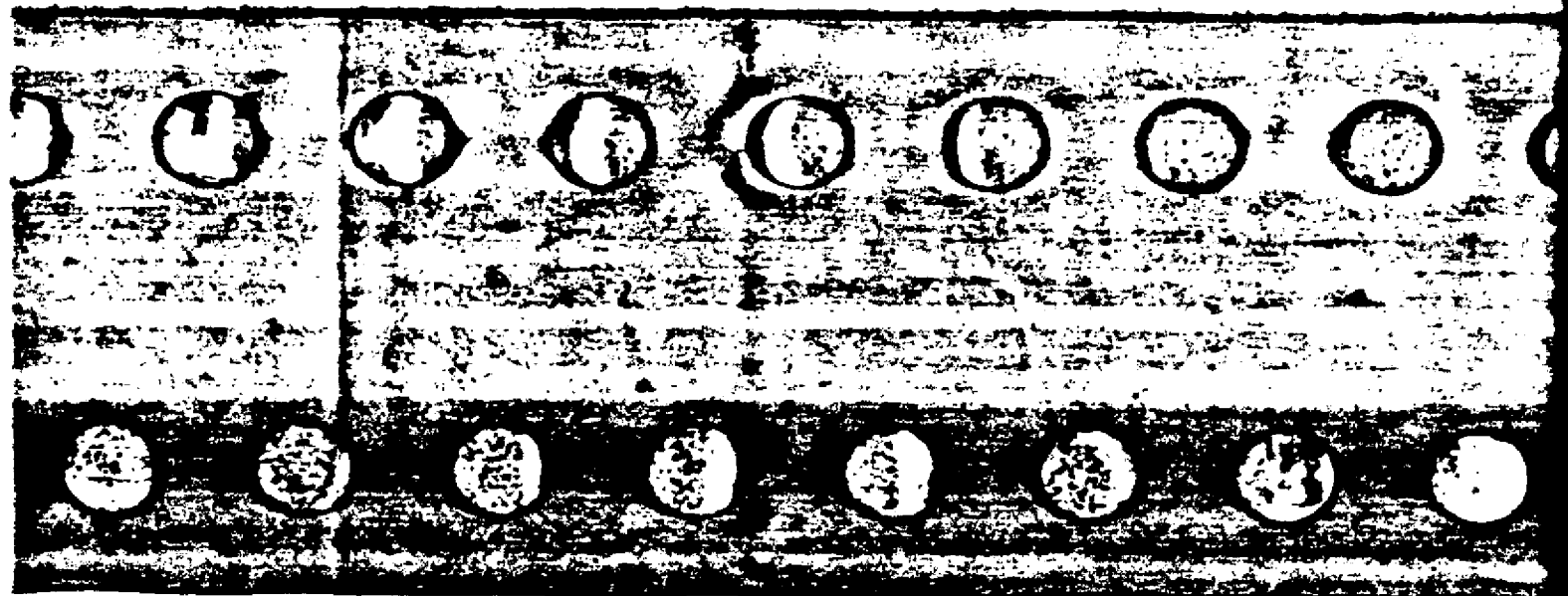

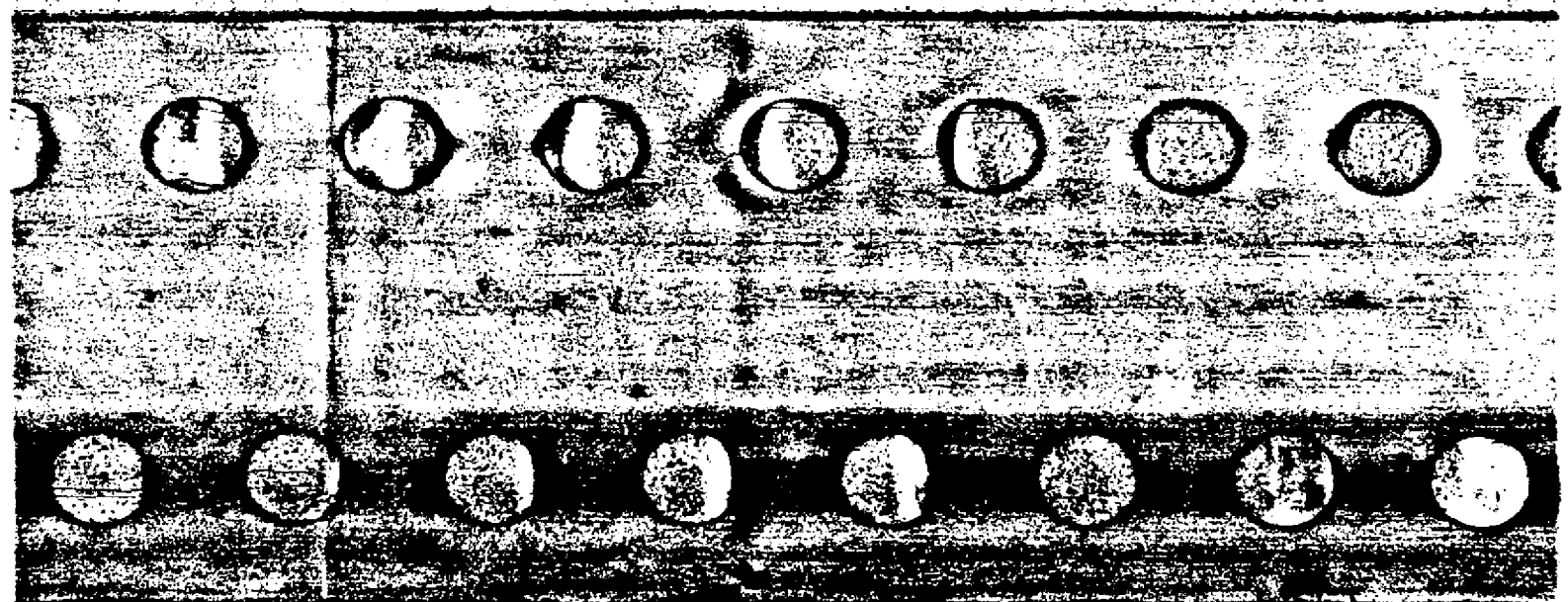
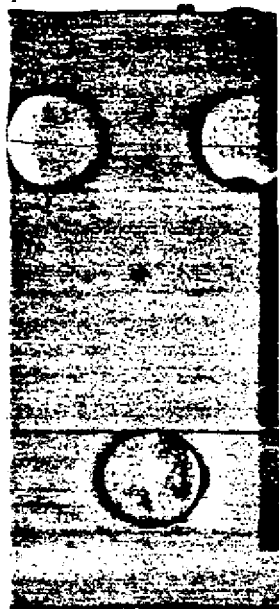

FELIX AUGUST INSLERMAN (Bureau file 100-364037) has been identified by JAY DAVID WHITAKER CHAMBERS as having been introduced to him in early 1937 by Colonel BORIS BYKOV as a paid Communist Party functionary and as having been a photographer who copied for CHAMBERS documents furnished to the latter by ALGER HISS and other United States Government employees. INSLERMAN is one of several subjects in the JAHAM case of which New York is office of origin. INSLERMAN has been to this date a completely uncooperative witness in government proceedings in the Southern District of New York.

ROBERT LESTER GREEN (Bureau file 100-261520) was a known active member of the Communist Party at Schenectady, New York from at least October, 1943 to February, 1947. GREEN was terminated as an employee of the Research Laboratory, General Electric Company, Schenectady, New York, in October, 1946 when the Manhattan District Engineers refused him security clearance.

GERHART FRIEDLANDER (Bufile 116-14967) was an acquaintance of the subject at Los Alamos, New Mexico. He was employed in the Research Laboratory, General Electric Company, Schenectady, New York, from March 4, 1946 to January 14, 1948. On the occasions of the subject's visit to the General Electric Research Laboratory on November 18 and 19, 1947, the subject personally contacted FRIEDLANDER. Bureau files reflect that when attending the University of California from 1937 to 1942, FRIEDLANDER was investigated

by the Berkeley, California, Police Department because of alleged Communistic tendencies. He was found to be a member of the "Campus Committee for Peace Mobilization" and "Committee to Fight Conscription". Bureau files also indicate that during 1943, FRIEDLANDER and MORRIS LEONARD PERLMAN were the sources of "discontent rumors" to the effect that persons employed on the Manhattan Project could not visit foreign countries. Bureau files also indicate that FRIEDLANDER and PERLMAN had on one occasion discussed IGNACY WITCZAK in such a manner as to indicate personal acquaintance with him.

