

DETAILS: The property accounting overview chapter of the FBI Accounting System has been approved by FBI management and GAO. Work is now underway to set forth the detailed procedural aspects of the property accounting system. Accordingly, a revamped manual property system is being developed to serve at the present time until the future automation of the system occurs.

It is felt that the observance of the CIA and ATF property management/accounting systems would be of immeasurable assistance in the creation of the desired computer adaptable FBI property system.

Through observance of these systems, possible solutions to procedural problems foreseen in the formulation of the Bureau's property system will be illustrated.

Due to complexities involved in the accountability of laboratory equipment and external inventory reporting requirements placed on the Laboratory Division, it is believed the Laboratory Division should take part in the review.

The Procurement and Administrative Services Section has the overall responsibility of administration for the FBI's property management program and therefore has a basic interest in the development of the property accounting system.

# Harvard restricts contracts with CIA

Harvard University issued new guidelines yesterday for the dealings between faculty and staff members and US intelligence agencies such as the Central Intelligence Agency.

Under the guidelines, the university itself can enter into research contracts provided the existence of the contract is made public.

Individuals who enter "direct or indirect consulting arrangements" for research or analytic services must report them in writing to a faculty dean, though there will be no public disclosure.

The guidelines also stipulate, "There should be no covert recruiting at Harvard." Recruiters will have to register with the university.

The guidelines were drafted by Harvard general counsel Daniel Steiner, Prof Archibald Cox of the law school, Dean Don K. Price of public administration and government and Dean Henry Rosovsky of arts and sciences.

In a statement they said, "Members of the Harvard community should not undertake intelligence operations for the CIA," nor lend their names to misleading propaganda efforts.

Harvard president Derek Bok requested the guidelines after the Senate Intelligence Committee reported last year that "there is a problem" in the way the CIA used academics.

When asked what would happen to faculty members violating the: guidelines, he said, "It really would depend on the nature of the violation."

## Committee to Study MIT-Intelligence Links

Chancellor Paul E. Gray this Frank Church (D., Idaho). week announced establishment of an Ad Hoc Committee on MIT and Intelligence Agencies to consider and develop recommendations for policies and procedures pertaining to potential involvement of MIT and members of the MIT community with intelligence agencies.

Professor Kenneth M. Hoffman, Head of the Department of Mathematics, was appointed committee chairman. Other committee members are: Dr. Louis Menand III. Special Assistant to the Provest and Senior Lecturer in the Department of Political Science: John M. Wynne, Vice President. Administration and Personnel; Dr. Ascher H. Shapiro, Institute Professor and Professor of Mechanical Engineering; Dr. Phyllis A. Wallace, Professor of Management; and Dr. Myron Weiner, Professor of Political Science.

Dr. Hoffman in 1970 was chairman of the faculty-student Commission on MIT Education, the report of which, entitled Creative Renewal in a Time of Crisis, was issued after lengthy studies and has had much to do with restructuring MIT educational and research policies. Dr. Shapiro is a former Head of the Department of Mechanical Engineering. Dr. Weiner is a former Head of the Department of Political Science.

Dr. Hoffman said the committee was established in response to public uirgings by a committee of the United States Senate, which held hearings on and studied the relationship between the Central Intelligence Agency and the nation's colleges and universities. Chairman of the committee was Sen.

In its report, issued in 1976, the Church committee urged colleges and universities to review their own policies and procedures gov-

erning their relationships to intelligence agencies and, where appropriate, promulgate updated guidelines and policies to take into account present-day intelligence gathering activities, particularly those of the CIA.

The Church committee declined to recommend new legislation to Congress to regulate the relationships, saying, instead, that the relationships would best be governed by the individual colleges and universities themselves and urged them to begin procedures toward that end.

