By teletype dated March 5, 1950, the New York Office advised that Gertrude Crosby was believed to be identical with Gertrude Crosby Rowen, 446 East 20th Street, New York City.

The husband of Gertrude Crosby Rowen is Phillip S. Rowen, wa. Rosenzweig. He is employed as Office Manager for a rug manufacturer in New York. The New York files reflect that one Philip Rowen, Legislative Committee, United Office and Professional Workers of America, Local 16, New York, New York, in 1944 signed a letter to the Oklahoma State Attorney General protesting the prosecution of four Oklahoma Communists on charges of criminal syndicalism.

Gertrude Crosby Rowen is now employed as a statistician for Alexander Sachs, 72 Wall Street, New York City. The size of this firm, or the exact relationship between Gertrude Crosby Rowen and her employer are unknown. Sachs, according to Who's Who, is an economist, and was born in Russia. He was Vice President of Lehman Brothers from 1936 to 1942 and Economic Adviser to the Petroleum Industrial War Council from 1942 to 1943. He lectured at the New School for Social Research in 1939. (U)

The files of the New York Office reflect that Alexander Sachs returned a telephone call made to him by Andre Visson, whose true name is Isidore Marie Akiysson. This occurred during the period from October 7 to October 14, 1949, while Visson was at the Hotel Plaza, New York City, where he stayed upon his return from a trip to Europe. (U)

Regarding Akiysson



The Bureau's files contain no references to Gertrude Crosby Rowen or to Phillip S. Rosensweig. There is a reference to a Senora Rosensweig in Mexico as of August 29, 1943, and a Mrs. Rosensweig, 2109 Olive Avenue, Los Angeles, California, as of May, 1947, but neither of these are identifiable with Gertrude Crosby Rowen. (U)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the New York Office be authorized to interview Gertrude Crosby Rowen to determine whether she was an employee of the British Diffusion Mission in New York City, and if so, to obtain from her all knowledge she may have of the activities of Fuchs. The interview also will develop the identities of the other employees of the British Diffusion Mission in order that they might also be interviewed for their knowledge of Fuchs' activities. (U)

Canada Spy Probe Seen Fuchs Conviction Link

By DOUGLAS HOW

Ottawa, March 3 (CP).—Canada's 1946 espionage probe is believed to have furnished a vital piece of evidence that helped lead to the conviction of Dr. Klaus Fuchs, the German-born British atomic scientist who got 14 years in prison this week for spying for Russia.

Both RCMP and Justice Department officials have refused comment on London reports that have attributed the trapping of Fuchs to a Soviet agent's notebook unearthed by the Mounties' counter-espionage men.

It was learned, however, from unofficial but reliable sources that Fuchs' name was found in a notebook or other document the Mounties dug up in connection with the 1946 probe. The document was among a considerable amount of material that was never made public either in the report of a Royal commission or the celebrated spy trials that grew out of it.

There have been at least two versions of the London story. One is that British Intelligence became aware there was a leak of information from the Harwell, England, atomic plant and that the Fuchs' name on the staff list struck a bell in the head of a man who had seen evidence piled up in connection with the Canadian cases.

Another is that it was the finding of Fuchs' name in the notebook that touched off the whole investigation last year.

Regardless of which version is more accurate, Fuchs' name is listed in a notebook or diary that came into the hands of the RCMP's special branch. A possible answer is that once suspicion was born that there was an atomic leak in Britain a thorough search was made of all available material including the piles of public and secret evidence accumulated for the 1946 prosecu-

tions in Canada that sent 10 persons to prison.

Fuchs' name, apparently, was one of many in that wealth of material for which there was (at the time) no connecting link in the evidence produced by the key witness, Igor Gouzenko, the Russian Embassy cipher clerk whose flight in September, 1945, was the trigger for the whole thing.

It was overlooked or written off or earmarked for future scrutiny.

Its significance now is an indication of one of the larger lessons that emerged from the report of a two-man Royal commission in 1946—that the espionage was considerably larger than that bared in the report or the Canadian trials and that a considerable number of names were divulged which have never been made public.

Further available information indicates that Mark was a contact of Alan Nunn May, Norman Venet, Raymond Boyer, and Francis L. Chubb, all of whom were implicated in the Corbett case.

[redacted], a native-born American citizen and professor at [redacted] University, [redacted], called at the Consulate to give information concerning his acquaintance with the Fuchs family. Professor [redacted] was in Berlin for the American Friends Society from 1936 to 1938, during which time, he said, he knew the Fuchs family intimately. Professor Emil Fuchs, father of Klaas Fuchs, was in the United States during most of 1949 at The Friends School, Pendle Hill, Wallingford, Pennsylvania, the visit having been arranged by the American Friends at Kirschweg 25, Frankfort-Eschersheim.

