[REDACTED] PERSONALLY INTERVIEWED AND STATES THAT INDIVIDUAL WHOSE IDENTITY HE DOES NOT FEEL FREE TO DISCLOSE BUT WHO IS VERY SUBSTANTIAL PERSON WAS AT HIS HOME AT PARTY AND AFTER SOME DRINKING ASKED [REDACTED] WHICH AGENCY OF GOVT HE WAS NOW ASSOCIATED WITH. THROUGH HIS ADMIRAL UNQUOTE. BELIEVED BAUTZER WAS IN U.S. NAVY FOR A SHORT PERIOD DURING WAR. ADMIRAL UNNAMED AND UNKNOWN. CLAIMED RUPERT HUGHES, AUTHOR, IS MEMBER OF GROUP AND ALLEGEDLY WILL MOVE TO NY TO HEAD UP SOME SORT OF OFFICE FOR GROUP. [redacted] in his letter indicated that the Central Intelligence Agency was endeavoring to recruit undercover intelligence persons in the movie colony in Hollywood.

On April 6, 1950, I telephonically instructed SAC Hood to interview [redacted] to obtain any specific information which he might have in his possession. [redacted] was interviewed and the results are set forth in the attached teletype dated April 6, 1950.

You will recall that on April 5, 1950, Judge E. A. Tamm referred to the Director a quoted portion of a letter from [redacted] dated April 3, 1950. [redacted] in his communication to Mr. Tamm stated that CIA was trying to recruit undercover intelligence-operatives in the movie colony. [redacted] indicated that evidently one of the lines used by CIA was that the FBI was all washed up, that there was a need for CIA because it was not affiliated with the New Deal, etc., and there was quite a whispering campaign going on which was untrue and unfair. (S)

[redacted] was interviewed by SAC Hood and he would not disclose the source of his information but described him as a very substantial person and stated that this individual had said CIA was organizing everyone into an undercover organization inasmuch as the FBI was being controlled by the New Deal. [redacted] stated that [redacted] was the organizer of the CIA group. He also claimed that attorneys Greg Bautzer and [redacted] were members. He further claimed that Rupert Hughes, the author, was a member of the group and allegedly would move to New York and head up some sort of an office for the group. (S)

Mr. Hood interviewed Rupert Hughes, who denied any such association on his part. Mr. Hood also talked to Mr. LeRoy Edwards, Vice President of the Gas Company in Los Angeles and Mr. Edwards stated he had no knowledge of any such activity on the part of CIA. Mr. Hood has been requested to maintain contact with [redacted] to try to determine further information concerning the allegations. (S)

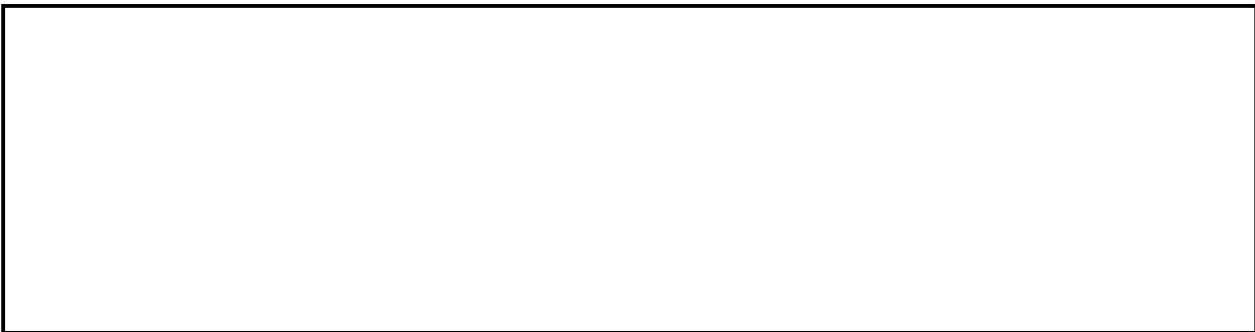

International FBI Considered To Combat Soviet's Spy Ring

By Fred Sparks

Foreign Correspondent of The Star and the Chicago Daily News

ROME, Mar. 24.—Should the democracies organize a gigantic FBI to smash international Soviet spy rings?

That's a question being considered today.

Why?

Allied military plans on this continent are as secret as a show window on Fifth ave.

Spies by the bundle, Communists by the acre, know almost every move of French, Italian, Benelux and Scandinavian army men.

Defense Union Difficult.

This makes almost impossible the creation of a rigid common-defense plan for Western Europe against a Soviet feared push.

It endangers the basic value of the North Atlantic Pact and the military aid program.

From recent conversations I know American and British military top-dogs are jittery. After three years of touring European Army installations I know they have solid reason to shudder.

They're convinced Soviet sleuths plus native party-liners know the insides of practically every military filing cabinet on the continent.

Slowly but surely American wishy-washy thinkers who like to label spy-stories "red herrings" are finding out that Joe Stalin has built himself the most magnificent snoop machine in history.

Fuch's Case Cited

Scientist Fuchs made even England's counter-espionage service long heralded as the slickest in this world look like a bunch of teen-agers sporting "detective" badges.

Europeans wonder if England can falter, what chance is there of security for common secrets in such talkative countries as France and Italy?

Remember that one out of every three Frenchmen or Italian votes the straight Red ticket. Without question many Reds are in the armies * * * not necessarily as brass-hats, but certainly as paper shufflers or infantrymen.

Last year I asked French army

officers: "How can you prevent Communists from being conscripted?" They hopelessly shrugged their shoulders.

Last week I got an equally disturbing reply from the Italians.

U. S. Must Face Facts.

These are hard facts that must be faced as we ship arms to Europe to build a mutual armed mass.

When I visited Fontainebleau, Marshal Montgomery's GHQ for Western Union forces, I found British officers absolutely reluctant to create on paper "the defense plan."

They frankly did not trust allied staffs in the ancient chateaux.

The same conditions apply to America's feeble forces in the Reich.

Last summer I reported that scores of employes of the Army occupation forces were positive Communist informers.

Last week Lt. Gen. Clarence C. Huebner said, "Western Germany is honeycombed with Communist agents." Later his provost marshal ordered extra precautions taken with important documents.

Here in Rome a Communist told me, "You can be sure that every American embassy in Europe is well watched by our friends."

What can be done about this spy brigade that blankets Europe?

There is no simple, offhand answer in democracy's book. Army men generally have never been up against such a towering security problem.

That's why they're talking about a new democratic FBI—with police trained crime-crusher like J. Edgar Hoover to head it.

Where is the CIA?

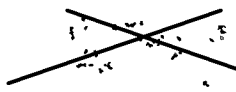

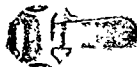
