According to VAN LANDINGHAM the letter indicates that Agency is in desperate need of clerks, typists, and the recipient of the letter was requested to furnish names and addresses of prospective employees. The letter also indicated that in the future former Agents of the FBI might be called upon to conduct applicant investigations for CIA and the remuneration would be approximately \$25 per day and expenses or a minimum fee of \$12.50 for handling a lead.

The above is being furnished for the information of the Bureau. In the event the Bureau does not have a copy of the letter in question, I feel that same can be obtained from Mr. VAN LANDINGHAM should the Bureau desire.

On May 19, 1951, former Special Agent [redacted] who is presently [redacted] and is a member of the Society of former Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, contacted Special Agent Theodore Webb, Resident Agent at Staten Island, and furnished him with the following information regarding the Central Intelligence Agency.

[redacted] advised that he was in receipt of a letter from CIA asking him as a former FBI Agent to recommend to that agency any individuals who he thought would be acceptable as stenographers, typists and clerks.

[redacted] advised Special Agent Webb that in another portion of the letter CIA inquired as to whether or not [redacted] would be available to conduct applicant investigations for CIA. These investigators are to be paid at the rate of \$25.00 per day and expenses, with a minimum of \$12.50 in cases of one shot leads and work requiring less than a day. [redacted] advised Agent Webb that the letter was signed by one, WILLIAM J. KELLY, Personnel Department, CIA. It is noted that [redacted] advised Special Agent Webb that if he knew of any likely prospects for a stenographic or clerical position he would recommend them to the FBI before anyone else.

The Bureau, in turn, should be promptly advised of this information and dissemination to other agencies of the Government will be handled at the Bureau so that there will be no question as to the origin of the information.

It is desired that in the future each representative abroad adhere strictly to this policy.

Central Intelligence Agency

On February 23, 1951, the Bureau was advised in a letter to the Director, subject APPLICANT CASES, CIA AGENCY CHECKS, that the Central Intelligence Agency was then requiring approximately twentyfour days between the submission of flimsies to that agency and their return to the FBI. The reasons for this delay included lack of personnel, expansion of CIA and increased work load imposed by the FBI and other agencies. The following information applies to all cases generally requiring CIA checks.

The situation between February 23, 1951, and April 25, 1951, deteriorated until, as of the latter date, the interval between submission and return of flimsies had lengthened to 45 days except for those cases where the "Deadline Must be Met", White House Inquiries, Bureau Applicants and the extremely urgent cases which were especially handled in a period of approximately four days. However, the Bureau's attention is directed to the fact that the number of such cases had to be kept to a minimum in order to insure expeditious treatment.

Close contact was maintained by Special Agent L. RUSSELL WHARRY of this office with [redacted] CIA, and his successor, [redacted] to keep these men constantly aware of the situation; however, they maintained that due to the factors previously mentioned, the length of time necessary for the searches could not then be shortened.

On April 25, 1951, a conference was held with [redacted] and Agent WHARRY, at which time the seriousness of the problem was discussed and the CIA representatives stated they felt the situation would be immediately improved.

On April 27, 1951, results began to show and the number of flimsies returned to the FBI steadily increased until, as of this date, with the exception of a few cases, there are only eight days required between the submission of flimsies and their return to the FBI.

[redacted] subsequently advised that the personnel problem in the CIA file rooms had been alleviated and barring any unforeseen circumstances it can reasonably be expected that the

PURPOSE:

BACKGROUND:

You will recall that recently General Walter Bedell Smith of CIA requested that a few of his men receive Bureau training in applicant matters in order that they may subsequently become supervisors at CIA in handling applicant cases.

By my memorandum to you dated April 12, 1951, captioned as above, you will also recall that Mr. Clegg, in an addendum to the memorandum, suggested that we have the regular instructor on applicant matters appear before one class and that CIA instructors be in attendance and carry on from there. The Director noted, "I am willing to go as far as Clegg suggests. H." Mr. DeLoach, Liaison Section, advised General Smith of our decision in this matter, whereupon General Smith expressed his appreciation for our assistance in this regard.

DETAILS:

On May 16, 1951 [redacted] CIA, telephonically contacted W. F. Woods, Liaison Section, and asked whether they could have a representative of the Bureau appear before a CIA training class on June 6, 1951. He stated that there would be about 12 or 15 trainees and 3 or 4 individuals who were to be trained as instructors in attendance. He advised that he had been informed of the Bureau's decision in this matter, and for that reason, the potential instructors were being requested to attend.

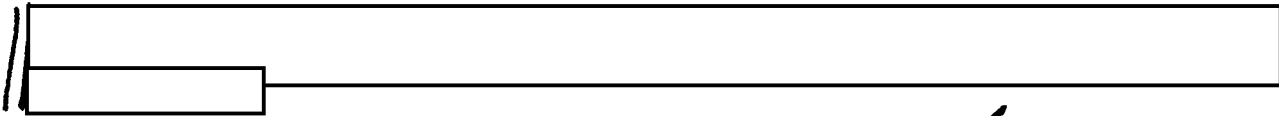
