SAC Hawkins of the Houston Office advised at 6:00 p.m., 8/11/61, that 12 Freedom Riders from Los Angeles had arrived in Houston at 9:55 a.m., 8/11/61, via Southern Pacific Railroad. These 12 possessed railroad tickets only to Houston. SP Railroad Station has no eating facilities. After visiting a colored attorney and visiting the campus of Texas Southern University, 7 of the 12 Freedom Riders, at 11:55 a.m., 8/11/61, returned to the Southern Pacific Railroad Station and purchased the cheapest tickets for DeQuincy, La., (Houston Police advised that they would not object to these colored people eating in the railroad station if they possessed a railroad ticket beyond Houston).

At 1:48 p.m., 8/11/61, the 12 Freedom Riders from Los Angeles, plus four Houston Freedom Riders, went to the Union Railroad Station where food is served. They were refused service. The manager requested the police to arrest them and the police refused. The manager went to the County Courthouse, contacted the Justice of the Peace, secured warrants for the arrest of all 16 charging them with "Unlawful Assembly" and took the warrants to the police who then arrested all 16 at 3:35 p?m., 8/11/61.

SAC Houston does not have the identity of any of the 16 arrested Freedom Riders. He advised that no violence took place and that everything was handled peacefully.

The Journal said the fund was a small volunteer group organized for the "purpose of aiding research: on problems in Marxist theory and its application to social analysis".

Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation observed in attendance at meetings of the Wisconsin Socialist Club, Madison, on August 2, 1959 and September 21, 1959.

A characterization of the "Fair Play for Cuba Committee" appears in the Appendix pages of this memorandum.

On December 28, 1960 U.S. Customs, Miami International Airport, advised that the passenger list for Cubana Airlines flight 803B of December 23, 1960 included the names of

On January 10, 1961 the Daily Cardinal, a campus publication of the UW, Madison, Wisconsin, published an article headlined, "'U' students see Cuban advances; heavy support for Castro noted." The following quotation was taken from that article:

"Great economic and social progress have resulted from the Cuban revolution, according to eight out of nine university students who toured Cuba during Christmas vacation.

"The tour was organized by the Fair Play for Cuba Committee in cooperation with the Cuban government. Each student said he was in Cuba for the first time to gain a better understanding of the revolution.

"All nine students agreed that they had complete freedom of movement and were received in a friendly manner by the Cubans.

"They noticed that Cubans often differentiated from the American people and the American Government, which the Cubans considered to be hostile toward their country

"Those who were sympathetic with the achievements of the revolution are Jim Wahlstrom, senior psychology major; Andrea Morell, History major"

On January 9, 1961 and again on February 1, 1961 advised the Federal Bureau of Investigation that she took the Christmas Holiday tour to Cuba sponsored by the Fair Play for Cuba Committee at the expense of the on her return. She gave people who went with her the names of along with her evaluation of those persons. said the tour left Chicago, Illinois by air and arrived Miami December 23, 1960 from where they took a Cubana Airlines flight to Havana. They left Havana January 1, 1961 and came back to Madison the following day. Among the persons she identified as accompanying her on her trip were said she had not but that gotten to know extremely enthusiastic about what she saw in Cuba and thought the revolution was wonderful. Milwaukee, mentioned above, advised the Federal Bureau of Investigation on February 16, 1961 that at Madison, and lacksquarehad traveled to Cuba over the preceding Christmas Holiday. He said told him the group was sponsored by a "Socialist" club, adding that he had been asked to join the Communist Party three times during the trip.

Capital Times, Madison, Wisconsin, in its issue of June 6, 1961 published an article headlined "Local Man Arrested as 'Rider'." The article read partially as follows:

"Seven more 'Freedom Riders,' including one reportedly from Madison, Wis., were arrested in Jackson, Miss., today as they arrived aboard a bus from New Orleans.

"The Madison rider was identified as James Wahlstrom, 24.

"The seven were arrested as they stepped into a segregated waiting room in the Jackson bus terminal.

"The group arrived shortly before noon, convened outside their bus, then marched into the waiting room reserved for whites.

"They stood just inside the door, apparently waiting to be arrested. A police officer ordered them to 'move on' and took them into custody when they ignored his order.

"The group included five whites and two Negroes, a boy and a girl. The Negro girl smiled throughout the proceedings.

