This is in reference to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request.

By letter dated September 4, 2013, you indicated your willingness to pay \$15.00. The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) has located approximately 4,877 pages of records potentially responsive to the subject of your request. By DOJ regulation, the FBI notifies requesters when anticipated fees exceed \$25.00.

Releases are made on CD unless otherwise requested. Each CD contains approximately 500 reviewed pages per release. The 500 page estimate is based on our business practice of processing medium and large track cases in segments. DOJ regulations provide 100 pages or the cost equivalent (\$10.00) free of charge. If all potentially responsive pages are released, you will owe \$140.00 in duplication fees to receive the release on CD. Should you request that the release be made in paper, you will owe \$477.70 in duplication fees.

Please remember this is only an estimate, and some of the information may be withheld in full pursuant to FOIA/Privacy Act exemption(s). Also, some information may not be responsive to your subject. Thus, the actual charges could be less. No payment is required at this time. However, you must notify us in writing within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter of your format decision (paper or CD) and your commitment to pay the estimated fee.

You have the opportunity to reduce the scope of your request; this will accelerate the process and could potentially place your request in a smaller processing queue. This may also reduce search and duplication costs and allow for a more timely receipt of your information. The FBI uses a three-queue processing system to fairly assign and process new requests. Requests track into one of the three queues depending on the number of responsive pages - 500 pages or less (small queue), 501 pages to 2500 pages (medium queue), or more than 2500 pages (large queue). Small queue cases usually require the least time to process. Please advise in writing, if you would like to discuss reducing the scope of your request, and your willingness to pay the estimated search and duplication costs indicated above. Dear Mr. Greenewald:

This is in response to your request for a fee waiver for the above referenced Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. Fee waivers are determined on a case by case basis. See 5 U.S.C. § 552 (a)(4)(A)(iii).

To be granted a fee waiver or a reduction in fees, two requirements must be satisfied. First, you must demonstrate that "disclosure of the [requested] information is in the public interest because it is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of the government." Second, you must establish that "disclosure of the information . . . is not primarily in the commercial interest of the requester." See 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A)(iii). The burden is on the requester to show the statutory requirements for a fee waiver have been met. If these requirements are not satisfied, a fee waiver is unavailable under the statute.

To determine whether disclosure is in the public interest, we consider these factors: (1) whether the subject of the requested records concerns "the operations or activities of the government;" (2) whether the disclosure is "likely to contribute" to an understanding of government operations or activities; and (3) whether disclosure of the requested information will contribute "significantly" to "public understanding." See 28 C.F.R. §16.11(k)(2).

If the first requirement has been met, we must then determine whether disclosure of the requested information is primarily in the commercial interest of the requester. To make this determination, we consider these factors: (1) whether the requester has a commercial interest that would be furthered by the requested disclosure and (2) whether the magnitude of the identified commercial interest of the requester is sufficiently large, [compared to] the public interest in disclosure, that disclosure is "primarily in the commercial interest of the requester." See 28 C.F.R. § 16.11(k)(3). If the requester's commercial interest in disclosure is greater than the public interest to be served, then a fee waiver is not warranted.

We have reviewed the information you provided in support of your request for a fee waiver and have found that you do not satisfy either requirement. Quoting or paraphrasing the statute, without also providing factual detail or support specific to your request, is not sufficient under the law. Consequently, your request is denied.

You may file an appeal by writing to the Director, Office of Information Policy (OIP), U.S. Department of Justice, 1425 New York Ave., NW, Suite 11050, Washington, D.C. 20530-0001, or you may submit an appeal through OIP's eFOIA portal at http://www.justice.gov/oip/efoia-portal.html. Your appeal must be received by OIP within sixty (60) days from the date of this letter in order to be considered timely. The envelope and the letter should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Appeal." Please cite the FOIPA Request Number in any correspondence to us for proper identification of your request.

Captioned individual, who you advised was born January 26, 1912, in St. George, Utah, and holds Social Security Number 530-16-8384, is a former U.S. Senator from Nevada. Our central files contain the following information pertaining to him.

In February, 1964, a reliable confidential source advised that U.S. Senator Howard Cannon was present at the funeral services in Las Vegas, Nevada, for Claire Levinson, wife of Edward Levinson. Cannon reportedly had made a special trip from Washington, D.C., to attend the funeral, which made him miss several important votes in the Senate.

Comments were made at the funeral that Cannon was one of the few friends the gambling establishments in Las Vegas still had; that he was the only one of any stature who was willing to stand up and be counted and to show himself as a friend of Edward Levinson.