MORRIS LEONARD PERLMAN (Bureau file 116-33189) was an acquaintance of the subject at Los Alamos. He was employed in the Research Laboratory, General Electric Company, Schenectady, New York, from February 25, 1946 to August 31, 1948. Upon the occasion of subject's visit to the Research Laboratory, General Electric Company on November 18 and 19, 1947, the subject contacted PERLMAN personally. Bureau files reflect that PERLMAN was a member of the Temporary Executive Committee of the Association of Los Alamos Scientists, and that Doctor I. PERLMAN, 527 Colusa Avenue, Berkeley, California, was a member of the Executive Committee of the San Francisco Federation of American Scientists, both of which were reportedly Communist infiltrated at that time. While a resident of Los Alamos, New Mexico in 1943, PERLMAN received circulars from "Free World", 8 West Fortleth Street, New York, New York. Additional information concerning PERLMAN has been set out underneath GERHART FRIEDLANDER, above.

EDWARD LEWIS BRADY, now employed as a Research Assistant at the General Electric Research Laboratory, Schenectady, New York, since October, 1948, has indicated to another General Electric employee a prior association with the subject and has, according to this informant, somewhat condoned subject's activity by stating that subject had acted in accordance with his beliefs. BRADY, upon leaving Oak Ridge, Tennessee, studied at Massachusetts Institute of Technology from June, 1946 to September, 1948, receiving his Ph.D. He has received Atomic Energy Commission clearance in the Schenectady area but is not presently working on the project at this time.

JOHN PAUL BLEWETT (Bureau file 116-337). is mentioned in report of SA BRENTON S. GORDON dated 2-22-50 at Boston, in which Albany is requested to provide information on BLEWETT in view of the fact that one JOHN BLEWETT and wife, HILDERED, 28 Sunnyside Road, Scotia, New York, employed at the General Electric Company, Schenectady, New York, was listed in the personal notebook of ISRAEL HALPERIN, a subject in CORBY case. BLEWETT was considered a possible suspect as the unknown Schenectady scientist.

BLEWETT and HALPERIN were roommates at the University of Toronto and later at Princeton University, being closely associated from 1928 to 1936. BLEWETT studied at Cambridge University, England, 1936-37, and was employed as a physicist in the Research Laboratory, General Electric Company, Schenectady, from 1937 to 1946. BLEWETT resided at 22 Sunnyside Road, Scotia, New York, from 1939 to 1942. BLEWETT was terminated by the General Electric Company in December, 1946, when the Manhattan District Engineers refused clearance for security reasons. BLEWETT has not resided in Schenectady since the summer of 1947. He has been reported working at the Brookhaven National Laboratory, Patchogue, New York, since that time.

