Consideration was given originally to the possibility that Zola Gotthard A. Deutsch was identical with Unsub [redacted] because of Kristel Heineman's statement to the Boston Office on February 2, 1950, that one Deutsch had visited her brother, Emil Julius Klaus Fuchs, while he was at her home in Cambridge, Massachusetts, and that Deutsch was a scientist who had worked with her brother at Oak Ridge. Investigation established that the Deutsch referred to by Kristel Heineman was Martin Deutsch, a resident of Cambridge, Massachusetts, who formerly worked at Los Alamos.

The Boston Division displayed a photograph of Z. G. A. Deutsch to Kristel and Robert Heineman, and both eliminated him as being the unknown chemist who called at their home on two occasions inquiring for Fuchs, and who, on another occasion, visited Fuchs there briefly. It is to be noted that this unknown chemist is believed to be identical with Unsub [redacted] inasmuch as Fuchs now admits that his sister, Kristel, may have witnessed at least one of his meetings with his American contact [redacted]. b1

Preliminary inquiry revealed that Z. G. A. Deutsch is a chemical engineer, was employed by Kellex, Inc., from March 8, 1943, to May 31, 1945, and opened his own consulting engineering firm in New York City early in 1945.

Review of Bureau and AEC files, as set out in the blind memorandum attached hereto, reflects that Z. G. A. Deutsch was born September 13, 1899, in Cincinnati, Ohio, received a degree in chemical engineering from the University of Cincinnati in 1923, and has been engaged in that profession since that time. It also was disclosed that Deutsch had his own consulting engineering office at 420 Lexington Avenue, New York City, for several years prior to going with Kellex in 1943. Nothing believed pertinent to instant investigation was obtained as a result of the file review.

Inasmuch as the photograph of Z. G. A. Deutsch was indicated by the Heinemans not to be that of the unknown chemist who visited their home, and in view of the fact that the Deutsch originally referred to by Kristel Heineman has been determined to be Martin Deutsch, it is recommended that no further consideration be given at this time, on the basis of available information, to the possibility that Zola Gotthard A. Zola G. Deutsch has not been the subject of an investigation by this Bureau. The Bureau's files, as well as the files maintained on Deutsch by the Atomic Energy Commission, a photostatic copy of which has been furnished the Bureau by the Atomic Energy Commission, have been reviewed concerning Deutsch.

The only information in the Bureau's files concerning Deutsch is the following:

Captain Menke of the Manhattan Engineering District, New York, on July 3, 1944, furnished the New York Office with the names of several employees of the Kellogg Corporation, 233 Broadway, New York City, who were employed in connection with the D. S. M. project and who, it was indicated, might be Communistically inclined. Sixteen names were furnished by Mr. Menke, one of which was Zola Gotthard Deutsch.

The New York Office, by teletype of February 6, 1950, entitled, "Exil Julius Klaus Fuchs, was., Espionage - R," advised that the records of Kellogg Corporation, New York City, reflect that Deutsch was employed there from March 8, 1943, to May 31, 1945, as a chemical engineer. A. L. Baker, Vice-President, of Kellogg, advised that Deutsch's work did not concern diffusion, but dealt with corrosion. Baker regarded Deutsch as an excellent chemical engineer, although rather eccentric personally. Baker neither knew of nor suspected any dis-loyal tendencies on the part of Deutsch. He advised that following his termination with Kellogg, Deutsch opened his own consulting engineering firm at 402 Lexington Avenue, New York City, which is still operating. The New York teletype reflected that Deutsch graduated from the University of Cincinnati. It is noted that Baker

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advised that the Kellax Corporation did not handle any thermal diffusion problems, but that they were handled by a United States Navy supervised project #350 at Oak Ridge, Tennessee, and that the engineering personnel was supplied by the H. The Bureau files contain no identifiable disloyal data concerning Max Spitzer, 18 West 41st Street, New York City, nor do the files contain any disloyal data concerning Zola Deutsch's wife, Lily Ortnor Deutsch.

Concerning a Robert Sada of Monterrey, Mexico, the Bureau files contain the following information which might possibly be identical with the Robert Sada with whom Deutsch had business connections in early 1945. A report prepared on September 14, 1945, by SA Wallace F. Estill at Managua, Nicaragua, on Communist infiltration of labor unions, reflects that about 1935, a man named Roberto Sada (Pena) who was an electrical engineer from Mexico came to Nicaragua and posed as a poet and worked for three months as such while he endeavored to organize a Communist Party in Nicaragua. He worked at the Le India Mine for two months as a common laborer trying to organize a Communist Party. He reportedly brought with him a great volume of Communist literature printed in Mexico, and he appeared to be well financed. He was described as a person of dynamic personality and through his efforts, D'Partido Trabajadores Nicaraguenses (an organization long active in the organizing of labor in Nicaragua) became a closely organized and working organization. At that time the leaders of this organization reportedly were instructed in the teaching of Marx and Engel's doctrine, by Sada.

The address of 37 South Wabash Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, is furnished for each listing.

The Information Service advised that no one by the name of KEEFF was listed in connection with this telephone number.

The Certified List of Domestic and Foreign Corporations for the Year 1949 as compiled by the Secretary of State for the State of Illinois in Volume 2, page 3280, has the following listing under foreign corporations:

Leonard Construction Company, 37 South Wabash Avenue, Chicago 3, Illinois.

