BROTHMAN TOLD LEVINE HE WOULD SEND OSCAR VAGO TO YORK, PENNSYLVANIA, TO INSPECT A PLANT REFERRED TO AS THE "EAST PLANT". LEVINE ADVISED BROTHMAN TO GET IN TOUCH WITH DR. FOOCASE, ESPIONAGE 2, ██████████ CONFIRMING EARLIER ADVICES FROM NY, ROBERT HEINEMAN, WHO HAD AMPLE OPPORTUNITY TO THOROUGHLY STUDY JOSEPH ARNOLD ROBBINS TODAY, IS POSITIVE THAT ROBBINS IS NOT IDENTICAL WITH UNCKEM, EFFORTS TO VIEW LOUIS FRANCIS FISHER MADE WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS. BOSTON STILL FEELS THAT HEINEMAN SHOULD VIEW FISHER UNLESS FUCHS DEFINITELY IDENTIFIES NOR RECENT PHOTOS OF ROBBINS. IN ORDER TO BRING HEINEMAN TO NYC ON A WEEK DAY IT WILL BE NECESSARY FOR NY TO ADVISE POSSIBILITIES OF VIEWING FISHER DURING WEEK BEGINNING EASTER MONDAY, APRIL TENTH, NEXT. IT WILL FURTHER BE NECESSARY THAT MORE NOTICE BE GIVEN HEINEMAN AND MAHAN. BOTH STATED TONIGHT THEY WOULD NOT GO TO NY AGAIN ON TWELVE HOUR NOTICE. HEINEMAN STATED TODAY THAT HIS WIFE, KRISTEL, HAD ONCE TOLD HIM THAT ALBERT EINSTEIN WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN GAINING RELEASE FOR KLAUS FUCHS FROM CANADINA INTERMENT CAMP IN NINETEEN FORTY DASH FORTY TWO AND IN GAINING MEMBERSHIP FOR FUCHS IN ROYAL ACADEMY OF SCIENCE AT LONDON SO THAT FUCHS COULD WORK ON MED. MRS. HEINEMAN NEVER GAVE HER HUSBAND ANY SPECIFIC DETAILS CORROBORATING FOREGOING AND HE DOES NOT KNOW THE SOURCE OF HER INFO OR ITS ACCURACY. SHE WILL BE INTERROGATED CONCERNING THIS MATTER DURING NEXT WEEK. ROBERT HEINEMAN KNOWS OF NO DIRECT RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN FUCHS AND EINSTEIN. INVESTIGATION CONTINUING.

MEMO:

Re: FOOCASE

SA GRANVILLE called and requested the following information be relayed to the Bureau:

That HEINEMAN had come down from Boston with agents and viewed ROBBINS and stated that ROBBINS is definitely not the man. GRANVILLE stated that HEINEMAN had excellent opportunity to see ROBBINS with and without his hat and he felt absolutely certain that ROBBINS was not the right individual. GRANVILLE requested that the Bureau also be advised that HEINEMAN is returning to Boston at 6:00 PM, but that he was going to the Bronx to view suspect FISHER before embarking for Boston. GRANVILLE requested that the Bureau be advised that, with their permission, in view of HEINEMAN'S failure to identify ROBBINS, as well as the poor quality of the picture available, that the physical surveillance on ROBBINS will be discontinued.

The above information was conveyed to Mr. CARL HENNRICH, who subsequently spoke to ASAC WHELAN, who advised that this surveillance should under no circumstances be discontinued and the Bureau's instructions as heretofore given should be maintained in full force. Mr. HENNRICH also inquired about the photographs of ROBBINS, but later in the day he advised that they had been received in the Bureau. SA McCARVILLE was advised that the surveillance on ROBBINS should be continued.

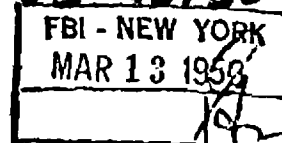

Manson Benedict presently is employed as Director of Process Development by Hydrocarbon Research, Inc., 115 Broadway, New York City. He resides at 465 Topping Hill Road, Westfield, New Jersey.

The New York Office has considerable information about Manson Benedict. Briefly, from 1933 to 1934 he roomed with Isadore Amdur while attending M.I.T. Amdur and his wife are known to have been members of the Communist Party in Cambridge, Massachusetts, and Amdur was a contact of Israel Halperin, who was acquitted in the Canadian Russian espionage case. Manson's brother, William, contributed \$100.00 to Halperin's defense and is employed by the National Bureau of Standards. Bureau files reflect that the wife of William Benedict may be known to Allan Rosenberg, Joseph Gregg and Robert T. Miller, subjects of the Gregory Case, and Alfred K. Stern, a figure in the case.

Because of his work on atomic energy, Manson Benedict may know Klaus Fuchs. It is requested that he be immediately interviewed for possible knowledge in his possession regarding Fuchs' background, contacts and associates. Manson Benedict appears to be an authority on gaseous diffusion.

It is requested that the results of this interview be forwarded to the Bureau in report form by special delivery.

A copy of this letter is being forwarded to the Newark Field Division in the event it is necessary for action by that office in connection with the interview of Dr. Manson Benedict.
