





Erdos is a world renown mathematician/ consultant, who was recently elected as a foreign associate to the National Academy of Sciences. He has been out of Hungary for five years. Hungary hosted an international meeting of mathematicians, but excluded Israel. Erdos has refused to return home until Hungary apologizes to Israel.