Edward Levinson, President of the Fremont Hotel, Las Vegas, was the subject of an Anti-Racketeering investigation by the FBI from 1962 to 1969. He pleaded nolo contendere to one count of a two count indictment by a Federal Grand Jury (FGJ), in Las Vegas, in 1968 (income tax evasion). He was fined \$5,000 for making a false tax return and count two was dismissed.

Attached is a copy of an interview conducted by the FBI with Cannon on January 13, 1965, and FBI letters dated January 18 and 28, 1965, which were furnished to the Acting Attorney General, DOJ, with the results of the FBI investigation of the allegations.

Our files also contain an allegation received in 1965 that an individual in Las Vegas claimed responsibility for the re-election of the then Senator Howard Cannon by stealing 600 votes in the 1964 election. Cannon reportedly won the election by about 60 votes. No action was taken by the FBI as there was no indication he knew about this situation.

It was brought to our attention in 1965 that Cannon was reportedly attempting to obtain a full presidential pardon for an individual convicted and sent to prison for income tax evasion in the 1950's. This individual who resided in Las Vegas had a wide acquaintance among major hoodlums throughout the United States and a criminal record dating back to 1924. The individual eventually became disillusioned with Cannon's efforts and made other contacts.

In 1980, Cannon, a U.S. Senator from Nevada, became one of the subjects of an extensive Racketeering Influenced and Corrupt Organizations investigation by the FBI under the code name "Pendorf." Attached is an FBI letter which gives the details of his reported involvement.

details of his reported involvement.

On May 22, 1981, an 11 count indictment was returned against Allen Dorfman, Ray Williams, who was the current President of the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, a "capo" in the Chicago La Costra Nostro (LCN) and others regarding conspiracy to bribe a U.S. Senator.

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Howard Walter Cannon In addition to the above information obtained concerning his involvement in the Pendorf case, the following allegations were also received regarding Cannon. Allen Dorfman reportedly gave \$5,000 to Cannon in 1976, at the direction of a hotel corporation in Las Vegas, for the purpose of obtaining some information on an individual suspected of being an informant; however, it was possible the money could have been for an entirely different reason. Dorfman was later queried by a top Chicago LCN member about whether he delivered the money to Cannon and Dorfman insisted that he did. Turk Torello (deceased Capo in the Chicago LCN family) in 1979 reportedly made the statement that Cannon had been a big help in the past and was expected to be a lot of help in the future. Additionally in 1979, a Kansas City, Missouri, LCN member reportedly made contact with the Administrative b6 of Senator Cannon on behalf of a then incarcerated Kansas City LCN member. During the execution of a b7C Federal search warrant in February, 1979, at the residence of a Kansas City LCN member, a piece of paper was seized with the following notation "Cannon - Dunes Wednesday 10th or Thursday llth." The details of this contact are unknown to this Bureau. In 1980, a politically influential Oklahoma businessman who owned property in Nevada located on a river paid off Senator Cannon in order to have the river dredged by the Corp of Engineers or the Environmental Protection Agency. It was noted at that time that Senator Cannon was a member of the Armed Services Committee and sat on the Military Construction and Stockpile Committee. The above allegations generally consist of information furnished by sources that Senator Cannon used his influence wrongly. None of these allegations were substantiated by the FBI. Alan Dorfman was the victim of a gangland style slaying on January 20, 1983, after being convicted in the Pendorf case in December, 1982. - 3 -



Williams today was ordered to enter a prison hospital to begin serving a reduced sentence of The order came from U.S. District Judge Prentice Marshall, who reduced Mr. Williams' original sentence of 55 years for conspiring to bribe a U.S. senator. After an emotional appeal for lenien-cy by Mr. Williams, Judge Marshall ordered the former union leader to re-port to the U.S. Medical Center for

Federal Prisoners in Springfield, Mo., in days. "My life is in your hands," Mr. Williams, 70, told the judge. He said he was innocent.

Mr. Williams, who suffers from em-physema and heart problems, was wheeled into the courtroom and was tethered to an oxygen supply.

Judge Marshall did not comment on the reduced sentence. The original 55year sentence was provisional pending a medical evaluation.

The sentence was imposed in 1983, but the medical evaluation did not take place until this year because Mr. Williams' case was appealed to the Supreme Court.

Judge Marshall said 60 days should. give Mr. Williams time to seek medical attention and to get his personal affairs in order

Mr. Williams was convicted with four . other persons in 1982 for conspiring to bribe then-U.S. Sen. Howard Cannon, a
