Information received that Zivnostenska Banka New York Agency to be closed. **RUDOLF KURAZ**, former Consul General, sailed for Czechoslovakia 2/11/49. **IRVIN MUNK** serving as Acting Consul General. **LYBUSE VELIBILOVA** new clerical employee in Commercial Attache's Office. New glass or textile firm in New York City being organized, possibly under auspices or control of Commercial Attache. **KARL FINK**, Commercial Attache, made motor trip to Chicago, Illinois. Opposition feared to new tax applied by Czech Government to exports from that country. Plans made for Czechoslovak Industries Fairs at New Orleans, Louisiana, and Boston, Massachusetts. **FRANTISEK B. JERBA**, Cultural Attache, returned from Czechoslovakia 2/9/49. **NORBERT FRYD**, Acting Cultural Attache, left for Mexico 2/21/49. (S)