President C. M. LEONARD, 37 South Wabash Avenue, Chicago.

Secretary, E. S. BOHLIN, 37 South Wabash Avenue, Chicago.

Registered Agent, C. M. LEONARD, 37 South Wabash Avenue, Chicago.

The records of the Chicago Office contained no information pertaining to the officers of the Leonard Construction Company or to CLIFFORD M. LEONARD or the Biltmore Country Club.

-- The Leonard Construction Company was one of the subjects in a Fraud Against the Government investigation in 1943 of which the Los Angeles Office was office of origin, Bureau file 46-2879. The allegations against the Leonard Construction Company were to the effect that in connection with certain contracts in the Panama Canal Zone this construction company, which had its headquarters in Chicago, Illinois, had been paid twice in certain instances by the United States Government or its representatives. The disposition of this case is not included in the information available to the Chicago Office.

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The records of the Chicago Office contained no information pertaining to BILL ABRAMOWITZ under this or any similar spelling.

The telephone number Peabody 2222 listed in connection with the name of ABRAMOWITZ is not a Chicago telephone number. The Information Service of the Illinois Bell Telephone Company advised that Peabody is not used as an exchange anywhere in Illinois.

JOSEPH ARNOLD JOBBINS, AKA JOSEPH REGENSTREICH

Mr. JAMES ROWAN, Assistant to the Vice-President in Charge of Operations, United Air Lines, 5959 South Cicero Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, furnished the following information to Special Agent JOHN A. O'LEARY:

United Air Lines has flown from Chicago to Boston only since May 1, 1945. Prior thereto passengers were handled by United Air Lines from Chicago to New York and by American Air Lines from New York to Boston or by American Air Lines the entire way. Passenger records are maintained by United Air Lines for only four years and are then destroyed. Some reservation lists, however, may be available for the period between August, 1944 and February, 1945. United Air Lines at New York City may also have some records for this period.

Mr. CARL QUARTERBUS, Manager, Revenue Accounting, United Air Lines, Chicago, advised Special Agent O'LEARY that tickets issued by United Air Lines are retained for only three years and then destroyed.

Mr. MIKE O'MALLEY, Reservation Manager, American Air Lines, Monroe and Wabash, Chicago, Illinois, furnished Special Agent JOHN A. O'LEARY the following information:

Reservation records were destroyed by American Air Lines after six months during the period in question and are now destroyed after three months.

The Treasury Department of American Air Lines, 910 South Boston, Tulsa, Oklahoma, may still have tickets, however, for the pertinent period.

Mr. J. KELLY, American Air Lines, Tulsa, Oklahoma, is the person who would have information pertaining to such tickets. American Air Lines in Boston and New York may also have some passenger records or reservation lists for the period in question, but probably do not.

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The above information was obtained by Special Agent JOHN A. O'LEARY on March 10, 1950.

On March 13, 1950 Special Agent O'LEARY and the reporting agent examined the available records pertaining to the period from August, 1944 to February, 1945 of the United Air Lines in an effort to determine whether JOSEPH ARNOLD ROBBINS, also known as Joseph Regenstreich, had made any flight from or to Boston, Massachusetts during the month of August during that period. These records were examined through the co-operation of EDWARD F. PIPER, Supervisor of Building Maintenance, United Air Lines, FRANCIS E. JANOTA, General Clerk, Building Maintenance Department, United Air Lines, and ARTHUR RAY, Records Custodian, Building Maintenance Department, United Air Lines, Chicago, Illinois. The results of the search were negative.

The following records of United Air Lines were examined:

1. Reservation cards for January and February, 1945. These cards did not include the names of all passengers carried by United Air Lines during that time, but only the names of persons making reservations ahead of time through the facilities of the Travel Bureau of United Air Lines.
2. Reports on passes issued and special rates allowed to various persons most of whom were employees of United Air Lines for the period August, 1944 through February, 1945.
3. Priority records prior to October 1, 1944 which contained the names of persons who had used air priorities in making flights on United Air Lines.

All other pertinent records for the period August, 1944 to February, 1945 have been destroyed.

Mr. JAMES ROWAN, Assistant to the Vice-President in Charge of Operations, United Air Lines, advised Special Agent JOHN A. O'LEARY that air priority records of the former Air Transport Command for the pertinent period might still be available.

JOHN W. CLEMSON was the Chief of the Domestic Priority Section and is now employed with Trans World Air Lines, New York City, New York.

MAX WOLMUTH, succeeded CLEMSON and is now with the Admiral Travel

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Bureau, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. ROWAN was of the opinion that either CLEMSON or WOLHMUTH would be able to furnish information as to the whereabouts of these priority records in case it was desired that these be examined.

The leads set out for Chicago in referenced New York report have been previously covered.

At New York, New York. Will attempt to identify the telephone number Peabody 2222 as set out for the Chicago office in New York letter to the Bureau dated March 2, 1950.

Will give consideration to the advisability of having the priority records of the Air Transport Command examined. It is to be noted that JOHN W. CLEMON, Trans World Air Lines, New York City, or MAX WOLFE, Admiral Travel Bureau, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, may have information as to the whereabouts of such records.
