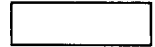

TO MR. JOHN WARNER FROM HELMS

1. For your information, I have received a letter from Mr. David J. Anderson of the Department of Justice stating that they have received my letter of July 13, 1975 and that they have my request under consideration. My request is to be represented by the Department of Justice in Civil Action No. C-75-1211-CBR, as per your cable of recommendation to me. Incidentally, I may have omitted to send you a copy of my letter of July 13 to the Attorney General. It was written in the precise form you gave me in an earlier case.
