On 5/7/90, an airtel was dictated for purposes of enclosing original extortion letter to FBIHQ-Laboratory Division. In so doing the original letter was locked in SA desk.

It was SA _____ intention to enter the extortion letter into Bulky Evidence as soon as dictation was returned concerning the airtel to the Bureau. Inasmuch as the airtel that was dictated did not return to SA _____ until after 5/24/90, the letter was not bulkied in San Diego Division until 5/25/90.

SA inadvertently overlooked the rule concerning time in entering evidence into <u>Bulky Evidence</u>, however, the letter remained locked up in SA desk at all times until it was entered into Bulky Evidence on 5/25/90.

LLOYD MARK BUCHER; CRIME ABOARD AIRCRAFT-CARRYING WEAPONS ABOARD AIRCRAFT

On November 14, 1987, LLOYD MARK BUCHER attempted to board a PACIFIC SOUTHWEST AIRLINES (PSA) flight at Lindbergh Field, San Diego, California, when a revolver was found in his luggage. Investigation determined that the revolver appeared on the X-ray moniter when BUCHER attempted to clear his luggage at the security checkpoint. When approached by officers of the HARBOR POLICE, Lindbergh Field, BUCHER admitted the luggage was his and that there was a gun inside. BUCHER stated he kept the gun hidden in the luggage in his closet and that he apparently forgot to remove it when he packed for his trip. BUCHER further stated that he never carried the gun with him and that it was a pure mistake to leave it in the luggage. Located inside the luggage was a 9 millimeter WALTHER PP gun, Serial Number 33195, with one magazine containing seven 9 millimeter rounds. BUCHER was subsequently arrested by the HARBOR POLICE and charged with Carrying a Dangerous Weapon in the Airport.

On November 14, 1987, Assistant United States Attorney (AUSA) b6 San Diego, California, after b7C being apprised of the above facts, stated she would defer prosecution inasmuch as BUCHER was being charged by the HARBOR POLICE.
