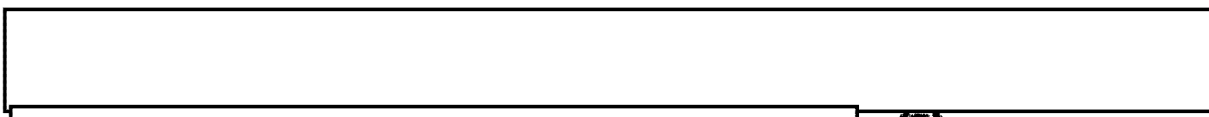

I am writing to you today regarding the proposed relocation of the FBI's Washington Metropolitan Field Office (WMFO), a project that is critical to the effectiveness of the Intelligence Community in carrying out its mission. This proposed relocation has been pending since 1982 without resolution, and it appears that an impasse has been reached. For this reason, I find it necessary to bring this matter to your attention and seek your support.

The WMFO is second only to the FBI's New York Office in size and in importance to our counterintelligence mission.

In the 1984 budget, President Reagan proposed and the Congress approved the sum of \$10 million to be available until expended for the purpose of moving the WMFO. In an effort to effect this move, the FBI negotiated with the Department of Justice, General Services Administration (GSA), and the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) to locate a suitable site for the WMFO. GSA proposed building a new facility on one site in north-west Washington, D.C., however, this proposal was rejected by the House Public Works Committee.

In September 1989, GSA submitted to the Congress the recommendations of a joint GSA/OMB task force which examined Federal housing needs, the status of funds available to meet those needs, and financing options. Among the 21 critical projects identified was the proposed relocation of the WMFO.

I am advised that GSA is in the process of submitting a prospectus for the WMFO project to the House Committee on Public Works and Transportation. OMB has indicated that it may disapprove the WMFO relocation and GSA has advised that until the issue of OMB's uncertainty is resolved, it can not proceed with the submission of this prospectus. GSA has further advised that if the issue is not resolved in a timely manner, the prospectus could be delayed substantially. It is, therefore, essential that this situation be resolved expeditiously.

The Intelligence Community's success in collecting and exploiting intelligence and counterintelligence information is a cornerstone of our efforts to safeguard national security. I recognize that this is a costly project which only grows more costly each year it is delayed. In the interests of national security, however, it must be done without further delay.

In his introduction to the President's 1991 Budget, Director Darman noted "None of the foregoing (initiatives) would be worth very much if the budget failed to provide for the protection of U.S. National Security. Though responsible analysts might differ about the best means of protecting it, national security holds a fundamental claim on governmental investment. Without adequate investment in national security, ultimately, all that America holds dear could be lost."

We are entering an era of extreme uncertainty in the international arena. That uncertainty makes these particular needs of the Intelligence Community all the more compelling. I believe that your active participation is essential in resolving the problems that stand in the way of this project. Although it is not clear what OMB's objections to the WMFO project might be, the FBI is most anxious to respond to any questions or concerns OMB may have. I urge you to voice your support for the relocation of the WMFO to Mr. Richard Darman, Director, and Mr. Frank Hodsoll, Executive Associate Director, OMB. If you wish, I will arrange a complete briefing regarding this project on a date most convenient to you, and will also arrange a briefing for Mr. Darman and Mr. Hodsoll as previously offered to their staff. In addition, a letter similar to this is being transmitted to the Attorney General.

