This is in further response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for access to records in the custody of the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA). Our office received your request for FBI case file 100-HQ-428507 pertaining to Ruby Wallace Davis (Ruby Dee) on August 7, 2014, and we assigned your request FOIA case number 43934.

We have completed our review. We released 180 pages in full. We redacted 49 pages for (b)(7)(D) (confidential sources) under the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. 552).

You have the right to appeal our decision to restrict access, either in whole or in part, to any document over which this agency has release authority, within 60 calendar days from the date of this letter. Appeals must be submitted in writing to the Deputy Archivist of the United States (ND), National Archives and Records Administration, 8601 Adelphi Road, College Park, Maryland 20740-6001. Clearly mark the appeal letter and envelope "FOIA Appeal" and cite your case number in your appeal letter. As an alternative, you may email your appeal to <u>foia@nara.gov</u>. Please use the words "FOIA Appeal" in the subject line and also cite your case number.

The records are available for viewing in our textual research room in College Park, Maryland. Please provide us with at least 72 hours advance notice of your visit so that we may have the records ready for you in our hold area. You may also request a price quote for mail-order copies. Our current reproduction fee is \$0.80 per page.
