Forwarded under separate cover is a clipping from the 20 March edition of <i>El Pais</i> which records the adhesion of a number of democratic student organizations to the stand taken by subject during his recent visit to Montevideo. Also quoted are excerpts from a speech given by the executive secretary of a station-influenced nationwide student organization.</p> <p>2. The apparently spontaneous nature of such declarations is having a cumulative effect on broad segments of the Uruguayan public. Furthermore, such statements appear to be having a demoralizing effect upon the Communist Party of Uruguay (PCU) as evidenced by its frenzied efforts to hold demonstrations in the Uruguayan interior and as confirmed by penetration agents and the shrill denunciation of these student groups by the PCU daily, <i>El Popular</i>.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>William C.
