Dear Mr. Greenewald:

This is in response to your enclosed, electronic Freedom of Information/Privacy Act (FOIA)/(PA) request to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). In turn, the FBI forwarded three documents, totaling five pages to our Office for review and direct response to you. Your request and responsive documents were received in this office on January 21, 2016, and assigned FOIA case number 16-F-0485. We ask that you use that number when referring to your request.

The FBI determined that certain information which has been redacted from the enclosed documents is exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), which pertains to information the release of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of individuals; 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(C), which pertains to records or information compiled for the law enforcement purposes, the release of which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy of individuals; and 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(E), which pertains to information the release of which could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law by disclosing techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions.

In addition, the Chief of the Freedom of Information Act Division, a FOIA Initial Denial Authority determined that certain information which has been redacted from the enclosed documents is exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), which pertains to information the release of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of third parties.

There are no assessable fees associated with this response in this instance and the portion of your request referred to this office is now closed. If you are not satisfied with this response, you may submit an administrative appeal for the (b)(6), (b)(7) (C) and (b)(7)(E) redactions applied by the FBI to the Director, Office of Information Policy (OIP), U.S. Department of Justice, 1425 New York Ave., NW, Suite 11050, Washington, DC 20530-0001, citing FOI/PA # 1222680-001, or you may submit an appeal through OIP's eFOIA portal <a href="http://www.justice.gov/oip/efoia-portal.html">http://www.justice.gov/oip/efoia-portal.html</a>. The envelope and the letter should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Appeal." 
