At approximately 9:30 AM, Charles E. Maibach, Chairman of the Board and President, Prospect National Bank, Peoria, Illinois, received telephone call at the bank from male who stated, "You have an emergency, call home", and hung up. Maibach immediately dialed his home phone number, and the same person answered the phone stating he was the emergency and gave him instructions to take all the money from the bank, place it in a bag, and immediately within five minutes, proceed to a telephone booth approximately one mile from the bank where he would receive further instructions. The caller advised Maibach he should not notify the police and not do anything foolish, as the money was insured and he was being watched. Maibach imme-diately placed \$31,500 in a bank bag, which amount included b7E and proceeded to the telephone booth where he received instructions to go to a second telephone booth for further instructions. Upon arrival at the second telephone booth, Maibach was instructed to proceed approximately one block further and place the bag behind a blue trash receptacle at a Wendy's hamburger stand and then go home and make any necessary calls he would have to make. Maibach dropped the money off and left the area; and upon arriving at home, found out was safe at the residence and knew nothing be about the incident.

Investigation reflected Maibach's home telephone line had been interrupted with a pinpoint phone connector as his lines had been cut on the exterior of his house and the person talking to Mr. Maibach at the bank had apparently intercepted the call at the site of his residence.

No surveillance of the money drop was made, and subjects developed to date have been eliminated.



Under the provisions of Part III (B), of the Attorney General's Memorandum of September 22, 1980, to the Heads of Executive Departments and Agencies entitled, "Monitoring Private Conversations with the Consent of a Party," emergency monitoring was instituted under the authorization of an appropriate official of the FBI.

Monitoring of this conversation was authorized in the best interest of law enforcement in that it was expected to provide corroborative evidence and to protect the individual utilizing the equipment.

Further monitoring is expected in this matter and it is requested that your office approve the use of this equipment for a period of 30 days beginning the date on which you grant approval.

A search of the Carl DeTienne residence, 723 North Monroe, Peoria, Illinois, and of their cabin located at Goofy Ridge, Illinois, was conducted on 12/9/82, in an attempt to recover items of evidence related to the bank extortion with negative results.

Contact has been maintained with since the incident, but he has been unable to provide any additional positive information of value relative to the bank extortion matter.