Professor Fuchs visited Professor [redacted] in Canada in March 1949 and he expressed great pride in achievements of his son, Klaas. Professor [redacted] stated that Professor Fuchs informed him at that time that he was contemplating accepting a post in Leipzig. Fuchs was a Lutheran minister who had turned Quaker, according to [redacted]. He stated he was an extremely devout man of her high principles and accepted the Leipzig post with the hope that he might be able to instill Christian principles into a few of the theological students there. [redacted] claims that Fuchs told him he had informed his prospective employers in Leipzig of his beliefs and his purpose in accepting the post, but he was, nevertheless, invited to take the post. Professor [redacted] sincerely believes that Professor Fuchs is not a Communist and has no Communist leanings.

Professor [redacted] recalls, however, that Professor Fuchs expressed to him in 1936 to 1938 his great concern that his children, two sons and two daughters, had Communist tendencies. Of the four children, the only one who was probably not a Communist was a daughter, Elizabeth, who committed suicide in the fall of 1948. She was married to Klaas Kittowski, a German Communist, who was arrested by the Nazis and convicted of taking friends across the German border. He was sentenced to six years in prison but escaped to Czechoslovakia without completing the sentence.

The other daughter, Cristal (Christine) Fuchs, came to

the United States in 1937 with the assistance of the American Friends Society, as the father wished her to be away from the influences which surrounded her in Germany. She attended Swarthmore College in Pennsylvania. She subsequently married Robert B. Heineman, who resides at 94 Lakeview Avenue, Cambridge, Massachusetts. Her husband is, [redacted] thinks, in the laundry business. Professor [redacted] referred to newspaper accounts that Klaas Fuchs visited his sister in Boston and is reported to have given out secret information while in that city. Communist Friheten under the headline "The Atom Spy Fuchs - a Cog in the Cold War" wrote on February 23 that the many contradictory American press reports on the so-called Fuchs Affair in London reveal that the whole case is a grand-style provocation staged for certain political purposes. "In the first place Fuchs' information could not have been of very much importance to the Russians, since it has been proved that the Soviet Union possessed the essential secrets concerning production of atomic bombs in 1940.

"According to reports now available Fuchs ceased to provide the Russians with information a year ago and his conscience obviously pressed him to contact the British authorities in October last year. However, despite the importance of his confessions and the nature of the work he performed, no one thought of arresting him until February 2 this year. The publicizing of the Fuchs affair at this time must be seen in connection with President TRUMAN's order to start production of the hydrogen bomb. This decision exposed Truman and his atomic bomb politicians to a stronger public criticism than ever before. They were in need of a sensation which could split the resistance against their policy.

"The Fuchs case was an excellent pretext to accelerate the war hysteria and agitation, a combination which has helped President Truman out of many a tight corner."

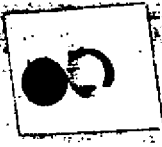

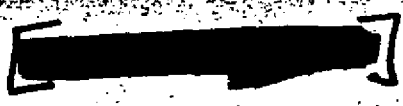

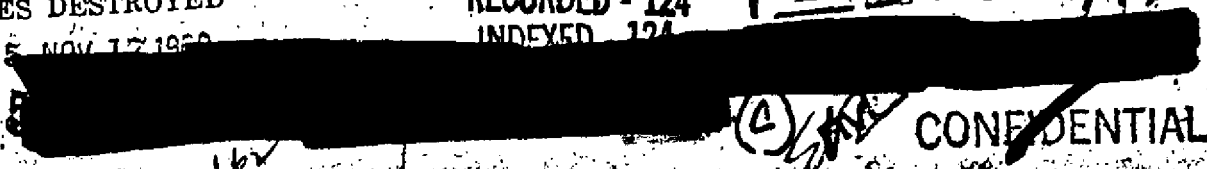

The Boston report of SA FREDERICK M. CONNORS, dated May 20, 1947, reflects that MANSON BENEDICT was acquainted with ISADOR AMDUR. In this respect the Bureau's attention is particularly directed to Boston letter to Bureau dated September 25, 1948, and entitled, "ISADOR AMDUR, was. - INTERNAL SECURITY - R, Ref. 5 I.S." This letter reflects that AMDUR was acquainted with NORMAN VEALL, Canadian Scientist named by GOUZENKO as a part of the Soviet Espionage System in Canada. (u)

A brief summary of AMDUR's activities has been set forth at page 49, in the report of SA BRENTON S. GORDON, at Boston, dated February 9, 1950, and entitled, "KRISTEL KLAUS HEINEMAN, was., ROBERT B. HEINEMAN, was. - ESPIONAGE-R." (S) b1 (X)

