Rev. Arthur Lichtenberger, the presiding Bishop, as the presiding officer. The National Council of the Episcopal Church runs the business of the Episcopal Church throughout this part of God's kingdom.

We are now talking about the National Council of Churches of Christ. This is an organization created in 1950 with headquarters in New York with a budget of \$13,000,000. It started out on a very ethical plane - we were very happy. It was to be like a Criss-Cross. If you have ever used a Criss-Cross for the telephone or directory you were able to trace down and find out who lived where, and then you were able to contact them and find out more about them if you so desired. The National Council of Churches of Christ was to be that type thing. It was to be an interchange of ideas. At no time was it to be a Super Church. At no time was it to make pronouncements. It was to be a cooperating agency wherein all of the churches could cooperate and might have an interchange about missionary problems and situations throughout the world.

We got into the National Council of Churches of Christ in 1950. The National Church took us in without consulting the various parishes or priests. We didn't have a chance to vote to get in. We don't have to vote to get out. There seems to be the suggestion that the only way that we can get out is that we must "memorialize General Convention" to let us out. THAT IS NOT TRUE. The only thing that you and I have ever gotten into that we cannot get out of is our families. We had nothing to do with getting into our families - many of us were lucky - and

I AM OUT OF THE COUNCIL OF CHURCHES'

The National Council of Churches, in the last several years, has felt called upon to speak on every subject. It has been very controversial! The National Council in the last 5 weeks has spoken on: capital punishment, artificial insemination (which means birth control), medicine for the aged, against the movie "Operation Abolition" and they CONTINUE TO SAY THEY SPEAK FOR 40,000, OOO PEOPLE!

"It is an organization or agency through which Protestant and Or. thodox churches express their common faith in Jesus Christ and cooperate to focus the light of that faith on all phases of American life. The Council policies are decided by an Assembly. These policies are expressed through pronouncements."

And even though the pronouncements come out we constantly say they do not affect us! But when we have 32 representatives on this Council, and when we spend \$500,000 per year, they had BET-TER speak for us! I bring that up because we are constantly saying that the Episcopal Church gives the National Council of Churches \$25,000 per year. Now this is Church finance, you see. We gave over \$500,000 last year! Don't take my word for it. It is in the 1959 Annual Report of the Protestant Episcopal Church, starting on page 48. Now, you see if a banker were to make a mistake of \$475,000 something might happen to him! Church Finance seems to be different. In fact, there is a saying "when is a business man not a business man." And the answer is, when he is a Vestryman of the Episcopal Church"

And so we find ourselves very much in this thing.

"It passes pronouncements. A pronouncement is a statement of policy or a position, or affirmation of conviction, formally approved by the General Board or General Assembly. It expresses a substantial preponderance of General Board opinion. And there is a strong weight of ethical, moral or religious principle in support of the view ex-pressed."

The General Assembly is made up of 443 clergymen, 251 laymen. You see, the clergy are very generous with your money. We use the money of the laity and we have twice as many members on the Board as do the laity. We are ordained

to control these things. It is very genalous of you to give your money into our keeping. We know we have your souls. And if we were to mess up your souls the way we mess up your money MAY GOD HAVE MERCY UPON YOUR SOULS!

The National Council of Well Churches of Christ has found itself, in the last several days, the object of ridicule - the object of questioning, And I do not plan to get into whether or not there are Communists in the National Council of Churches. Where you have 40,000,000 people there is the bare possibility that a Communist might sneak in! We have on the Board 10 bishops, we have 10 priests, we have 6 laymen, and 6 laywomen. We have 32 votes - again the clergy out-voting the laymen and the laywomen 20 to 12. One of the bishops who represents us on the National Council of Churches is the controversial Bisbop of California; another one is the Bishop of Bethlehem who is taking J. Edgar Hoover to task about capital punishment. And I assure you, of the two, I imagine J. Edgar Hoover knows "just a bit more" about capital punishment than does the Bishop of Bethlehem, Pa. Two of the clergy who are on this Board are extreme liberals, and one belongs to 14 organizations which are on the Un-American Activities list, which are known not to be sympathetic toward the American way of life. There are 32 people speaking for 2,123,110 Episcopalians! These 32 people have more say and more authority than the General Convention! See, it is like the UN. The UN has more say for us than our own Government.