"Six of the riders sat in a row of waiting room chairs to give officers their names while the seventh -- Newell Weber, a gray-haired photographer -- told newsmen why he made the trip:

"'I believe that interstate passengers should be able to use all bus station facilities. I really believe that.'..."

On June 23, 1961 the Daily Cardinal, UW, reported an article headlined "Freedom Rides Supported in Rally, March Thursday".

The article read partially as follows:

"Despite the threat of rain Thursday afternoon over 150 University students and Madison residents ralled in front of the Union, then marched to Capitol Square in protest of the imprisonment of 100 Freedom Riders in southern jails.

"The purpose of the rally was to sarry a petition to Govenor Nelson in the Capitol asking him to intercede on behalf of the Wisconsin citizen, former University student James Wahlstrom, who is one of the Freedom Riders who are in Jackson City Jail on charges of disturbing the peace while riding interstate busses, eating at station restaurants and using station restrooms...."

On June 27, 1961 the Milwaukee Journal published an article headlined, "Bad Treatment Told By Freedom Rider." The article appears in full following:

"James Wahlstrom, a Milwaukeean who was one of the 'freedom riders' imprisoned in Mississippi, said in an interview here Tuesday that two of his fellow prisoners had been dragged naked through a concrete corridor after they had refused to walk to their cells.

"We could hear them screaming, Wahlstrom said.

"Wahlstrom was released from prison at Parchman, Miss., on a \$500 bond on Saturday and flew back to Madison where he had been a student.

"That was the day his father, John, 65, died of a heart ailment here. Young Wahlstrom talked to a reporter before his father's funeral here Tuesday.

"SEVEN GET RELEASE

"Wahlstrom said he and six other freedom riders had arranged to leave the prison at this time so that they could tell about the conditions there and the treatment the freedom riders had received.

He said many of his letters from the prison had never been received by friends in Wisconsin, and that he had not received letters which had been mailed to him.

"The Milwaukeean and other freedom riders were arrested at Jackson, Miss., June 6 and transferred to Parchman prison June 15. That, he said, was the day two men — Felix Singer and Terry Sullivan, both of Chicago —

MI 100-13770 "were dragged down a prison corridor. "The story of that incident also was told Monday by another released freedom rider, Kenneth Shilman, 18, of Oceanside, N.Y., and was reported by the Associated Press. "BAD TREATMENT DENIED "In Jackson, according to the Associated Press, the Hinds county sheriff, J. R. Gilfoy, denied any inhuman treatment of freedom riders. He said Singer and Sullivan were dragged when they had refused to move. "Wahlstrom said that the normal procedure would have been to carry the prisoners who would not strip and walk to their cells. He said he believed the dragging was a "slipup" and that he was sure Gov. Ross Barnett of Mississippi was angry when he heard about it. "The governor, Wahlstrom said, undoubtedly had instructed state officials not to use violence in handling the freedom riders. He said the governor wanted to keep 'a semblance of law and order' so that the public spotlight would not be on Mississippi and little attention would be paid to what happened to the freedom riders after they were arrested. "Their cases, he said, could drag on in Mississippi courts for years. Wahlstrom, 24, of 2623 W. Grant Blvd., was to have served a term of 127 days on a charge of breach of the peace. "He was on a hunger strike for 12 days, but he said he stopped it because there was no publicity about it and that the only purpose of the strike had been to draw the public attention to the situation in Mississippi. "Wahlstrom said he and other freedom riders were in the maximum security section of the prison in small cells, about 10 by 5 feet, occupied by two men each.

MI 100-13770 "The prisoners, he said, were not allowed books and got no exercise. They left the cells just twice a week to take showers. He also said lights were left on in the halls night and day, and that the men were clad only in underwear. "Wahlstrom said they were cold much of the time. said they had only sheets on their bunks and that air conditioning was left on at night. "Women freedom riders, he noted, also had been imprisoned, but he said he did not know under what conditions they lived. "He said conditions in Jackson had been considerably better than they were at Parchman. "Electric shockers, of the type used on livestock, were used on Singer and Sullivan, Wahlstrom said. "II've heard they were also used at Auschwitz (the notorious Nazi concentration camp), Wahlstrom said. "BLOODSHED IS CITED "He also observed that the American people apparently rise to moral fury only when they see bloodshed, when they see something like the Wisconsin kid who was beaten. Newspapers carried a picture of James Zwerg, an Appleton freedom rider, who was splattered with blood after he was beaten by a mob in Montgomery, Ala., in May. "But, Wahlstrom said, apparently the American people were willing to tolerate people going to prison on sentences which he described as travesties of justice. "'If this is the case, Wahlstrom said, 'then I'm afraid civil rights and democracy really don't exist . in America. "He said that if a public beating were required to move Americans to sympathy, then one could expect the policies of Barnett, van ignorant governor in Mississippi, to succeed." The article carried a picture of James Wahlstrom. - 8 -

