EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS

For background, the Nuremburg Files were the idea of hardcore anti-abortion activist Paul deParrie of the group Advocates of Life Ministries (ALM). Unveiled at the American Coalition of Life Activists (ACLA) January 1996 conference, ACLA sent a hard copy of some of the files/names to Otis Neal Horsley, a skilled webmaster of anti-abortion sediment. As such, the Nuremberg Files website opened in January 1997.

The Nuremburg Files have been considered by many as "hit list" of potential targets for anti-abortion extremists. Historically and currently, the list includes the names of over 200 individuals, to include doctors and providers, who provide abortion services nationwide. Approximately 200 more individuals are listed for judges, politicians, law enforcement, spouses, and abortion rights supporters. In many instances, addresses and photos are also included. In the case that no address and/or photo information exists, the website solicits such information for distribution. The christian gallery website, and its corresponding Nuremburg Files, continues to be maintained and operated by Otis O'Neal Horsley, an anti-abortion extremist currently living in Carrollton, Georgia.

The list is broken down by each particular state the liste works in. Particularly alarming is the Nuremburg File "Legend" which explains the meaning for each listed color-coded name. Accordingly, names listed in "Black Font" are defined as individuals "working" in the abortion field. "Greyed-out Name" indicates an individual wounded. A "Strikethrough" name indicates a "fatality." All names are defined as "a complete list of all the people killed or otherwise maimed because of legalized abortion." Among many, two names with a "strikethrough" are David Gunn and John Britton, both medical doctors who were shot and killed by anti-abortion extremists.

Litigation against ACLA began in 1998 when abortion provider Planned Parenthood sued ACLA and others in district court for claims that the defendants violated the Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act (RICO), 18 U.S.C. 1962 and on claims that the defendants conspired to violate the FACE act (Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances), 18, U.S.C. 248. The plantiffs charged that the ACLA and others engaged in "harassment, intimidation and threats of violence in order to cause violent acts and to drive plaintiffs out of business." show such violations, the plantiffs introduced as evidence three tactics of threatening communication used by the defendants to discourage them from practicing. The three tactics were the "Deadly Dozen" poster, which identified a specific abortion doctor as "WANTED", a poster of and the "Nuremburg Files." The ACLA and defendants argued that the First Amendment shielded them from liability.

In February 1999, the case was brought before a jury in the U.S. District Court in Portland, Oregon. The jury found that the website, which contained the Nuremburg Files list, was not protected by the First Amendment and constituted "real threats" to the safety of the providers. The judge ordered that the

website be permanently shut down and the plaintiffs were awarded \$107 million in damages. In March 2001, this verdict was overturned by the U.S. Ninth District Court of Appeals as they concluded that the anti-abortion activists, and Horsley's website, were protected by the First Amendment.

Upon this reversal, Planned Parenthood immediately asked the court to reconsider and on October 3, 2001, the Ninth Circuit withdrew its prior opinion and ordered the case be reargued. The case was reconsidered and on May 16, 2002, the members of the en banc court of the Ninth Circuit affirmed the \$107 million jury verdict and the district courts original injunction. In doing so, the court stated "activists' speech, posters and list of physicians on their Internet website were not protected as political speech under the First Amendment."

This final ruling brings us to the present day in which Horsley is dissatisfied with the courts ruling. Despite the affirmation of the original injunction, Horsley posted the names of six judges of the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals. Horsley's website states: "Six Baby Butchering Judges Are Getting Added To The Nuremburg Files." Further review of the website identifies all six judges by name and location, three of which preside in Phoenix, Arizona

As the U.S. District Court in Portland has already determined, the Nuremburg Files list is considered a "true threat" for any listed individual. In his order and injunction dated February 25, 1999, which is now affirmed, U.S. District Judge Robert E. Jones stated "The Nuremberg Files (Trial Exhibits 7, 9) are a true threat to bodily harm, assault or kill one or more of the the plaintiffs." In addition, Justice Jones stated "I totally reject the defendants' attempts to justify their actions as an expression of opinion or as legitimate and lawful exercise of free speech in order to dissuade the plaintiffs from engaging in providing abortion services."

Phoenix Division requests that a full investigation be opened immediately.

HORSLEY designed and operates the Nuremberg Files project from his website, www.christiangallery.com in order to compile personal information on abortion providers (e.g., photos or videotapes of the abortion provider, their car, family or friends). The Nuremberg Files concept is the brain child of hardcore anti-abortion activist PAUL DEPARRIE of the group Advocates of Life Ministries (ALM) who unveiled the concept at the American Coalition of Life Activists (ACLA) 1996 conference. Law enforcement concerns exist given HORSLEY'S known associations with AOG members who directly support violence and could potentially attempt to access HORSLEY'S collected information to carry out criminal acts. The Nuremberg Files have been considered by many as the "hit list" of potential targets for anti-abortion extremists. In October of 2001, President George W. Bush was added to the Nuremberg files due to his decision to use fetal stem cells for tax payer funded medical experiments. An editorial refers to Neal HORSLEY who stated his decision to list President Bush on the Nuremberg Files is because "Bush's stem cell research decision is a covenant with the devil."