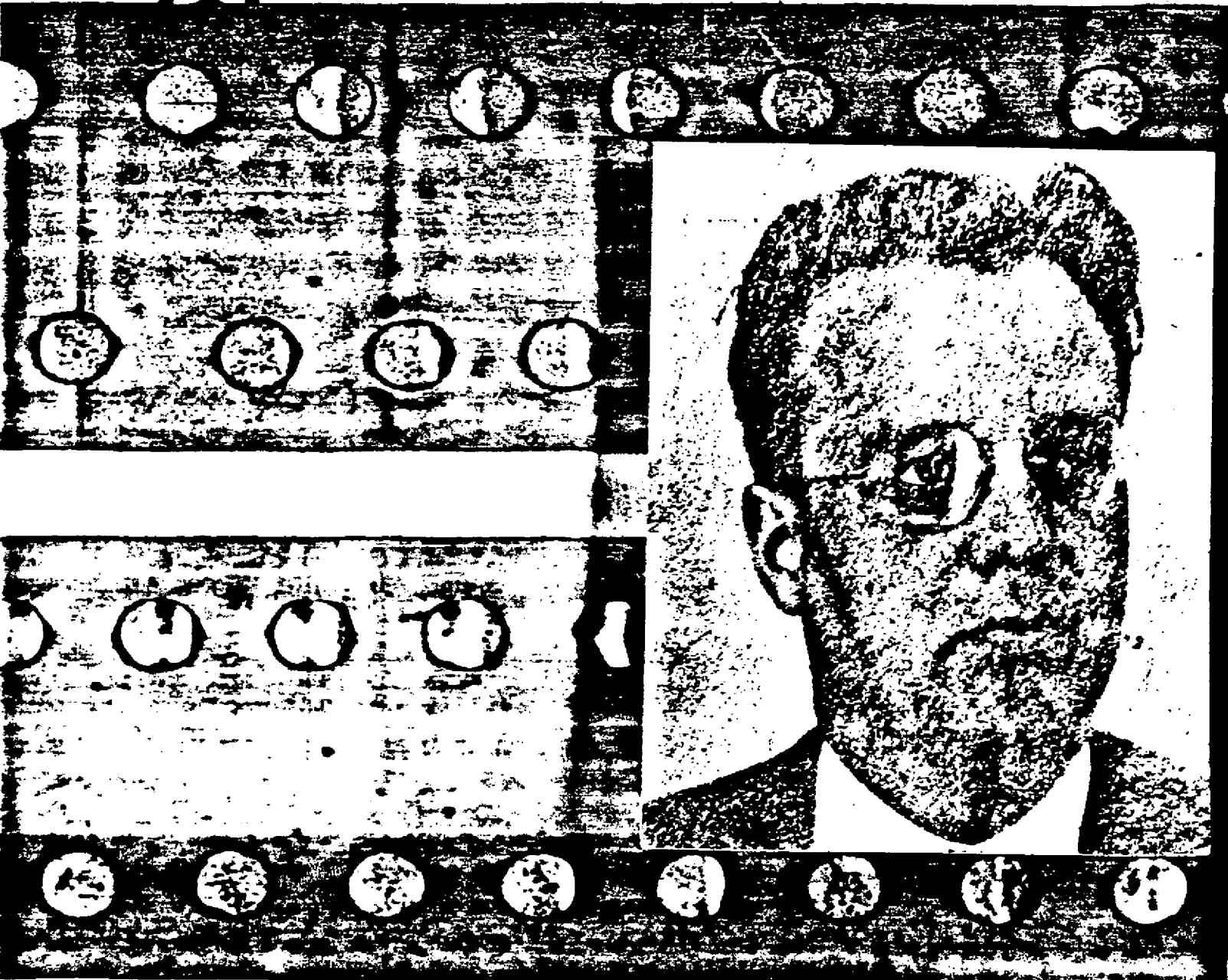

He gives impression of being definitely opposed to the Russian Revolution and the present regime in Russia. He intimates that his views and his fortune required that he leave Russia. He has never spoken of his German or Chinese background. Thirty-five to forty people are regularly employed by this Institute, and quite a few part-time employees are hired as special projects demand.

Massachusetts, and the purpose of her visit was shown as health. She later indicated  
that she returned to Los Alamos on September 3, year not shown.

A third form showed that MARTIN DEUTSCH intended to leave Los  
Alamos on August 13, year not shown, and return about September 1, year not shown.