MI 100- 13770 On June 30, 1961 the Milwaukee Journal reported in an article headlined "Links 'Rider', Red Session," that the head of the Mississippi Highway Patrol, T.B.Birdsong told a newspaper conference the preceding Thursday that a Milwaukee freedom rider had attended a Cuba meeting dominated by Communists identifying the rider as James R. Wahlstrom, 24 of 2623 W. Grant Blvd., a former UW student in Madison. Wahlstrom, the Journal said, had returned to Madison after attending the funeral of his father John M. Wahlstrom. The article reported that Birdsong, Jackson, Mississippi, told the conference that Wahlstrom had participated in February in a Soviet-directed seminar in Cuba designed to teach students the tactics of the sit-in, walk-in, kneel-in, and freedom ride. The article added that the Associated Press quoted Birdsong as saying the Freedom Riders were "Communist backed, pawns in the hands of Communist powers that be". The Journal reported further that "at Madison Wahlstrom told the AP Thursday night that he went to Cuba last Christmas with other UW students who were members of the Fair Play for Cuba Committee." "'But as far as I know I never talked with a single Russian during my entire Cuban visit, Wahlstrom said". 'Certainly there was no Soviet Seminar for Freedom Riders'..." On July 3, 1961 the Milwaukee Sentinel, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, carried an article headlined, "Denies 'Rider' Red Link Statement." The following quotation was taken from that article: "The head of the Mississippi State Highway Patrol denied Sunday he made a statement to the press about James Wahlstrom, 24, a Freedom Rider from Miwaukee, who is now out on bail. "The official brigadier general T.B. Birdsong was quoted in press service accounts as saying

"Wahlstrom attended a Communist-directed seminar in Cuba to learn anti-Segregation tactics.

"Wahlstrom denied the charge

"Birdsong said 'it was stated by someone other than myself that Wahlstrom was one of the two arrested freedom riders who attended the Cuban seminar'....

"'Mr. Wahlstrom could perhaps clear up the misunderstanding in certain quarters if he would reveal the truth or untruth of the matter, what transpired in Cuba and who financed the trips to Cuba and to Mississippi.'..."



FAIR PLAY FOR CUBA COMMITTEE (FPCC)

The April 6, 1960, edition of "The New York Times" newspaper contains a full page advertisement captioned, "What Is Really Happening in Cuba," placed by the FPCC. This advertisement announced the formation of the FPCC in New York City, listed various sponsors of the Committee and declared the FPCC intended to promulgate "the truth about revolutionary Cuba" to neutralize the distorted American press on Cuban affairs.

"The New York Times" edition of January 11, 1961, reported that at a hearing conducted before the United States Senate Internal Security Subcommittee on January 10, 1961, Dr. CHARLES A. SANTOS-BUCH identified himself as one of the organizers of the FPCC. Also, Dr. SANTOS-BUCH identified ROBERT TABER as a co-organizer of the FPCC and said TABER drafted the aforementioned FPCC advertisement. Dr. SANTOS-BUCH further testified that he and TABER obtained \$3,500 from the Cuban Government through the son of Cuba's Foreign Minister, which funds, along with about \$1,100 collected from supporters of the FPCC, paid for the cost of aforementioned advertisement in "The New York Times".

On October 3, 1960, a source advised that the Socialist Workers Party (SWP) in New York had become active in the FPCC, and that SWP members, in a recent FPCC election, had been able to remove several Communist Party members who were on the Executive Board of the FPCC and gain control of the organization. This source asserted that the SWP members believed that they had achieved a great influence in the course of the Cuban revolution through their control of the FPCC.

On February 10, 1961, a second source advised that PHIL BART, National Organizational Secretary and member of the National Committee, CP, USA, had reportedly stated recently that the FPCC had been captured by the Trotskyites, but that the CP had not given up in the FPCC.

