This is in response to your request dated 6 December 2013, received in the Information Management Services Office of the (NRO) on 6 December 2013. Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), you are requesting "a copy of all versions of the film, The Nation's Eyes and Ears in Space."

Your request has been processed in accordance with the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. After a thorough search of our records and databases, we located three versions responsive to your request. Versions 1 and 2 are being released in full. One version is being released in part.

Material being withheld in version 3 at timestamp 01:45-01:47 and 05:57-05:59 is denied pursuant to FOIA exemptions:

- (b) (1) which is the basis for withholding properly classified information under Executive Order 13526, Section 1.4(c); and
- (b) (3) which is the basis for withholding information exempt from disclosure by statute. The relevant withholding statute is 10 U.S.C. § 424, which provides (except as required by the President or for information provided to Congress), that with respect to the NRO, "no provision of law shall be construed to require the disclosure of (1) the organization or any function" of the NRO; or "(2) the number of persons employed by or assigned or detailed to any such organization or the name or official title, occupational series, grade, or salary of any such person."

The FOIA authorizes federal agencies to assess fees for record services. Based upon the information provided, you have been placed in the "educational/scientific/media" category of requesters, which means you are responsible for duplication fees (.15 per page) exceeding 100 pages. In this case, no assessable fees were incurred

in processing your request. Additional information about fees can be found on our website at www.nro.gov.

You have the right to appeal this determination by addressing your appeal to the NRO Appeal Authority, 14675 Lee Road, Chantilly, VA 20151-1715 within 60 days of the date of this letter. Should you decide to do so, please explain the basis of your appeal.