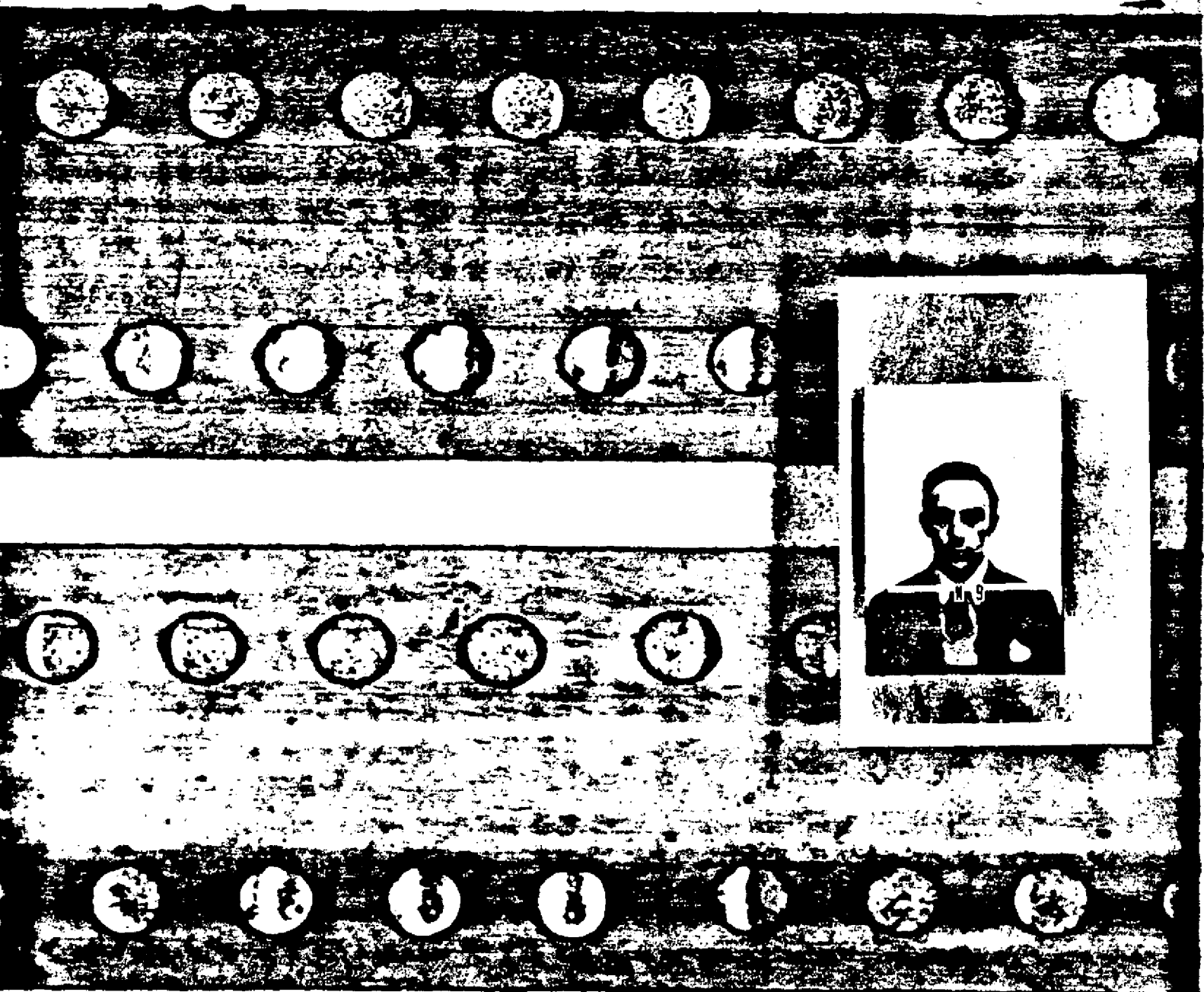
He would be available if necessary at 44 Larchwood Drive, Cambridge, Massachusetts. Purpose of visit was shown as "Vacation" and "Consultation about post war work." He showed under proposed itinerary, "Leave Cambridge on August 22 to drive back to Project." He later listed that he had returned to Los Alamos on September 3 and that he had contacted the "Physics Department Mass. Inst. of Technology" on this trip.

A different type of form captioned, "Permit to leave Site," dated July 28, 1944, reflected that Mr. and Mrs. MARTIN DEUTSCH desired to visit Mesa Verde Park and Durango from July 29 to August 1, years not shown. Reason for trip was shown as pleasure.

Under date of October 18, 1945, MARTIN DEUTSCH addressed a memorandum to Captain JONES, Intelligence Officer at Los Alamos, advising that it was his intention after leaving the Project in January to take a short vacation in Mexico. He requested that he be advised if such a trip would be considered inadvisable at that time. The file contained no reply to this memorandum.

The Security Office file also contained a copy of a teletype which stated that there had been some dissatisfaction on the part of terminating personnel with the secrecy declaration used. On January 15, 1946, MARTIN DEUTSCH who was about to terminate, requested a copy of the secrecy declaration so that he could study it before it was presented to him for his signature. After reading it over he stated that to his mind the form was perfectly satisfactory and not at all what he had heard it rumored to be.

Three copies of the photograph of MARTIN DEUTSCH are being forwarded to the Bureau and the Boston and New York Offices.