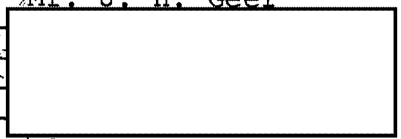

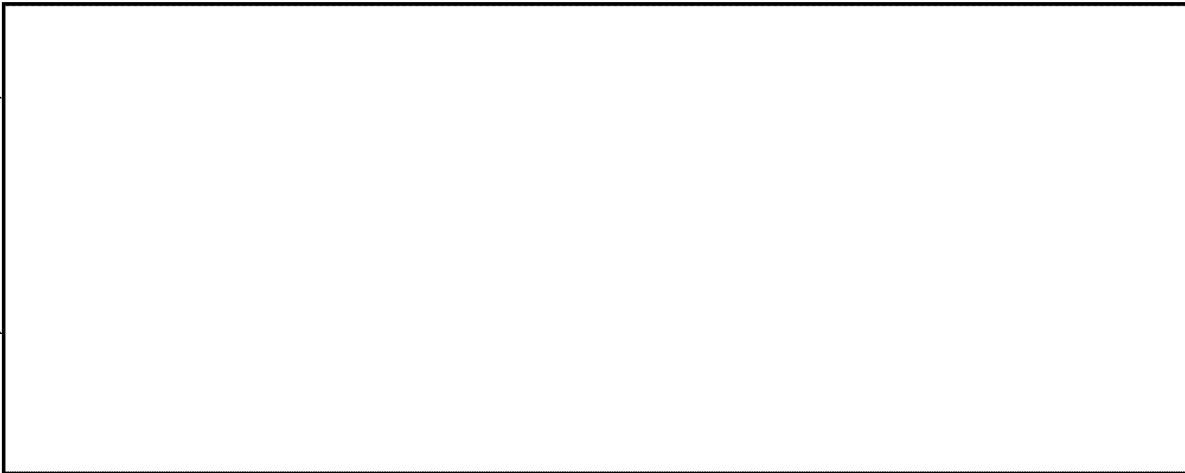

PURPOSE: To request the comments of the Records Management Division, (RMD), the Intelligence Division (INTD), and the Criminal Investigative Division (CID) regarding captioned bill.

DETAILS: By form dated June 12, 1981, the Office of Legislative Affairs, (OLA) Department of Justice, (DOJ) provided the Congressional Affairs Unit (CAU) with a copy of S.1235 and requested the FBI's comments. S.1235 was introduced by Senator D'Amato for himself and others on May 20, 1981. This bill is specifically addressed toward the CIA. It amends several provisions of the FOIA, eg. b(2), b(6), b(7)(e) and b(8), but these broadened exemptions only apply to the CIA. Also this bill exempts CIA from the requirement in subsection (b) that segregable portions of a record be provided to a requester. Another provision of this bill provides that no court can enjoin the CIA from withholding Agency records nor order the production of such records unless they are personnel records necessary for obtaining employment of the requester outside the Agency.

One portion of this bill addresses in part a concern the FBI raised in its proposals to amend the FOIA. The Bureau has recommended that the requirement that information be furnished "only" by the confidential source before it can be protected be eliminated by striking "only" from the b(7)(d) portion of the act. This bill makes that change "in the case of a record compiled by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation" but does not remove the word "only" to protect confidential information compiled in the course of a criminal investigation.

RECOMMENDATION: That RMD, INTD and CID review this bill and provide their comments to Margaret Owens, CAU, Room 7240, Ext. 4510 by COB 6/23/81.

Dear Sir:

I wish to solicit your assistance in solving a problem I have, which was brought on by an encounter with the United States Government over twenty years ago. It concerns the denial of security clearance to, and the surveillance of loyal Americans by officials of the FBI, CIA and National Security Administration.

In March of 1961 I was visited, at my home, by [redacted] an official of the United States Counter Intelligence Service. After a lengthy conversation I agreed to join the service. I was told I would be asked to go to Washington D.C. for an interview, medical and psychological examinations. The date for my interview was to be confirmed at a later date. However, I later received a contradictory correspondence stating that I had broken an appointment, but another would be made for me. In August of 1961 I went to Washington D.C. for one week. I was interviewed by a GS-14 psychologist, and what was supposed to be a physical examination turned out to be a guise under which drugs were administered to me and psychological implantations were performed. It later became evident to me that I had been unwillingly made to participate in secret psychological stress experiments. Unknown to me I was given a hypnotic controller. She was a [redacted] a [redacted]

This young woman was also in Washington D.C. when I reported there for my interview. Because of the superiority of my morality to hers, I was able to break away from being controlled by her.

The emotional degradation brought on by my encounter in Washington D.C. has caused me many years of anxiety and now threatens my very family life. Over the years there have been numerous employment situations denied to me because of my lack of a security clearance. In September 1979 I bought a home in Staten Island. I moved into it without leaving a forwarding address at my previous place of residence or Post Office. On September 10th. 1980, FBI agent [redacted] of Queens FBI office telephoned me at my unlisted home telephone. He obtained my telephone number after visiting my former place of residence [redacted] I had not resided there for over twelve years. Subsequently, on two occasions I received telephone calls from Scarsborough Research. Bearing in mind that my telephone number is unlisted and taking into consideration the questions asked I have come to the conclusion that I was being voice-typed.

During the summer months of 1980 I made several applications in search of new employment. Two corporations practically assured me of employment and then in October both rejected me, I suspect based on telephone conversations I had with them, because of the lack of a security clearance.

b7C On October 21st. 1980, I visited the FBI office in New York and discussed my problem with the supposed supervisor on the twenty-sixth floor east. On October 22nd. 1980, I returned to the FBI office and spoke with agent [redacted]. He assured me that he would speak on my behalf to the director of FBI. On October 29th. 1980, I sent him a follow-up letter stating that I was anxiously awaiting a reply. I have not received any communication as yet.