We find ourselves in a group that started out glorious. It was to be an exchange of ideas. Christian brothers were to get together and have a mutual exchange. The Episcopal Church is in it. Do they speak for ME? Do they speak for US? I would say that since we have been in it for over 10 years, since we have paid \$500,000 a year, I would say YES, THEY PROBABLY SPEAK FOR US.

Now, there are several things that are controversial. I do not plan to debate socialized medicine; people more capable than I can do that. I do not plan to depate the Ethnic problem; that has been debated by people not as intelligent as I. One of the problems that the National Louncil of Churches of Christ has spontored is "the breaking down of neighborhoods". I would buy a nice home in langlewood or wherever your nice home might happen to be, then I would move that one. I do not have one. I do not plan to do that, but we have been told

sow to break down your neighborhood!

Now, there is one problem that worries me, brethren, and that is the problem of literature. The NCC has put out a bulletin, a reading list, suggesting some of the reading which would be "good for our children to read". It is called "The Negro American — A Reading List." One of the books on that list is called "Color Blind" and I direct your attention to pages 104-105. I recommend that maidens not read it, or high school boys and girls not read it, because I have slept with it under my pillow for 3 days so that my teenagers would't even see it! IT IS DISGUSTING! Another one of these famous books is "Without Magnolias". These books are in the Public Library! Then another book is "The Walls Came Tumbling Down". This literature has been recommended to our young people, they have been asked to read it. ITS FILTH, IT'S DISGUSTING! Men at the 19th hole at the Country Club wouldn't even mention these subjects.

Another thing that the National Council of Churches has done is that they have asked that the clergy not show the movie "Operation Abolition" because they maintain that the Un-American Activities Committee and the FBI have "framed" this film. Now, Mr. J. Edgar Hoover is not running for any job, he has it made I think. Read his book "Masters of Deceit" and you'll find out whether or not any Communists have gotten into the Church. The Bishop of the Diocese got quite concerned about the movie "Operation Abolition". He wrote Mr. J. Edgar Hoover. May I quote his letter from Mr. Hoover:

"Dear Bishop Mason:

I have received your letter dated March 2, 1961, with its enclosures, and your interest in writing to me is indeed appreciated.

The film 'Operation Abolition' has been sponsored and distributed by the Committee on Un-American Activities, United States House of Representatives and the FBI had no connection with its preparation. Therefore, I cannot comment on this film.

You may be interested, however, in reading the enclosed pamphlet entitled 'Communist Target — Youth' which contains my report concerning the disturbances in San Francisco, California, in May, 1960, in connection with a hearing of this Committee. Additional copies of this pamphlet can be made available to you upon request. I am sure you will agree after reviewing this pamphlet that it clearly illustrates the communist tactics and strategy involved in these disturbances.

In addition to the above pamphlet, I

holosing some material on the menace of communism, available for general distribution by the FBI.

I trust the above information and the enclosed material will be of assistance to you.

Sincerely, s/s J. Edgar Hoover"

I have that pamphlet. In the back of the pamphlet are pictures from the film "Operation Abolition" showing Archie Brown and Brodsky calling out "open the door". I've shown the movie twice, and if there are enough people interested I shall show it again!

On the matter of literature there are two things that I want to read to you. One is a very flippant Lord's Prayer. This is a beatnik type prayer which is sponsored by the National Council of Methodist Youths. I quote:

"LORD'S PRAYER (Teenege Version)

O, daddy, O
Who are the most
Hurrah for your support
My personality integrate,
All my physiques develop,
My mervous system calm,
In body as in mind.
Prepare me new tempo,
Our daily jive, and
Release us from our parents
And other repressed victims.
Lead us into more self-expression
And much less boredom,
For you are the coolest,
Gonest, and hepest drive
From mow on."

