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



**Results of Examinations:** 

7-1a (2-5-98)

The specimens Q1 through Q10 were examined and ten latent fingerprints (three tips) of value were developed on specimens Q5, Q6, Q8 and Q9.

The latent fingerprints were compared, insofar as possible, with the comparable areas of each of the latent fingerprints, but no identification was effected.

Automated latent fingerprint searches were conducted, but no identification was effected.

The envelopes, Q1, Q3, Q5 and Q8, were processed for latent prints in such a manner as to preserve them for a DNA examination. If in the future a DNA examination is required, these specimens should be resubmitted to the Laboratory Division requesting the DNA examination, and the completion of the latent print examination.