The SWP and the CP, USA, have been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

On July 9, 1961 Mr. JAMES MC CAIN, Field Representative, Congress of Racial Equality (CORE), advised that five freedom riders were scheduled to leave St. Louis, Missouri on July 10, 1961 enroute to Little Rock, Arkansas, Shreveport and New Orleans, Louisiana via Trailways bus to test facilities enroute. He stated that one of them will be a white male, one a white female, two colored males and a colored female.

Intelligence On July 9, 1961 Captain Unit, New Orleans Police Department; HARVEY TEASLEY, Chief of Police, Shreveport, Louisiana; and Lt. Louisiana State Police, Troop G, Shreveport, Louisiana, were advised of the impending trip by freedom riders. a representative of

On July 10, 1961 CORE at Shreveport, Louisiana, who stated he attends Dillard University in New Orleans and was arrested on the first freedom ride arriving in Jackson, Mississippi, advised that the freedom riders from St. Louis planned to stay overnight in Shrevepor't, Louisiana upon arriving there. He related that he did not have any basis for any trouble expected in Shreveport, but stated that he believed if there is any trouble in Louisiana, it would be in Shreveport.

Shreveport, On July 13, 1961 Louisiana, advised that the freedom riders will leave Little Fock, Arkansas at 4 a.m. on July 14, 1961 by Trailways bus enroute to Shreveport, Louisiana and will arrive at 11:30 a.m. They will not test any facilities upon arrival and he said he did not know how long they/will stay in Shreveport or where they will stay. Police HARVEY TEASLEY, JAMES M. GOSLIN, Chief Deputy Sheriff,
and Troop G of the Louisiana State Police, were advised of

On July 14, 1961 at 10:45 a.m. Special Agents of the FBI observed officers of the Shreveport Police Department and Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office had taken positions at all intersections located one block from the intersection of Fannin and Edwards Sts.in Shreveport. Shreveport Police Department officers were directing automobile traffic and no car was allowed to drive down Fannin St. from Marshall or Edwards Sts. No traffic was allowed to turn off Travis St. onto Edwards St. going north toward the bus depot. Caddo Parish deputies were stopping all unauthorized persons on foot and not allowing them to enter the area within one-half block of the bus depot. At 11 a.m. there were approximately ten uniformed Deputy Sheriffs, five uniformed officers of the Police Department together with four detectives in plain clothes stationed inside the bus depot. These officers were under the command of Caddo Parish Sheriff J. HOWELL FLOURNOY and Chief of Police HARVEY D. TEASLEY who, together with J. EARL DOWNS, Commissioner of Public Safety, arrived on the scene about 10:30 a.m. The officers in the station were observed inquiring of several individuals in the depot concerning their business in the depot.

At 11:15 a.m. an employee of the a resident of Shreveport and was observed standing in the Fannin St. entrance to the bus depot. From T1 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. approximately 100 persons, both colored and white, were observed standing at the intersections of Marshal and Fannin Sts., Fannin and Edwards Sts., Travis and Edwards St. and in the parking lot on Fannin St. across from the bus depot.

The Trailways bus carrying the four freedom riders arrived on the west ramp of the depot at 11:25 a.m. on July 14, 1961. On alighting from the bus Reverend was surrounded by reporters of the newspaper, radio and television media. Sheriff FLOURNOY, Chief of Police TEASLEY and Commissioner DOWNS were observed to introduce themselves to Reverend and were heard to inquire concerning the plans of the group. They were told by that the group intended to rest in Shreveport and remain overnight. The other three individuals, everend talked briefly with two newsmen while obtaining their baggage. At 11:38 a.m. the four individuals walked to the front of the bus depot where they were met by Shreveport CORE representative and another individual who escorted them from the vicinity of the bus depot. They made no effort to test facilities in Shreveport.
daily newspaper at Shreveport, Louisiana, advised on July 14. 1961 that he interviewed
on arrival in Texarkana, Arkansas. said she did not expect that the group of freedom riders would be arrested in Little Rock and she hoped they would
not be arrested in Shreveport. identified him- self as a Methodist preacher from Setucket, Long Island,
New York. stated that he drove from Texarkana
to Shreveport arriving ahead of the bus and he again talked
to the group at Shreveport. At this time Reverend said that he was one of the original freedom riders in
Alabama, that he planned to stay in Shreveport if the social
climate were favorable and he declined to say how long the
group would remain in Shreveport.
On July 14, 1961
Shreveport, advised that the four freedom riders who had

arrived at Shreveport that day would leave by Trailways bus at 2 a.m., July 15, 1961 enroute to New Orleans. He stated they would be accompanied by five to ten additional riders recruited in Shreveport and that they would test bus station facilities in Shreveport prior to departure.