That is the Lord's Prayer. I quote another one. This is by Langston Hughes. Langston Hughes is one of the authors that the National Council of Churches of Christ recommends. They list no less than 6 books of his that you should read if you are to be intelligent. I am afraid that I shall die ignorant! This one is called:

"GOOD-BY CHRIST
Listen, Christ,
You did all right in your day,
I reckon —
But that day's gone now.
They ghosted you up a swell story,
too.
Called it the Bible —
But it's dead now.
The popes and the preachers 'ee
Made too much money from it.
They've sold you to too many
Kings, generals, robbers, and killers —
Even to the Tser and the Cossachs,
Even to the SATURDAY EVENING
POST.



#### THE EICHMANN TRIAL : CUI BONO?

The most sensational murder trial in the history of the world has occupied the head-line space of the international press. Opinions, pro and con, are on the printed record: some feel that the arrest and abduction, in the realm of the sovereign State of Argentina, is juridically untenable and even dangerous; some feel that for one State to reach into the jurisdiction of another for an act of revenge (no matter how justifiable) establishes a precedent which destroys the concept of political asylum; and some feel that it opens the way for a ruthless super-State, like Russia, to do likewise with political opponents. In fact, this was

done in the murder of Trotsky in Mexico.

There is little argument that the accused represents a monstrous era, the Hitlerian mass-murder, or that Jewry can be blamed for exacting a belated, though repetitious retribution. On the other hand, the War-Crimes Tribunals and subsequent judicial punitive actions in West Germany have tried and convicted the master-minds of genocide. This is a plain case of whipping a dead horse - Hitler. The question arises immediately as to the purpose and the calculated or incidental effect of this trial, staged with all the fanfare and techniques of modern communications media. The ancient Roman query: "Cui Bono" is almost inescapable: "Who will benefit" from this sudden exposure? The Roman law, basis of Western jurisprudence, shrewdly looks for the 'profit motive, the beneficiaries" in an otherwise obscure action. We confess to complete bafflement. A revival of the Hitler horrors is bound to boomerang on West Germany, which has made superhuman efforts to make restitution: Hundreds of millions of dollars have poured into Israel, in war damages and claims. Continuous Court actions are in process to punish responsible Nazis connected with concentration camps and other crimes.

By comparison, the absolutely identical "programs" of Czars and Commissars, the mass murders in the Ukraine, the equally horrible Russian slave camps in Siberia, etc. were not equated at any time, in the national or foreign

press.

Responsible Israeli are aware of the inflammatory potential of this trial. President David Ben Gurion was emphatic in his declaration: "... Modern Germany, the Germany of Adenauer and the Social Democrats is not Hitler's Germany...". The Israel Minister of Justice, Dr. Pinhas Rosen stated: "... The people of Israel know precisely that a distinction must be made between Hitler's era and West Germany today. The Eichmann trial will be useful to educate other nations not to become embroiled in a similar guilt..."

West German officials have been aware, of course, of the implications of this sensational event. Chancellor Dr. Adenauer appeared on a television program, speaking as follows: "... We have been troubled in our mind, after the collapse of the Hitler regime, how we could eradicate the poisonous remnants of this tragedy. Our feeling was one of shame and bitter liverse. We immediately offered the widest reparation for the Hitler victims. In 1952 we formulated a program of direct help in the development of the State of Israel. This has been mutually satisfactory. Then we started to work on our own reconstruction. We have shifted from the nightmare of 'National-Socialism' to a state based on Law and Order . . ."

He pointed out to American reporters at a Press Conference, that "... Eichmann was not a German national, hence not subject to the German Courts, now handling war crimes. There is no doubt that the trial will engender damaging repercussions. We will have to bear them patiently ..."