The publication, The Chronicle of Higher Education, in it's September 26th. 1977 issue had an article that profoundly supports my contention that the university class rooms and corridors were, in the early sixties, fertile ground for candidates for secret mind-controlling experiments by the CIA. The Chronicle states that the Congressional investigation that was held on the matter, achieved no conclusive evidence because records were deliberately doctored and even faked as a double security measure.

Several events in my life have convinced me that I am still being victimised by the falsefied records maintained on me. I am still under survailance, and I am soliciting your assistance in ending this victamising against myself and many other loyal Americans.

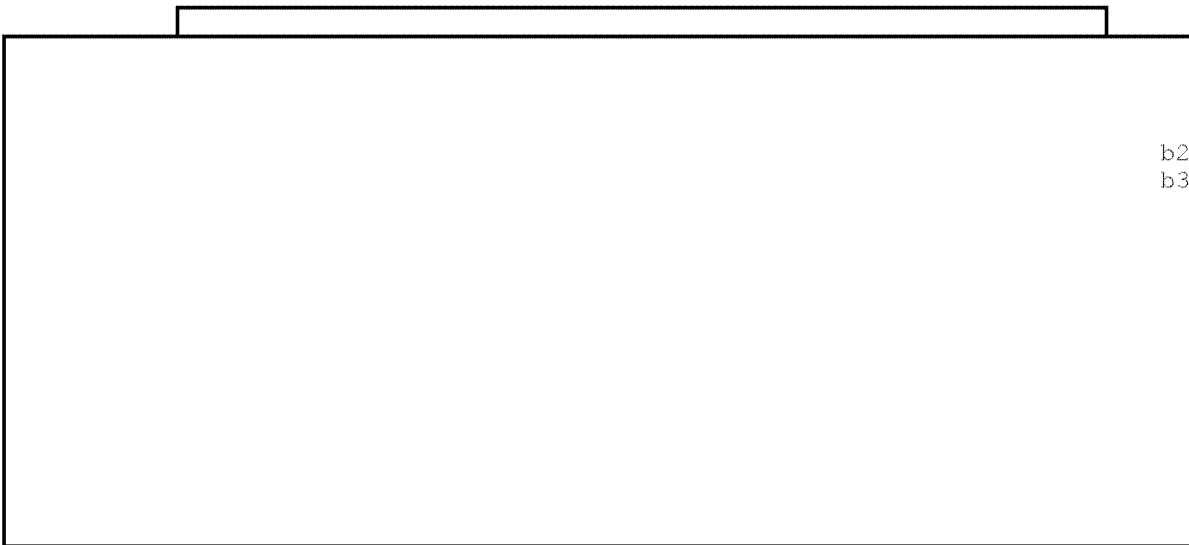

RE: FOIA AMENDMENTS

After expressing his view that the Senate may be more receptive than the House, Mr. Rose noted there are several legislative approaches to take. The CIA proposal could be submitted separately, thereby permitting the Senate and House Intelligence Committees to consider that recommendation rather than House Government Operations or Judiciary.

The Administration could strive to obtain Senate passage of all or most of the package, seek to secure House passage of that portion which the Government Operations Committee could be expected to report, and then focus on seeking favorable action by the Conference Committee.

A third possibility is to try to have the Senate pass a bill palatable enough for Mr. English, Chairman of House Government Operations Subcommittee, to refrain from demanding the bill be referred to him. That would permit a vote on the floor of the House where passage is more likely than in the Subcommittee.

Mr. Rose will consult with the Republican leadership in the House and Republicans on Mr. English's Subcommittee to assist in determining the best approach.

He reported he has discussed the law enforcement issues with the Attorney General and with Mr. Meese, Counselor to the President. The FOIA package may dovetail with the Administration's plans to concentrate on crime matters in the Fall.

