You will need to install this on the client pc you are using to view the footage. The file called "reviewplayer.mz.zip" is an install-less video client that will let you view the files without actually installing the software on the pc.

I am the network engineer at MIT in charge of the video surveillance platform used for the building 16 security incident. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) dropped me a note saying that there are no timestamps on the video files that we gave you. There should be several different types of exported footage consisting of avi files and ova files. It looks as though the NVR did not embed the review player software in the directory that we gave you. The review player software allows you to play the ova files which contains all the timestamp information and allows you to scroll through more efficiently.

I am going to work on exporting another copy of this software and I will try sending it to you. Worst case scenario I may need to drop it off at your office on cd/dvd.