<u> At 1:</u>20 a.m., July 15, 1961 Shreveport, advised that the freedom riders would arrive at the bus station at 1:45 a.m. accompanied by seven additional freedom riders who had been recruited . in Shreveport. He said there would be nine additional individuals with the group to see them off, making a total of about 20 to arrive at the bus station at 1:45 a.m. The above information, upon receipt, was furnished to Chief Deputy Sheriff Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office and Chief of Police HARVEY TEASLEY and Troop G of the Louisiana State Police, Shreveport, Louisiana. advised at 2:15 a.m. on July 15, 1961 that he did not have the identities of the other individuals who tested the facilities at the Trailways bus station at Shreveport by entering the white waiting room. These individuals had presented tickets to Waskom, Texas so they would have a legitimate reason for being at the station. After they left the white waiting room they returned to their homes in Shreveport. He related that not further identified, joined the freedom riders and was accompanying them to New Orleans.

Special Agents of the FBI observed at 1:30 a.m. on July 15, 1961 that approximately ten deputies from the Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office under the direction of and the same number of uniformed officers from the Shreveport Police Department under the direction of Chief of Police HARVEY TEASLEY and Public Safety Commissioner J. 

On August 2, 1961, Tallahassee, Florida, advised that on the afternoon of August 1, 1961, Attorney of Miami, Florida, filed a Notice of Appeal in City Couft, Tallahassee, Florida, in behalf of the ten'interfaith "Freedom Riders" sentenced City Court at Tallahassee, Florida, June 22, 1961, on unlawful assembly charges in connection with their attempt to integrate the local airport restaurant. Attorney stated in instant Notice that the convictions of the group will be appealed to the Florida Supreme Court, asking the Court to review the Order and Judgment of the City Court.



"The following information was disclosed during an interview with the above-named subject on June 27, 1961 at the Maximum Security Unit of the Mississippi State Penitentiary at Parchman.

"Subject was born in Newark, New Jersey. Her father is dead and her mother lives in South Orange, New Jersey.

"She has two sisters. One sister, Joan, is now in the Hinds County jail. She was arrested 6-20-61 at the I. C. RR. terminal along with a large group of agitators from California.

"Subject lives at the above address on Chicago's South Side at the present.

"She works as a mimeograph machine operator and helps a photographer on the South Side.

"Her education consists of two years of High School.

"Subject stated that as a child she was not taught to believe in God and did not receive a Christian upbringing. She state further that she does not now believe in God.

"She admitted being arrested several times in Chicago, Ill. for picketing (possibly as 100-150 times). She was also arrested in New York City, N. Y. and San Francisco, Cal. for picketing. She has picketed the C. I. A. and for racial integration.

"Subject was one of a group of 202 'students' that went to Cuba in Feb., 1961 supposedly for the purpose of hearing a lecture by Castro and his governmental officials on his intentions and Cuba's intentions of friendliness toward the U.S. and other right-wing nations. Of course this was only a guise. It actually turned out to be a seminar conducted by nine officials of the Soviet Union.

"Subject admitted to being in a group of students in a dining hall in Havana, Cuba during the above-mentioned trip that was addressed by the nine officials of Soviet Russia.

"She stated that her group had been addressed by Castro and that she had met him personally.

"She refused to answer when asked what the group of 'students' discussed in Cuba or why they were there. She also refused to identify anyone else in the group.

"She was asked if she had been talked to by one 'John Doe,' a known Communist, and she refused to answer on the grounds that 'the F. B. I. might intimidate him' !!!

"She admitted to being a member of CORE but would not say what other organizations she belonged to, although she did admit to belonging to about seven or eight others.

"Finally she was asked if she was a member of the Communist Party and she refused to answer unless her attorney was present."