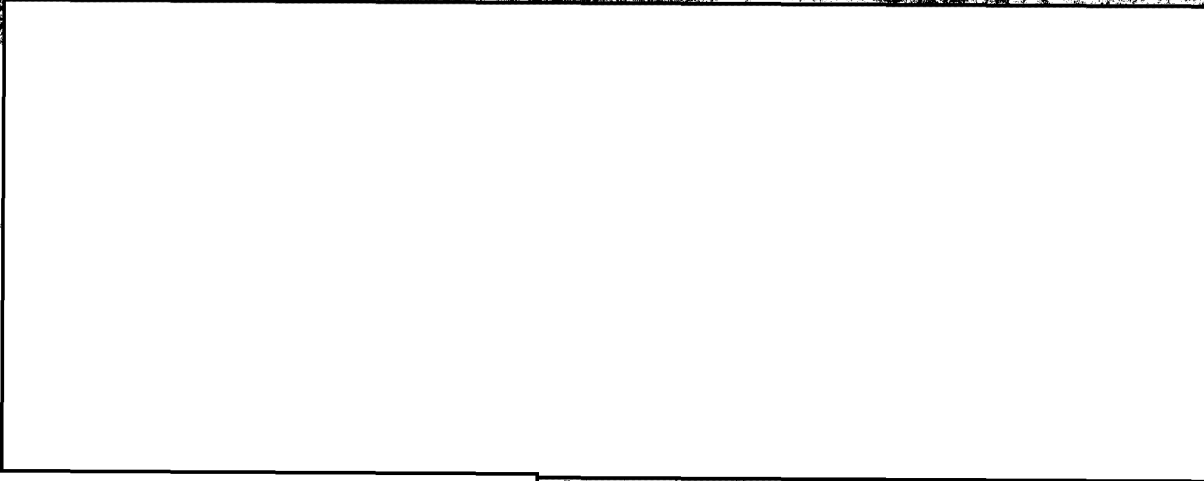

INTD has reviewed the current legislative needs of the Division and find that with the exception of those listed below, the current CIA proposals address our current concerns.

The INTD proposals for ammendment to the Tax Reform Act of 1976 (20 USC 6103) as first set out in J. M. Sturgis to Mr. E. J. O'Malley memo of 4/28/81, under the Tax Reform Act caption, which have been the subject of activity by Congressional Affairs Unit, remains a significant legislative need and should be emphasized in any community legislative package.

Additionally, the INTD proposal for permanent legislation for certification of undercover activities which resulted in part in the letter from the Director to the Assistant Attorney General for Administration dated 2/12/81, captioned "Proposed Language for the Department of Justice Authorization Act" remains a pressing INTD need. Congressional Affairs Unit is well acquainted with these proposals and they should be strongly urged as part of the community legislative package.

In the memorandum dated July 7, 1981 from the Associate General Counsel, Office of General Counsel, Central Intelligence Agency to the Intelligence Community Legislation Representatives, the FBI and other members of the intelligence community were requested to provide CIA with any legislative needs in the intelligence area which might be incorporated into an Intelligence Community Legislative Program.

In addition to those items in the current legislative program which are still pending, the FBI recommends that two other legislative areas be addressed.

First, the FBI recommends amendment to the Tax Reform Act of 1976 (26 U.S.C. s.6103). The law as it stands established rigorous and cumbersome restraints upon disclosure of tax information for use in non-tax criminal cases. It provides no access to IRS held information for use in investigations which are strictly foreign intelligence or counterintelligence matters. Only when a criminal investigation in a foreign intelligence or counterintelligence matter is underway does the law provide for access to such records. However, even in those cases, a determination is usually made not to attempt to access tax-related information because such efforts might entail an unacceptable risk to national security. To access tax information, court orders, analogous to search warrants, are required. Dispersion of sensitive classified information during an ongoing investigation to employees of a U.S. District Court who may not possess the required clearances or where there may not be proper storage facilities, may jeopardize the sensitive information and the ongoing investigation. This consideration when combined with the delays inherent in the current procedure, usually dissuades intelligence and law enforcement personnel from this line of investigation.

The FBI therefore recommends that the Tax Reform Act be amended to allow disclosure of IRS held information for use in connection with foreign intelligence and counter-intelligence activities. The Department of Justice supports this position and is preparing a package of tax disclosure amendments reflecting this concern and others which will be forwarded to the Office of Management and Budget for clearance.

Secondly, the FBI recommends permanent legislation for certification of undercover activities. Since 1979, Congress has included in the DOJ Appropriation Authorization Act an authorization for the FBI to (1) use appropriated funds to lease space, (2) deposit appropriated funds in banks and financial institutions, and (3) to utilize earned income to offset expenses in situations where the undercover technique is used and where U.S. Laws or regulations must be contravened. Because the Appropriation Authorization Act requires annual congressional approval, the DOJ has advised that the required certifications must also be obtained on a yearly basis. This causes an enormous administrative burden in light of the large number of operations employing one of the three activities and in light of the fact that the operations employing the activities frequently continue for years with no change in the basic nature of the operation nor reduced need for the activity. This burden is compounded by the fact that Congress regularly delays passage of the Act beyond the end of the Fiscal Year, thus requiring a continuing resolution and threatening possible cessation of all Government activity. Therefore, the FBI recommends permanent legislation which requires a single certification valid for the life of a criminal or counterintelligence operation.

Also the FBI proposes that the dual certification required of the Director of the FBI and the Attorney General is unnecessary and that the Director alone should be responsible for such certification with prompt notification to the Attorney General.
