FOR PASSAGE TO THE AMBASSADOR

1. HOWARD HUNT'S TESTIMONY BEFORE GRAND JURY CONCERNED THE BREAKING AND ENTERING OF OFFICE OF ELLSBERG PSYCHIATRIST. HE RECOUNTED IN DETAIL THE ASSISTANCE HE GOT FROM THE AGENCY INCLUDING THE RECORDER, CONCEALED CAMERA, THE FALSE DOCUMENTATION AND THE DISGUISE. HE ALSO MENTIONED THE PSYCHIATRIST'S APPRAISAL OF ELLSBERG GIVING DR. MALLOY'S NAME. THIS TESTIMONY WAS RELEASED TO JUDGE BYRNE WHO IN TURN RELEASED THE MAJOR PART OF IT INCLUDING POINTS MENTIONED ABOVE TO THE DEFENSE AND THEREBY TO THE LOS ANGELES TIMES. THIS WILL PROBABLY RESULT IN DEMAND TO JUSTICE FOR THEIR DOCUMENTATION AND KNOWLEDGE OF THESE FACTS INCLUDING THE REPORTS AGENCY MADE IN OCTOBER AND DECEMBER WITH WHICH YOU ARE FAMILIAR. OUR INITIAL POSITION WILL BE TO REPEAT WE HAD NO PRIOR INFORMATION OF WATERGATE EPISODE OR BREAKING INTO OFFICE OF ELLSBERG PSYCHIATRIST AND REFER ANY OTHER QUESTIONS TO JUSTICE.

AND PSYCHIATRIC ASSESSMENT WAS DATED 9 AUGUST. IN ADDITION,
HUNT TESTIFIED THAT THEY OBTAINED NO INFORMATION ON
