Old Post Office Change

The Old Post Office (OPO) renovation has begun. Over the next two years the Trump organization will be turning the OPO into a five star boutique hotel with an expected grand opening of early 2016. Throughout the renovation there will be numerous projects that will impact Main IR. It is anticipated that there will be construction noise, dust, and additional foot and vehicle traffic near the Main Building.
