1. The Telephone Circuit Analysis Course, Sheppard AFB, Texas, will be reinstated in the near future. Your organization is invited to participate in this course. Classes of three weeks duration will begin 3 June 1964 and a class will be held each month thereafter through April 1965, with the exception of December 1964. Classes are limited to eight students each, and our objective is to fill each class with qualified students.
2. The course has been revised to include foreign telephones. It will emphasize the telephone instrument and telephone system, with minimum time being spent on central office and key equipment. Attached for your information is an abbreviated course outline.
3. Requests for space in these classes will be directed to this office. Request you advise not later than 10 May of your space desires for the June and July classes, and 60 days in advance of subsequent classes. Please include the name and telephone number of an individual who may be contacted for each request you submit, in addition to the name of the individual to attend the course.