Willy Brandt, Mayor of Berlin and candidate for the upcoming national elections (the opponent of Dr. Adenauer), also commented on the Eichmann process: "... It is our duty to acquaint our younger generation with just what took place in those tragic years... as an object lesson in tyranny. On the other hand, we in Germany need not be afraid of this trial and assume general responsibility for the crimes depicted. We must be especially alert not to unload responsibility for this era on the German Youth of today, which had no connection with these crimes of State. The new electorate voting this fall, were only four years old, when the war ended in 1945..."

American opinion is difficult to assess. We may have picked the wrong editorial — but we like the "National Review," a sharp, biting journalism that flickers with the luster of literature, the classic "belles lettres" with undertones of frustrated bitterness. "There is underway a studied attempt to cast suspicion on Germany." Note a letter to the New Statesman (whatever values one cares to assess to letter-writers) . . . "Adenauer's aims of rearming Germany, opposing an East-West settlement, have the same aims that Hitler had before the war." Drang Nach Osten

### PART II NIMROD AND IDOLATRY

Idolatry—like man—like sin—did not get here through a process of evolution. It didn't get here on the installment plan. Idolatry—like man—like sin—came here suddenly, and full grown.

Idolatry originated with Nimrod. He is the father of idolatry—as he is the father of monarchy, of the world state, of the world church.

What is an idol? It is an image. What is an image? An image is an imitation or likeness of a person or a thing. Idol worship is the worship of the image of an ultimate person. Behind the image, always, there is a person.

It might be argued that this is not true. There is the image of the serpent, the symbol of wisdom. There can be no ultimate person behind the serpent.

This appears to be true. But only on the surface. Follow the trail of the serpent as an object of worship to its origin and you will find yourself standing before a person. The serpent is associated with fire worship. The god Phoroneus was the "inventor of fire." Behind the mythical Phoroneus there is a person—a man. That man is Nimrod.

Who is the greatest god of the ancient world? Tammuz, meaning "the son of life." He was worshipped throughout Babylon, in Assyria, Phoenicia, Palestine. In Plato's day Tammuz was regarded as identical with Osiris. Tammuz has been identified with Adonis. Tammuz was the king of the nether world. He was the god of the pasture, the patron of flocks and their keepers, and was himself shepherd—the chief shepherd. He died annually and returned to life with each recurring year.

Tammuz met a violent death. The women of Egypt wept for him as Osiris. The Phoenician women wept for him as Tammuz, and so did the Jewish women.

He said also unto me, Turn thee yet again and thou shalt see greater abominations that they do. Then he brought me to the door of the gate of the Lord's house which was toward the north; and, behold, there sat women weeping for Tammuz.

- Ezekiel 8:13f.

In Greece and Rome the women lamented him as Tammuz and Bacchus. The most beautiful love story of Babylon was that of the grief of Ishtar for her lover Tammuz.

Among the flowers of the garden he is abandoned.

Among the mulberry-trees he sleeps.

We are steeped in woe for his sake.

The great original of Tammuz was Nimrod.

The great original of Ishtar was Nimrod's wife, Semiramus.

Listen to one of the great authorities on that ancient world:

Bil-Nipru is probably the Biblical Nimrod, the original founder of the monarchy, the "mighty bunter" and conqueror. At the same time, however,

that he is this here deified, he represents also, as the second god of the first Triad, the classical Jupiter. He is "the supreme," "the father of the gods," "the procreator," "the Lord" par excellence, "the king of all the spirits," "the Lord of the world," and again, "the Lord of all the countries" ("Ancient Monarchies," by George Rawlinson, Vol 1, p 118).

Idolatry originated with the death of Nimrod—a violent death. His wife, the grand original of all the Jezebels, made her husband and herself objects of worship.

#### WHAT IS IT?

What is idolatry? It is a perversion of true worship. Consider the name of Nimrod's wife—Semiramus.

"Semi" - that is "Shem."

"Ra"—that was the great god of the sun and the chief deity of Egypt.

"Semiramus" — the God of Shem.

What is the leading hotel in Cairo? The Semiramus.

It is Satan come to town again—sitting in the place of God, directing the worship to himself instead of God.

#### THE RELEVANCY OF IT

The origin of idolatry is not only history, it is prophecy. "As it was — so shall it be."