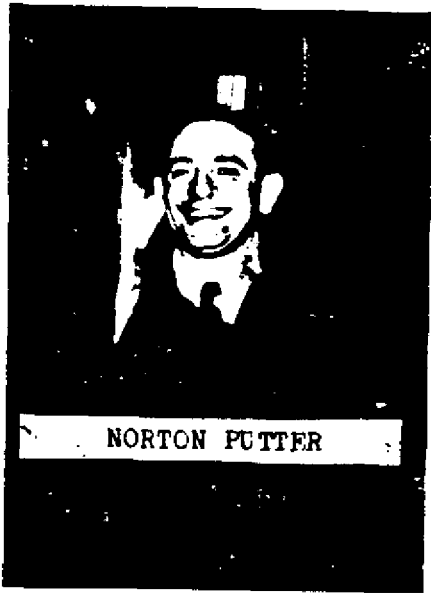

✓ MARK AARON GRAUBARD, who admitted that he was a member of the Columbia University Branch of the Communist Party in 1933 and 1934 and who also admitted that he engaged in anti-Nazi espionage work in 1935 and 1936 with JULIET STUART POYNTZ, a Russian espionage agent, advised that he believes that EDWARD EVERETT AUER was at the Columbia University Branch of the Communist Party in 1934. AUER attended some of the Communist Party meetings between September 1933 and the summer of 1934 with GRAUBARD. A photograph of EDWARD EVERETT AUER, the subject in this case, was exhibited to GRAUBARD, and he identified this person as the one who was in the Communist Party in 1934. ✓

✓ GRAUBARD advised that he introduced EDWARD EVERETT AUER to JULIET STUART POYNTZ, Russian espionage agent in about 1935; AUER told him at a later date that he did nothing for POYNTZ in the way of espionage work. ✓

✓ GRAUBARD stated that he last saw AUER in 1937 when GRAUBARD returned from a trip to Europe. At this time GRAUBARD told AUER that he should forget his activities and that he should not do anything for JULIET STUART POYNTZ or the Russian espionage ring. GRAUBARD stated he has not seen nor been in touch with AUER since about 1937 nor does he know anything concerning his present sympathies or activities." ✓

By letter dated 2/16/50 the Bureau requested that Newark contact and interview AUER. By teletype dated 2/24/50 Newark advised the Bureau that AUER is a current active member of a Communist Party club: [REDACTED]

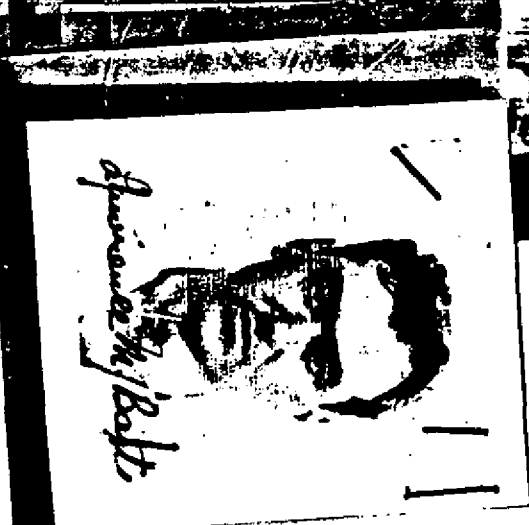

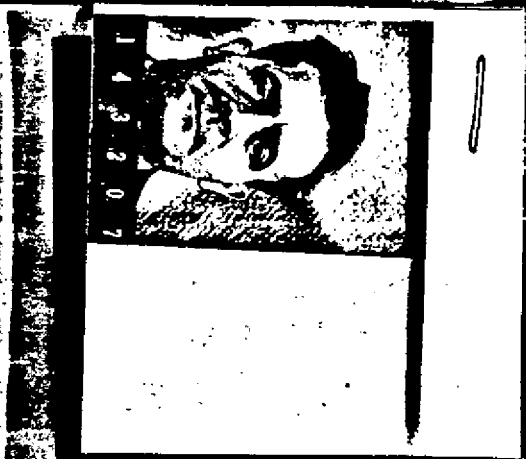

The Bureau files reflect that Jurgis Macynski was carried as a joint subject with Dr. Hans Gaffron of the University of Chicago in a Bureau investigation conducted between 1941 and 1944 under the character Alien Enemy Control - G, Foreign Born. New York file 100-12478 and Chicago file 100-3046. (100-16776)

A review of the above-mentioned investigation discloses that Macynski and Gaffron were apparently closely associated in Germany prior to the middle 30's and it appears that in 1935 or 1936 Gaffron was questioned by the Gestapo and his name searched because of his friendship for Macynski. Information received from Gaffron reflects that on March 15, 1943, Gaffron wrote Macynski and invited Macynski and his wife to visit him in the event they came to the United States. It is also noted that the investigation showed that after Gaffron came to the United States in 1937 certain stocks which he had in Amsterdam were transferred to this country for him by Mrs. Marguerite Macynski, the wife of Jurgis Macynski.