Litigation against the ACLA began in 1998 when abortion provider Planned Parenthood sued the ACLA and other in district court for claims that defendants violated the Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act (RICO), 18 U.S.C. 1962 and on claims that the defendants conspired to violate the FACE act (Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances), 18, U.S.C. 248. The plaintiffs charged that the ACLA and others engaged in "harassment, intimidation and threats of violence in order to cause violent acts and to drive plaintiffs out of business."

In February 1999, the case was brought before a jury in the U.S. District Court in Portland Oregon. The jury found that the website, which contained the Nuremberg Files was not protected by the First Amendment and constituted "real threats" to the safety of providers. In March of 2001, this verdict was overturned by the U.S. Ninth District Court of Appeals as they concluded that the anti-abortion activists, and HORSLEY'S website were protected by the First Amendment. Planned Parenthood immediately asked the court to reconsider and on October 3, 2001, the Ninth Circuit withdrew its prior opinion and ordered the case to be reargued. the case was reconsidered and on May 16, 2002, the Ninth Circuit affirmed the original jury verdict and the District Court's original injunction.

Synopsis: Background intelligence pertaining to OTIS O'NEAL (NEAL) HORSLEY, a white male, date of birth 4/15/1944.

Details: Intelligence research was completed regarding OTIS O'NEAL (NEAL) HORSLEY, a white male, date of birth 04/15/1944, resident of Georgia, residing at 218 Farmington Trace, Carrollton, Georgia, telephone number (770)214-0126. HORSLEY is a self described abortion abolitionist and maintains close association with members of the Army of God (AOG) a.k.a., the American Holocaust Resistance

Movement.

OTIS O'NEAL HORSLEY of Carrollton, Georgia designed and operates the Nuremberg Files project from his website, www.christiangallery.com in order to compile personal information on abortion providers (e.g., photos or videotapes of the abortion providers, their vehicles, family or friends). The Nuremberg Files concept is the brain child of hardcore anti-abortion activist PAUL DEPARRIE of the group Advocates of Life Ministries (ALM) unveiled the concept at the American Coalition of Life Activists (ACLA) 1996 conference. Law enforcement concerns exist given HORSLEY'S known associations with AOG members who directly support violence and could potentially attempt to access HORSLEY'S collected information to carry out criminal acts. The Nuremberg Files have been considered by many as the "hit list" of potential targets for anti-abortion extremists. In October of 2001, President George W. Bush was added to the Nuremberg files due to his decision

to use fetal stem cells for tax payer funded medical experiments. In an editorial referring to Neal HORSLEY, he stated his decision to list President Bush on the Nuremberg Files is because "Bush's stem cell research decision is a covenant with the devil."

Litigation against the ACLA began in 1998 when abortion provider Planned Parenthood sued the ACLA and others in district court for claims that defendants violated the Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act (RICO), 18 U.S.C. 1962 and on claims that the defendants conspired to violate the FACE act (Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances), 18, U.S.C. 248. The plaintiffs charged that the ACLA and others engaged in "harassment, intimidation and threats of violence in order to cause violent acts and to drive plaintiffs out of business."

In February 1999, the case was brought before a jury in the U.S. District Court in Portland Oregon. The jury found that the website, which contained the Nuremberg Files was not protected by the First Amendment and constituted "real threats" to the safety of providers. In March of 2001, this verdict was overturned by the U.S. Ninth District Court of Appeals as they concluded that the anti-abortion activists, and HORSLEY'S website were protected by the First Amendment. Planned Parenthood immediately asked the court to reconsider and on October 3, 2001, the Ninth Circuit withdrew its prior opinion and ordered the case to be reargued. the case was reconsidered and on May 16, 2002, the Ninth Circuit affirmed the original jury verdict and the District Courts original injunction.

HORSLEY, dissatisfied with the courts ruling and despite the original injunction, posted the names of six judges of the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals. HORSLEY'S website states: "six baby butchering judges are getting added to the Nuremberg files." All six judges were identified by name and location. An FBI source, not in a position to testify recently advised that HORSLEY'S website www.christiangallery.com is now available in the United Kingdom, Ireland, Canada, France and Australia.

HORSLEY referred to the www.wechooselife.net when soliciting other members for feedback. The website, www.wechooselife.net, is an Internet service provider that offers Internet access for the "Abortion Abolition Movement". The website advertises "virtually indestructible Internet access and services for people resisting legalized abortion: A model program for effective resistance". The website proclaims to be "first and foremost the primary real-time political organizing machine of the Abortion Abolition Movement." Potentially new subscribers are solicited to patronize www.wechooselife.net in part, through the proclamation that the Pro-Life movement has failed to abolish legalized abortion. The We Choose Life Network claims that a primary goal of the service is to "provide the financial resources to do things that only money can accomplish" and publicizes that 25% of the net proceeds are returned to "Abortion Abolition activists and activities across the USA and Canada." The website also provides links to an corporations claiming that they are "aiding and abetting abortion on demand."