Idolatry had a personal beginning. It began with a man. It will reach its climax, its culmination, in a man.

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
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



FBI Director, L. Edgar Hoover has condemned "unfounded" charges of communist infiltration of churches. Writing in the Crusader, American Baptist newsmagazine, he stressed that this is not the time "for name-calling, for unfounded accusations or publicity-seeking charges designed to confuse, divide, and weaken."

Observing that America's clergy "are today doing a magnificent job," Mr. Hoover said that they are "helping to preserve the dignity of man as the image of God, and to mold the individual to be a worthy citizen in a democracy." Because communists know that churches "stand as powerful obstacles in their path," the director said, they are constantly engaging in "violent attacks against religion, against the church, and against clergymen.

"As long as men have faith in God," he continued, communism "can never completely subjugate the individual to the diotates of the Party."



Asked about the threats reported by Rev. Linnerson, Bishop Kennedy pointed out that he had not heard about the incident, but if it occurred as described in the police reter port "it's a funny kind of Christianity."

Questioned about ACCC policy and its attacks on the NCC, the Methodist official said, "We don't pay much attention to the group. Everybody knows what kind of group it is. It seems to have attacks on the National Counthis cil as its main purpose for existence."

# FBI: Wide Communist Infiltration in Churches a 'Falsehood'

Once again charges of Communistic infiltration are being hurled against U.S. churches. Here statements from the FBI show how such wild claims by anti-Communist "vigilantes" are actually welcomed by the Reds.

# By LOUIS CASSELS,

No rational person can be a sincere Christian and a sincere Communist.

Communists know this. That is why they persecute Christian churches—sometimes openly, sometimes subtly—in every country in which they have gained power, from Russia to Cuba.

In free nations like America, Communists cannot suppress the churches but must think of other tactics.

Undoubtedly they have tried in the past to infiltrate churches by having diaguised Communists work their way up to leadership, particularly in the clergy.

They have learned that this is easier said than done. It is difficult for a Communist to pose convincingly as a dedicated Christian even for the space of one conversation, let alone through the long years of seminary study and pulpit service required of any man who becomes an influential leader in U.S. church life.

#### Discredit Leadership.

Although they have falled to infiltrate the churches in any substantial way, there is evidence that the Communists like it when charges are made that they actually have done so.

The Communists know that in the present climate of American feeling, there is no surer way of discrediting the leadership of churches and of sowing confusion and discord among their lay members than for the suspicion to be nourished that a substantial number of Christian clergymen are secret supporters of the Communist conspiracy.

You may think all of this is far-fetched. But the Federal Bureau of Investigation does not.

FBI director J. Edgar Hoover is deeply concerned about the danger that self-appointed "vigilantes" may, in the name of anti-communism, play into the Communists' hands.

During the past few weeks, Mr. Hoover has sent FEE Chief Inspector William C. Sullivan to deliver speeches in many parts of the nation, warning Americans not to be taken in by charges that their churches are overrun with Reds.

#### Charge Is 'Talsehood.'

"These allegations have served to create the impression among many Americans that the Protestant denominations in particular have been subjected to alarming infiltration and influence," Mr. Sullivan says.

"But this is a patent falsehood. The truth is that the Communist party has not achieved any substantial success in exerting domination, control or influence over America's clergymen or religious institutions on a national scale."

Mr. Sullivan is not making this statement on his own authority. He is speaking with the full approval and personal backing of Mr. Hoover. And the FBI director has so informed a number of amateur Communist hunters, who wrote to him protesting Mr. Sullivan's speeches.

"The most interesting reaction," an FBI official told United Press International, "has been from the Communists. They are very upset by Mr. Sullivan's remarks.

"They love to have wild charges of Communist domination hurled against America's churches. They know that such charges cause consternation, dissension, doubt and fear among church members. And they figure that anyone who succeeds in demoralizing America's churches is aiding their

cause."

Society" (John Birch Society) and wants to use a letter from the Director in an argument against the editor of the Columbus, Ohio, "Catholio Times." She requested information on communist infiltration of churches and the National Council of Churches.





