This is our final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request perfected on July 11, 2016 and assigned FOIA case number 17-003 by the Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA). You requested a copy of the Mandatory Declassification Review (MDR) case log for DTRA, for calendar years 2013, 2014 and 2015.

No records responsive to your request for the MDR case log for 2013 were identified during a thorough search of agency files and records, both electronic and paper. Enclosed is a copy of the records deemed responsive to your request, totaling two pages. These records are being released to you in part under FOIA Exemption 6. FOIA Exemption 6 prevents the disclosure of information which, if released, would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. No fees are due as the assessable costs total \$25.00 or less.

All determinations made by DTRA are on behalf of the Initial Denial Authority, Mr. Joseph J. Urgese, Deputy General Counsel. If you consider this decision to be an adverse determination, you may file a written appeal that is postmarked no later than 90 calendar days after the date of this letter to the Executive Director, Defense Threat Reduction Agency, Office of the General Counsel (FOIA/PA), 8725 John J. Kingman Road, MSC 6201, Fort Belvoir, Virginia 22060. The appeal should reference the FOIA case number, contain a concise statement of the grounds upon which the appeal is brought, and a description of the relief sought. A copy of this letter should also accompany your appeal. Both the envelope and your letter should clearly identify that a Freedom of Information Act Appeal is being made.
