

The indictment alleges the defendants conspired to murder, bomb and maim. Specifically, the defendants were part of an international terrorist group dedicated to opposing non-Islamic governments with force and violence. The group calling itself "AL-QAEDA" was formed by defendants UBL and Muhammad Atef and others. It was a part and an object of said conspiracy that the defendants, and others known and unknown would and did murder United States nationals anywhere in the world. In furtherance of said conspiracy, and to effect the illegal objects thereof, the following overt acts, among others were committed:

Guesthouses and training camps for Al-Qaeda and its affiliated groups were established. American citizens were recruited in order to utilize the American citizens for travel. Surveillance of embassies took place. Financial dealings took place on behalf of Al-Qaeda, including, but not limited to: purchasing land for training camps; purchasing explosives; purchasing communication equipment; and transporting currency and weapons to members of Al-Qaeda worldwide.

Due to the large amount of documents being generated in the above referenced case files and the variety of classification levels involved, New York is requesting all offices proceed under the following guidelines when generating paperwork on these matters.

In addition, it is unknown if Ressam was acting on behalf of a specific terrorist group/sponsor. Ressam and some of his conspirators have been linked to the overall Sunoi Islamic extremists network.





We kindly ask for the Mabahith's assistance in providing us with a copy of this interview, if possible, and extend our sincere thanks.





Usama Bin Ladin is one of the most significant sponsors of Islamic extremists activities in the world today. He is the son of Saudi construction magnate Muhammad Bin Ladin, founder of the Saudi Arabian Bin Ladin Group business empire.

Bin Ladin joined the Afghan resistance movement almost immediately following the 12/26/79 Soviet invasion of Afghanistan. He gained prominence during the Afghan war for his role in financing the recruitment, transportation and training of Arab nationals who volunteered to fight alongside the Afghan mujahedin.

Following the withdrawal of the Soviets from Afghanistan in 1989, Bin Ladin continued to support militant Islamic groups who had begun to target moderate Islamic governments in the region. Bin Ladin drew on his family's wealth to organize these extremist groups and fund camps in Afghanistan and Pakistan to provide new recruits with paramilitary training.


Saudi officials seized Bin Ladin's passport from 1989 until 1991 in an attempt to prevent him from combining forces with extremists whom he met during the Afghan war. He relocated to Sudan in 1991.


In February 1994, Saudi Arabia revoked Bin Ladin's Saudi citizenship for behavior that "contradicts the Kingdom's interests and risks harming its relations with fraternal countries"

As Bin Ladin's business interests expanded so did his financial support for Islamic extremist groups.

Bin Ladin formed a London-based dissident organization in July 1995, called the "Advisory and Reformation Committee," which has issued pamphlets critical of the Saudi Government.

Pakistani investigators noted in March 1995 that Ramzi Ahmad Yousef, the terrorist who masterminded the 1993 World Trade Center bombing, resided at a Bin Ladin funded guesthouse in Peshawar during most of the three years before his apprehension.

A leading member of the Egyptian extremist group al-Jihad, claimed in a July 1995 interview with Egyptian journalists that Bin Ladin helped fund al-Jihad and was at times aware of specific terrorist operations mounted by the group against Egyptian interests. According to alleged terrorists, recently captured by Egyptian authorities, Bin Ladin also remains the key financier behind the "Kunar" camp in Afghanistan which provides terrorist training to al-Jihad and Al-Gamma al-Islamiyyah members.

In early 1996 Bin Ladin was asked to leave Sudan at which time he moved to Afghanistan where he remains today.

In a May 1997 interview with Bin Ladin, he declared jihad against the U.S. Government. He stated that his group had focused his declaration of jihad against soldiers in the country of the two holy places (Saudi Arabia). He went on to say that even though American civilians are not targeted they must leave.

Bin Ladin's support for extremist causes has continued despite criticisms from regional governments. Algeria, Egypt and Yemen have accused Bin Ladin of financing militant Islamic groups in their own countries.

Bin Ladin has publicly claimed credit for the bombing of the OPM Sang facility in Saudi Arabia and the attack on U.S. servicemen in Somalia during Operation Restore Hope. Bin Ladin recently joined with several other terrorist organizations in issuing a FATWA urging Muslims to strike and kill U.S. citizens everywhere as a religious duty.


Saudi officials seized Bin Ladin's passport from 1989 until 1991 in an attempt to prevent him from combining forces with extremists whom he met during the Afghan war. He relocated to Sudan in 1991.


In February 1994, Saudi Arabia revoked Bin Ladin's Saudi citizenship for behavior that "contradicts the Kingdom's interests and risks harming its relations with fraternal countries"

As Bin Ladin's business interests expanded so did his financial support for Islamic extremist groups.

Bin Ladin formed a London-based dissident organization in July 1995, called the "Advisory and Reformation Committee," which has issued pamphlets critical of the Saudi Government.

Pakistani investigators noted in March 1995 that Ramzi Ahmad Yousef, the terrorist who masterminded the 1993 World Trade Center bombing, resided at a Bin Ladin funded guesthouse in Peshawar during most of the three years before his apprehension.







A leading member of the Egyptian extremist group al-Jihad, claimed in a July 1995 interview with Egyptian journalists that Bin Ladin helped fund al-Jihad and was at times aware of specific terrorist operations mounted by the group against Egyptian interests. According to alleged terrorists, recently captured by Egyptian authorities, Bin Ladin also remains the key financier behind the "Kunar" camp in Afghanistan which provides terrorist training to al-Jihad and Al-Gamma al-Islamiyyah members.

In early 1996 Bin Ladin was asked to leave Sudan at which time he moved to Afghanistan where he remains today.

In a May 1997 interview with Bin Ladin, he declared jihad against the U.S. Government. He stated that his group had focused his declaration of jihad against soldiers in the country of the two holy places (Saudi Arabia). He went on to say that even though American civilians are not targeted they must leave.

Bin Ladin's support for extremist causes has continued despite criticisms from regional governments. Algeria, Egypt and Yemen have accused Bin Ladin of financing militant Islamic groups in their own countries.

Bin Ladin has publicly claimed credit for the bombing of the OPM Sang facility in Saudi Arabia and the attack on U.S. servicemen in Somalia during Operation Restore Hope. Bin Ladin recently joined with several other terrorist organizations in issuing a FATWA urging Muslims to strike and kill U.S. citizens everywhere as a religious duty.