In view of the above indicated close association between Gaffron and Jurgis Macynski, it is believed Gaffron should be considered as a possible suspect for the unknown subject [redacted] who was Factor principal in the United States. Chicago is, therefore, requested to discreetly obtain a photograph of Gaffron and forward two copies to the Bureau and the Boston and New York Offices. Boston should thereafter exhibit this photograph to Robert and Kristel Reimann in case identification can be effected. Chicago should also discreetly obtain the dates Gaffron may have been absent from his employment at the University of Chicago between the period August 1944 and January 1, 1945. This information should then be forwarded to the Boston and the Boston and New York Offices.

To inform you that Robert Heineman has viewed the suspect Joseph Robbins in New York and has stated he is definitely not the man who visited Fuchs in Boston. Surveillance of Joseph Robbins continued. T.S.

DETAILS:

Special Agent Gathens advised at 10 P.M. that Robert Heineman had an opportunity to view the suspect Joseph Robbins under favorable conditions and that he had stated that Robbins was definitely not the individual who contacted Fuchs in Boston and whose identity is being sought by this Bureau as the person known as [redacted]. Arrangements were being made to have Heineman view the suspect Eugene Fisher, prior to his departure from New York.

ACTION:

The New York Office was instructed to continue the surveillance of Robbins until such time as surveillance pictures to be received by the Bureau are transmitted to London and exhibited to Fuchs, for further consideration looking toward a positive identification or elimination of Robbins as the suspect [redacted]. ADDENDUM:

On March 13, 1950, I spoke to ASAC Whelan, of the New York Office, to advise him that New York should continue to check the activities of Robbins until such time as we can definitely determine that he is not unsub [redacted]. To arrive at a basis for a conclusion on Robbins, I suggested that the New York Office immediately take the initiative to run out all leads on Robbins' employment and associates, after which New York should prepare a letter to the Bureau setting forth on one hand what we know about unsub [redacted] and other sources, and on the other hand, what the investigation reflects concerning Robbins. On the basis of this, we can come to a conclusion as to whether Robert Heineman is playing square with the Bureau and whether or not Robbins is unsub [redacted]. I advised Mr. Whelan we would inform the New York Office immediately upon receipt of advice concerning the display of the new surveillance photographs of Robbins to Fuchs. These photographs were sent to the Legal Attache in London on March 10.

