

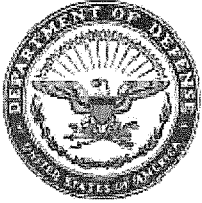

As part of this project (a book), I am writing a portion on POWs taken earlier in that conflict, as well as on the Reintegration process at the end of the war. My request is in two parts: • QUESTION ONE: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I have five (5) names that I was told they were POWs (and it is in a book on POWs) but cannot confirm as having been taken on any official or authoritative rosters. The books name is "Honor Bound: American Prisoners of War in Southeast Asia 1961-1973" by Stuart Rochester and Frederick Kiley (Naval Institute Press: Annapolis, MD), pg 25. - These five names and supposed dates of capture are below: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) US Army Pvt Doyle Morgan / 14 June 1954 / taken near DaNang, South Vietnam 2) US Army Pvt Leonard Sroveck / 14 June 1954 / taken near DaNang, South Vietnam 3) USAF Airmen Ciro Salas / 14 June 1954 / taken near DaNang, South Vietnam 4) USAF Airmen Giacomo Appice / 14 June 1954 / taken near DaNang, South Vietnam 5) USAF Airmen Jerry Schuller / 14 June 1954 / taken near DaNang, South Vietnam - I ran these names against the DPAA/OSD / DPMO -- Accounted For and Unaccounted for lists: (http://www.dpaa.mil/OurMissing/VietnamWar/VietnamWarPOWMIAList.aspx). - I also ran these names in NamPOW and came up with nothing (http://nampows.org/nampowlist.html). - I considered National Archives (NARA.gov) records "72.5.8 Records of the Adjutant General's Office/ Textual Records: Records, 1962-73", however, due to the date of the supposed isolating event, this portion of records likely doesn't contain the info requested. - Do you have any records of these five men being taken prisoner, being processed at the end of the war (Operation Homecoming), or other records on these men being held or unaccounted for? If so, can I get any messages, reports or other data supporting (or refuting) these five being held, detained, processed or being captured? • QUESTION TWO: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To support the Reintegration of former POWs coming home from the war in Southeast Asia, the USG planned and conducted Operation HOMECOMING during Feb and March 1973. These operations were conducted in several parts; air movement out of Southeast Asia, initial processing / debriefing in the Philippines, and also assistance / processing in the continental US. My questions for this operations are below: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Do you have records of how the personnel for Operation were trained? Can I get copies? 2) Do you records of which POWs flew out of Hanoi on which days? Can I get copies? 3) Do you have any copies of message summarizing the operation's successes and portions that we, the DOD needed to better the next time -- their AAR?

Life is really hard right now and I need someone to tell me everything is going to be ok. If i am some how a prisoner of war I do not know how or why and need some help finding out who or what i am if somehow I am part of some bigger picture that I do not understand. Thank you so much for your time and help. I Do not have a phone right now and am forced to survive and resist. unfortunatly i am unable to escape the voices of the previously named people or organizations. Thank you again. Sadly I am still forced to hear them speak and its debilitating.