A committee set up at Harvard University has already reported and many of its recommendations have been implemented there. Many other colleges and universities around the US are in the process of doing the same or soon will

Professor Hoffman said his committee expects to study numerous possible relationships that might develop with intelligence agencies, including:

The identifying of students and faculty by cell, guest as potential intelligence agency employees without the knowledge of the individuals so identified.

The formal and informal recruiting of students and faculty for employment by the agencies.

The interrogation of faculty returning from foreign travel for professional purposes.

The use of faculty and staff as consultants or in the preparation of what becomes propaganda for use by the agencies.

The sponsoring of university research projects by intelligence agencies through front organizations set up to conceal from the researchers the true source of the funds supplied.

"These are only some of the possible relationships the committee will be looking into," Dr. Hoffman said. "We want to look into any relationship that has the potential of developing and for which the Institute will need guidelines and policies."

Dr. Hoffman said the committee does not plan formal hearings, but will be seeking interviews with as many knowledgeable people at MIT as is possible and practical. It is too early, he said, to project a time schedule for the committee, "but we will do our work as promptly as we can." Dr. Hoffman said the committee hopes to report sometime this Spring.

One result of the Church committee hearing in 1976 was the public distribution by the CIA of papers having to do with a project the agency carried out in the 1950s under the code name MK ULTRA. Under that project, the agency arranged to support more than 140 research programs at colleges and universities with CIA-supplied funds administered through front foundations.

Two of the MK ULTRA projects were carried out at MIT with funding from a foundation known as the Society for the Investigation of Human Ecology.

One of the propers was carried out under a \$1.5 infant directly to a guest of the Institute, Dr. Anthony J. Wiener, who was then studying sociological aspects of the scientific community in the Soviet Union, specifically the system of rewards and recognitions employed there. He was affiliated with the MIT Center for International Studies and was unaware the funds came from the CIA. He later was affiliated with the Hudson Institute at Croton-on-Hudson, N.Y., and is now a private consultant.

The second project was a \$30,000 grant from the same society to Dr. Edgar H. Schein, Professor of Organizational Psychology and Management at the Sloan School of Management, to help support the preparation of Dr. Schein's book, Coercive Persuasion, a study of brainwashing techniques used by Chinese and North Korean interrogators on US prisoners of war during the Korean War.

Dr. Schein, a psychologist, was with the US Army Medical Corps at Walter Reed Army Hospital in Washington in the early 1950s and was a senior member of the team there that studied the brainwashed ex-POWs at length. He continued his interest in coercive persuasion after joining the faculty at MIT in 1951, and the grant from the society enabled him to complete his book, considered the definitive text on the subject. The book was published by Norton & Co. in 1961 and in the foreword. Dr. Schein expressed gratitude to the society for its support.

In response to demands by the Senate, the CIA is supposed to have sent all its MK ULTRA papers to the universities involved. MIT was sent papers relating to the grant to Dr. Wiener, but none relating to the support for Dr. Schein. The Boston Globe has reported learning that the support for Dr. Schein was included under MK ULTRA, but the CIA has told MIT it has no documents to support that report.

MEMORANDUM TO MESSRS. CREGAR **ADAMS** 

ALL INFORMATION CONTAINED

When I met with Admiral Turner at CIA Headquarters there was a small group of his principal officers. We sat at a round table with place cards. In front of my place, in addition to the place card, was a small inconspicuous diagram which outlined the table and who would be seated in the various seats. Admiral Turner introduced each executive in terms of his responsibility and subsequently each executive gave me a brief outline of the work for which he is responsible, and, in particular, any special relationships with the FBI.

Thereafter, there followed a general discussion of our mutual security problems

It may be anticipated that the adequacy of our justification for our budget may come up in polite conversation. Perhaps not. I think Admiral Turner is of the view that we can supply a more reasoned or databacked justification.

In preparation for our meeting I suggest that you memorandize or brief me on the major subjects which are of mutual interest. It would be helpful if I could have a brief resume on your Section Chiefs in order that I might undertake the introductions. If this is not possible I may ask you to do it.