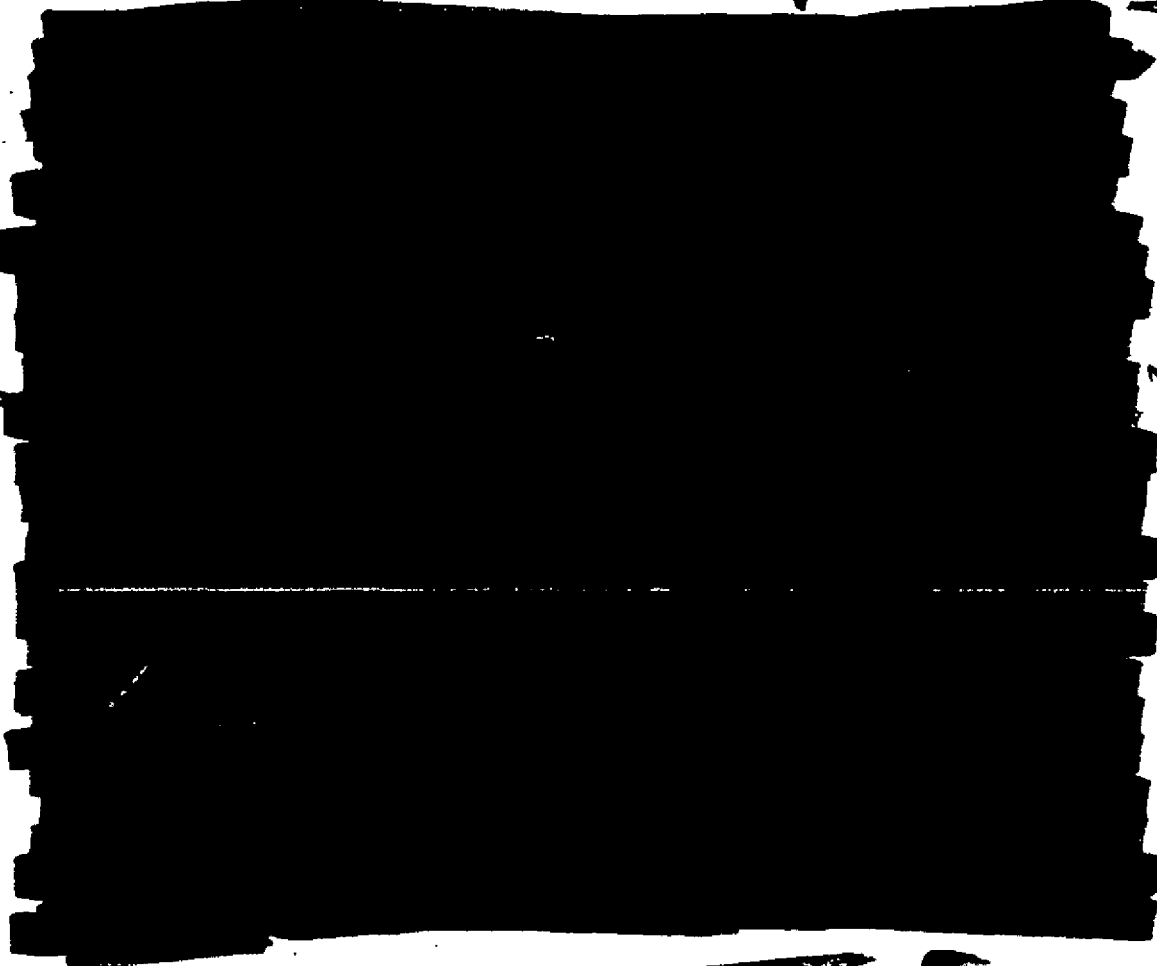

Feeling that the hearing was progressing rather slowly and being in an unknown neighborhood, she passed a note to Lord Portal asking him to have lunch with her, to which he agreed by a smile of acceptance and nodding. She accordingly met Lord Portal in the hall of the Bow Street Magistrate's Court and they then both went to lunch at a restaurant in that neighborhood. During the course of the lunch they naturally discussed the case, at which time Lord Portal gave his views regarding the progress of the proceedings and made the remarks already contained in General Ackerman's cable. Mrs. Ackerman further states that she then asked Lord Portal why the British did not watch men with such known backgrounds, which the Public Prosecutor explained at some length in the charge, and Lord Portal replied that the British have a system which is shared with America that they either recommend or do not recommend an employee and that, if this employee is later sent to America in connection with atomic energy work, he is accepted by America as being fully recommended. Mrs. Ackerman states that she was unable to understand this procedure and, consequently, was unable to further elaborate in this regard, or furnish any useful information from which some conclusion could be drawn. The conversation later turned to Subject FUCHS' possible contacts, both here (England) and in the United States and it was at this point that Lord Portal confidentially informed Mrs. Ackerman that Subject FUCHS has not been very helpful, as he has not furnished any names or identified any of his contacts, but that "they" (presumably meaning authorities, according to Mrs. Ackerman) would find more people here (England) and in America. It was after this that Lord Portal, according to Mrs. Ackerman, voluntarily and unsolicited by her made his comments regarding the FBI in stating that he "did not think the Federal Bureau of Investigation is doing anything." Mrs. Ackerman states that she defended the FBI and when she asked him whether he meant that the FBI are not or just haven't produced any results yet, Lord Portal replied: "There have been no results. We are all disappointed in them." In addition thereto, Lord Portal asked Mrs. Ackerman not to repeat these comments for fear that they might get back to the FBI. (S) u

Mrs. Ackerman states that this was the extent of their conversation regarding the FBI and she was of the impression that Lord Portal did not know that the FBI had representatives in this country. She also was of the impression that Lord Portal knew a lot about this case. She was unable to explain Lord Portal's criticism of the FBI but, as indicated above, apparently referred to the inability of the FBI in determining the identity of Subject FUCHS' contacts in America. She stated that she was again having lunch with Lord Portal on February 15, 1950, and at this time she would again discreetly question Lord Portal in this regard and advise writer. (S) u

On the following day, February 13, discreet and guarded inquiries were made of MI-5 and New Scotland Yard with the view to determining the extent of Lord Portal's knowledge of the facts in this case.
