#### **EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS**

EMPLOYMENT PHYSICS DEPARTMENT UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA AT SAN DIEGO 1960 - 1979On August 17, 1987, Physics Department, UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA AT SAN DIEGO (UCSD), provided the University Personnel Records pertaining

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applicant's employment in the Physics Department at UCSD. These records indicate the applicant was in the Physics Department at UCSD from January 17, 1960, to July 14, 1979, at which time he took a position in the UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA AT SANTA BARBARA.

The records do not contain anything unsatisfactory concerning the applicant.
stated that he worked very closely with the applicant for a number of years and considers him to be a topnotch physicist, a good teacher and competent administrator when its necessary.
stated the applicant is an individual of highest character, reputation, honesty and integrity.
He stated that the applicant's loyalty to the United States has never been questioned and he stated that never did he see any indication on the part of the applicant of the abuse of alcohol or the use of illegal drugs.
stated that the applicant did not appear to have any significant tinancial problems which would make him a security risk and he stated that he did not appear to have any racial prejudices or biases which would effect his work.
stated that he never knew anything unsatisfactory concerning the applicant, considered him to be a top man in his field and would recommend without hesitation that he be granted whatever clearances would be necessary for his current work.
stated that
of the UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA AT SAN DIEGO and former professional colleague and current friend of the applicant is currently in Europe attending a conference with Physicists from around the world and is not expected to return to the campus until shortly before school starts at the end of September, 1987.
stated that also listed by the applicant as a reference and a former professional colleague, is out of San Diego on vacation and is not expected to return until just prior to the start of school in late September 1987.
stated that the only other individuals in the Physics Department who would remember the applicant well enough to comment on him would be who is on vacation until late September, and who are both currently at the University.

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### REFERENCES

stated that on many occasions he recalls the applicant making impassioned pleas before the Student Senate on behalf of student's rights and he stated that he has never known anyone who had more integrity.

stated that he is extremely honored to be named by the applicant as one of his references and he stated that he has never known anything unsatisfactory concerning him and he would recommend him without hesitation for whatever clearances are necessary.
On the same date,  Department, UCSD, advised that he has known the applicant for nearly twenty years and worked very closely with him on a daily basis for years when the applicant was in the Physics Department at UCSD.
described the applicant as an individual of exceptional character, reputation and integrity and he stated his honesty and loyalty to the United States are above question.