Dear Mr. J. Edgar Hoover: HEREIN PROCESSIFIED AND ALL INFORMATION CONTAINED. I am a junior at the University of California at Berkeley. I believe that at this campus we have an unusually large number of truth and justice seeking idealists who seriously and actively pursue their highest hopes. I sincerely believe that I am very honored to be able to associate with people of this calibre. One of my very dearest friends, is one of these who hold such just convictions. He is presently imprisoned at Parchman Farm in Mississippi under the pretense of disturbing the peace by entering a "white" waiting room while in the company of a group of human beings of varying race, religion, and creed. He was jailed on July 2nd of this year: it is indeed a shame, isn't it sir, that he did not enjoy the irony of being arrested two days
later! As if this ridicule of justice is not stinging enough, he and his companions are held in solitary confinement under "maximum security", as is indicated on his letter head.
is a student who has but one year of college left to complete before he receives his Bachelors Degree in sociology. Upon graduation he intends to work for the State of California on cases dealing with juvenile delinquency, but under present conditions he will be unable to attend the fall semester as he will not be released from prison until January 2nd, 1962, and even then he will have to pay a fine of \$200.00.
Though I write this with plight foremost in my mind, I wish to point out that he is but one student among the many who have been so unjustly apprehended by the State of Mississippi. Certainly sir, the careers and abilities of all of these most gifted of Americans are being delayed, and stagnated, if not completely lost, by the senile attitudes of a 19th century slave-holding society. so much better for this nation to be free of Mississippi's asinine actions. Once she seceeded from the Union; now, I wonder, is there any way we can get her to leave?

I am hoping that and the others, may soon be released through the efforts of the U. S. Department of Justice. It is sad to think that while a Russian astronaut circles about the earth, this country permits its students to be denied their education and to be imprisoned for attempting to uphold the equality of man. But perhaps sir, you believe that we are not the equal of the Russians? I certainly hope not and I hope that you will indicate this through an effort to immediately correct the shameful situation in Mississippi. I would hope to receive the briefest note from you sir on your intended and accomplished actions on this matter.



P. S. I wish that I could have sent this to you in the form of a petition sir, but you may not realize the deep fear that exists among the vast majority of college students to-day which prevents them from indicating their beliefs by undersigning such a letter. This fear finds it's stimulis in the actions of a most un-American group, the House Un-American Activities Committee. If you do write to me perhaps you could also explain to me why Patrick Henry is considered a patriot. I can only regard it as an ultimate paradox, considering the conditions I have described in this post script.

Dear Mr. Former:

Your telegroms to the President and the Attorney General have been referred to me.

I appreciate your desire to provide a legal defense for the 150 defendants appearing in Jackson, Mississippi, unmarred by any public disorder. However, the Department has no information, either from your telegrams or otherwise, indicating any violation or threatened violation of federal law in connection with the pending litigation. In the absence of such violation, maintenance of law and order is solely a state and local responsibility. Fe have no basis to assume that the people of Mississippi will be lawless or that responsible law enforcement officials will be unable or unwilling to maintain law and order.

#### Freedom Riders, Jackson, Mississippi

Called from Jackson and said that Mr. Travis, City Attorney of Jackson, had called him aside after the hearing and had said the following:

- 1. Tell Mr. Marshall that we intend to call all of the freedom riders up for trial the first day, on August 14.
- 2. Convey to Mr. Marshall the following. In the past, the City of Jackson has maintained law and order and they intend to do so in the future. The City of Jackson will not tolerate any agitation from anyone, including their own people.
- 3. Travis was aware that CORE had asked for United States marshals.
- 4. They have always had a law that all defendants who appear from Mississippi will be called up the first day of the trial and have to be present. They are not going to change this rule for the freedom riders. They intend to handle these cases judiciously and as expeditiously as possible.

Following this, I called Mr. White and advised him.


I asked him if he was aware of a rally which was to be held Sunday night in Jackson, and he said he was end that there would be enough city policemen around the building to see that no trouble occurred.

He said that August II is the return date on each of the defendants' bonds, and the court rule is that all defendants must appear on the return date. At that time, each defendant who is there and pleads not guilty will receive a trial date for his trial.

As to the possibility of trying just 4 cases, he said they would have been glad to have CORE send only 4 people to test segregation in Jackson. Instead, they chose to fill up our jails. Now the shoe is on the other foot, and CORE doesn't like it.

I have advised Mr. Rosen of the FBI of the situation.

This article pointed out that arrested persons went to all rather than to post bond of \$500 each. KAUFMAN reportedly stated his group would not post bonds and would serve out any sentences.