Dear Mr. Hoover:

When I showed Operation Abolition in a losel Presbyterian Church and aswered the questions that the National Council of Churches of Christ had raised against it, without once naming or calling any churchman a communist, their minister accused me of "McCarthyism" (which I received as an unintended compliment) and read from Christian Century the statement that William C. Sullivan of the FBI had stated there were no communists in the clergy.

A week later the local newspaper editor encircled for me in the Catholic publication "America" the same statement. i.e. William C. Sullivan, FBI, gives the churches, the councils, the clergy, a clean bill as to communist infiltration.

Last Sunday in my own Episcopal church the rector read the Daocesan pastoral letter (which had to be read in all the churches of the diocese then and next Sunday) stating that you, J. Edgar Hoover, had sent Wm. C. Sullivan on a speaking tour of the nation to refute the allegations by (what else?) irresposible persons and organizations that communists had infiltrated the churches and the clergy.

This was such a remarkable statement, e.g., that you had sent a representative of the FBI to refute the claims of communist penetration within the organization we both know they must penetrate to destroy us, that I just had to write you to ask whether the statement was true...did you send Wm. C. Sullivan in a speaking tour to refute communist infiltration in the churches?

This is so out of keeping of with your own statements; and your testimony at various times before congressional committees, and the statements and testimony of Philbrick whom you personnally recommended to me as a speaker for our PTA that I won't believe what I heard in two churches and read in three church publications until I hear or read it-from you.

I know you have far more important matters than this: I have the temerity to hope for the same gracious reply with which you have favored me on other occassions.

In his letter of June 14, makes caustic remarks concerning a letter sent over the Director's signature on June 9, 1961, to the effect that the Director did not write it and that a direct answer to his inquiry was avoided. He criticizes Assistant Director Sullivan's remarks saying that, 'many of us do not agree" with Mr. Sullivan including the Un-American Activities Committee. 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

I have received your letter of June 12, with enclosures. I want to thank you and for the benefit of your observations and your kind prayers.

You are possibly referring to the speech made by Assistant Director William C. Sullivan on February 22, 1961, at Cincinnati, Ohio, regarding communism and religion. I am enclosing an outling of Mr. Sullivan speech, as well as other material dealing with the general subject of subversion which may be of interest.

In response to your specific inquiry concerning my statement of apprehension over the communists having ministers of the gospel promote their work, I would like to point out that this quotation was taken out of context and, therefore, does not reflect the complete meaning which was intended. 

I attach hereto an item clipped from a local church paper headed FBI EXONERATES CHURCHES.

I have before me a news article from Philadelphia Inquirer, May 21st which purports to report information given out of your office via a hearing by the House Appropriations Subcommittee March 6, 1961, from which I quote: "The FBI Director said the Communist Party within the past year has stepped up its activities ... They (the Communists) have infiltrated every conceivable spere of activity: Youth groups, radio, television and motion pictures, church, school, educational groups. the press, national minority groups, and civil and political units, etc."

I also have before me a lengthy speech by one Dr. Eugene Carson Blake, Stated Clerk, United Presbyterian Churches, USA. Said speech given et the West Adams Presbyterian Church, Los Angeles, California, May 2, has been widely circulated and is being quoted throughout the nation.

Quotes: "During the past few weeks, Mr. Hoover has sent FBI Chief Thapector William C. Sullivan to deliver speeches in many parts of the nations warning Americans not to be taken in by charges that their churches are overrun by Reds."

Widespread allegations of Communist infiltration of the Protestant ministry ... of the leadership of National Council of Churches, is a brazen falsehood ... stupid and decadent white Protestants etc.,

I also have before me your books "Masters of Deceit" under pages 324 thru 328 where you discuss methods used by our enemy in infiltrating the churche and instructions handed out as to how to do it.

