This further responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of 15 September 2017 for "a copy of the "Intellipedia entry for WRANGLER WhatsNew." As noted in the acknowledgement letter to you, your case was assigned case #102529. A copy of your request is enclosed. On 26 December 2018, you appealed this Agency's original decision of 13 November 2018 denying your request for records. Your appeal was subsequently granted on 8 January 2019. Accordingly, the Agency reprocessed your request. Your request has been processed under the FOIA and the document you requested is enclosed. Certain information, however, has been redacted from the enclosure.

Some of the withheld information has been found to be currently and properly classified in accordance with Executive Order 13526. The information meets the criteria for classification as set forth in Subparagraph (c) of Section 1.4 and remains classified SECRET as provided in Section 1.2 of Executive Order 13526. The information is classified because its disclosure could reasonably be expected to cause serious damage to the national security. Because the information is currently and properly classified, it is exempt from disclosure pursuant to the first exemption of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. Section 552(b)(1)).

In addition, this Agency is authorized by various statutes to protect certain information concerning its activities. We have determined that such information exists in this document. Accordingly, those portions are exempt from disclosure pursuant to the third exemption of the FOIA, which provides for the withholding of information specifically protected from disclosure by statute. The specific statutes applicable in this case are Title 50 U.S. Code 3024(i); and Section 6, Public Law 86-36 (50 U.S. Code 3605).

Personal information regarding individuals has been deleted from the enclosure in accordance with 5 U.S.C. 552 (b)(6). This exemption protects from disclosure information that would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. In balancing the public interest for the information you request

against the privacy interests involved, we have determined that the privacy interests sufficiently satisfy the requirements for the application of the (b)(6) exemption.