The Bureau's attention is further directed to its file on MANSON BENEDICT's brother, "WILLIAM SIDNEY BENEDICT, was., Physicist, Commerce - LGE." The Boston Division submitted a report on July 12, 1948, by SA BRENTON S. GORDON on the latter case. It reflects that WILLIAM SIDNEY BENEDICT was acquainted with WENDELL HINKLE FURRY, a brother-in-law to ISRAEL HALPERIN. Thumbnail sketches of both FURRY and HALPERIN are contained at pages 50, 51 and 52 of the above mentioned report of SA GORDON in the HEINEMAN case. (u)

An analysis of the foregoing will reflect that the Smyth Report would indicate the possibility, but ^{NOT} necessarily the probability, (TS) that [REDACTED] might well have worked or studied under MANSON BENEDICT. *Per Boston tel 2/16/50. EVL*
The other references will reflect that BENEDICT and his brother were acquainted with both WENDELL FURRY and ISADOR AMDUR. AMDUR and FURRY had established connections with NORMAN VEALL and ISRAEL HALPERIN who were implicated in the CORBY case. b1 (X)

ROBERT HEINEMAN, since the submission of SA GORDON's report concerning him, has admitted to GORDON that he belonged for many years to a Cambridge, Mass., branch of the Communist Party in which both Mrs. AMDUR and Mrs. FURRY were members. He has attended meetings at the

homes of both. He is of the opinion, however, that Mrs. AMDUR has not been an active member for several years and he, himself, claims to have been inactive in the past two or three years. He notes further that he never actually knew WENDELL FURRY and ISADOR AMDUR as Communist Party members. They would absent themselves from their homes when meetings were held therein. He has a personal opinion that they were probably members predicated upon their wives' admission of membership, in their respective presence, and further their whole course of conduct as such as to demonstrate no hostility to the Communist Party, USA. (U)

The foregoing would indicate that an associate of BENEDICT would be, or could be, at least passingly familiar with the circumstances in the HEINEMAN home and with the Party situation and intellectual circles in Cambridge, Mass. (U)

The foregoing information is set forth for the consideration of offices handling leads in endeavoring to identify [REDACTED]. It is noted that the Bureau has earlier advised that it is searching the records of the Atomic Energy Commission for information regarding the technical subject of thermal diffusion, and that the Bureau will set out leads for further investigation predicated upon the results of its liaison with the AEC. Accordingly, no leads are being set out by Boston based on the foregoing notes. It is suggested that the Bureau also consider the above when it receives a summary of information from the AEC. Newark has been furnished with a copy of this letter because MANSON BENEDICT, according to information contained in the Boston file, resided as of 1947 at 465 Topping Hill Road, Westfield, New Jersey. 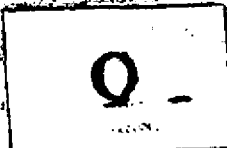

CHILDREN. SHE BELIEVES UNKNOWN SUBJECT HAD TWO CHILDREN LESS THAN
FOUR YEARS OF AGE IN 1945. SISTER'S HUSBAND THINKS FIRST THREE
LETTERS OF UNKNOWN SUBJECT'S NAME WAS XROB, POSSIBLY ROBERTS OR ROBERT-
SON, FIRST NAME JOSEPH. THEY DESCRIBE HIM AS FIVE FEET EIGHT INCHES
IN HEIGHT, ONE SEVENTY TO ONE EIGHTY POUNDS, STOCK BUILD, DARK HAIR,
RECEDING HAIR LINE, IMPRESSION OF BALDNESS. PINE FEATURES, FULL
FACE, CONSERVATIVE DRESS, WORE GLASSES, UNOBTRUSIVE APPEARING, IN
THIRTIES ACCORDING TO SISTER'S HUSBAND, IN FORTIES ACCORDING TO
SISTER, OCCUPATION CHEMIST. FUCHS SAYS UNKNOWN SUBJECT ABOUT FORTY
IN 1945, POSSIBLY FIVE FEET TEN INCHES, FAIRLY BROAD BUILD, ROUND
FACE, NOT NUCLEAR PHYSICIST BUT HAS KNOWLEDGE OF CHEMISTRY AND EN-
GINEERING, NOT INSIDE AE PROJECT, WAS INTERMEDIARY BETWEEN FUCHS AND
RUSSIAN GOVERNMENT. FUCHS THINKS CONTACT POSSIBLY FIRST GENERATION
AMERICAN BUT CANNOT DESCRIBE ANCESTRY. FUCHS WAS IN NEW YORK FROM
DECEMBER 1943 TO AUGUST 12, 1944 AND FROM AUGUST 16, 1944 TO JUNE
1946 WAS AT LOS ALAMOS. FUCHS SAYS ONE MEETING WITH UNKNOWN SUBJECT