Based on the above conflicting information, I would appreciate it if will convey some clarifying data either in pamphlet form or a direct clarifying statement to indicate your position. 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FBI EXÒNERĂTES CHURCHES . The Federal Bureau of Investigation has recently issued a statement exonerating protestant churches and church organizations, such as the National Council of Churches, of being infiltrated by Communism. These charges have been made in recent days with such vehemence that apparently a denial became necessary. The following is the statement: "These allegations have served to create the impression among many Americans that the protestant denominations in particular have been subjected to alarming infiltration and influence, but this is a patent falsehood. The truth is that the Communist Party has not achieved any substantial success in exerting domination, control, or influence over America's clergymen or religious institutions on a national scale." Another FBI official has indicated that many of the charges against the National Council of Churches and other protestant groups have been in fact Communist inspired so as to destroy American confidence in Christianity. The quote is as follows: "They love to have wild charges of Communistic domination hurled against America's churches. They know that such charges cause consternation, dissension, doubt and fear among church members, and they figure that anyone who succeeds in demoralizing America's churches is aiding their cause.

In view of your interest I am enclosing some material dealing with the general subject of communism which you may like to read. I am enclosing your pamphlet.



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# Editorials

Despite all the hoop-la, including pickets, full-page advertisements in newspapers, student riots in colleges and solemn declamations by some of our more naive professors, the backers of "Operation Abolition," designed to end the House Committee on Un-American Activities, managed to corral only six votes. Even Rep. Jimmy Rossevelt of California, who started out as the sponsor of the abolition movement, finally settled for an effort to curtail the committee's appropriation. That didn't get anywhere either.

Those who expected some other restilt have overlooked symptoms at the grass roots, which members of Congress, perhaps even including Jimmy Roosevelt, have been quick to detecta quiet but unmistakable impatience with politicians and others who, for whatever reason appeals to them, object to investigations of the Communist conspiracy. For one thing, there has been a shift in college and university opinion. Young conservatives are no longer succred at -- anyway not so often !

On the literary front, Allen Drury's novel, Advise and Consent (Doubleday), which suggests that liberal statesmen can play some pretty dirty pool, is doing a land-office business; and in New York the play based on Mr. Drury's book has been a sellout. Rumore that the play might be toned down because "liberals" didn't like it were emphatically blown down by Mr. Drury. John Dos Passos's exciting novel Midentury (Houghton, Mifflin), in which the tyranny of some labor unions over their own members is dramatically portrayed, is another best seller. A few years back, books like these would have been hard to come by in many bookstores if you didn't know the manager.

In several universities conservative student magazines have appeared. An Impressive representative of this new group is Analysis, published by students at the University of Pennsylvania. The writers in the first issue of Analysis are not all students. Prof. A. H. Hobbs of the Sociology Department is a contributor. The students, however, dissect their ideas with freshness and frankness and without invective like that credited to a member of Students for Democratic Action who declared that student conservatives displayed "the social conscience of a Hitler, a Stalin or a Barry Goldwater"!

In Jimmy Roosevelt's own state an interesting movement recently got into orbit, launched at the outset by Walter )

A. Wolford, city clerk of San Gilbriel Mr. Wolford first persuaded his city council to adopt a resolution citing the peril of Communist inflitration and urging "rededication of all loyal Americans to the principles and ideals of our founding fathers." He then formed a committee which put on a mass meeting, the main feature of which was the showing of Operation Abelition, the documentary moving alignment last year's riots against the Un-American Activities Committee in San Francisco. Thr place was packed. Since then a score of California communities have taken similar action.

Mr. Wolford insists that his idea is not to promote "witch hunting" or merely to make people angry. The program he advocated includes education, with special emphasis on seeing to it that public libraries and school libraries have reliable books on the history, ideology and purposes of Communism. Whatever curren of this particular effort, it represents a straw in the wind which members of Congress undoubtedly felt blowing strongly when they voted on the resolution to put an end to the House Un-American Activities Committee.

Of course, the battle isn't over. Queer characters still appear on college campuses sponsored by "liberal" groups. Nevertheless, as the response to City Clerk Wolford's crusade suggents, America arems to be catching
